OPENING DAY ENTRIES

The racing office was open today accepting entries for opening day Wednesday, August 14. Tom Doutrich (Racing Secretary), Lisa Jones (Assistant Racing Secretary) and Dolores Collins (Clerk of the Course) provided an experienced core staff as other Ferndale racing officials (i.e. Clerk of Scales, Horse Identifier) are working the final race day at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa). Larry Swartzlander and Heather Haviland, from the California Authority of Racing Fairs (CARF), have been here and had computers for the racing staff/stewards set up and ready to go.

Richard Conway is the new general manager for this 2013 version of the Humboldt County Fair. Conway, who also acts as director of racing, is a former horse trainer and was prominent in Arabian racing in California over a decade ago. He replaces long time Humboldt County Fair General Manager Stuart Titus.

Five (5) races were drawn for opening day. Steward Grant Baker was the in the racing office and oversaw entries.

Tuesday

08-13-13¹

ENTRY / SCRATCH DAY

The racing office was open today accepting entries for Friday, August 16. Seven (7) races filled. Forty-five (45) horses are scheduled to face Starter Robert Mooneyhan. Steward Grant Baker met with Track Superintendent Steve Wood and Fair Manager Richard Conway on the racetrack surface in order to 'go over' safety concerns. This was a compliance follow-up to the original pre-meet inspection performed by Safety Steward Tom McCarthy. Fair Manager Conway sent four (4) Humboldt County Fair employees to do some inside rail straightening and panel adjusting and those concerns will be addressed today. There were four (4) jockey changes and no scratches for opening day, August 14.

08-14-13¹

OFFICIAL CHANGE

Former Owner/Trainer/Jockey Jackie Payton replaces longtime Horseshoe Inspector Maurice Fitzpatrick at Ferndale this year. This is Ms. Payton's first day as a racing official in California.

08-14-13² **NEW TRACK VETERINARIAN**

CHRB Veterinarian Don Dooley accompanied Dan Chapman, D.V.M. to the steward's office for an informal meeting with the stewards. Chapman is the new track veterinarian here this year and practices equine medicine in Shasta Lake City (formerly Central Valley) California. He replaces longtime and very well respected Henry Cook, D.V.M. who worked here for over twenty (20) years. The stewards and Dr. Dooley went over paddock, racetrack, two-way radio use and afternoon scratch recommendation protocol with Veterinarian Chapman. Dr. Chapman asked the stewards some questions and we all felt that this morning's meeting was time well spent.

08-14-13³ **RULING NO. 1 – HARVEY**

Jockey **BARRINGTON HARVEY** is fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement) by giving two calls in the 7th race on Friday, August 16, 2013 at the Humboldt County Fair.

The ruling above was issued after the stewards met with Jockey Barrington Harvey and Trainers Quinn Howey and Edward Freeman. Both trainers claimed Jockey Harvey gave them a "call" to ride their horse in the race. Jockey Harvey was at the draw and opted to ride the Howey trainee even after some informal testimony showed that he had given a "call" to Trainer Freeman. Jockey Harvey hired a jockey agent (Ralph Garcia) following the issuance of the above ruling.

08-14-13⁴ **JOCKEY MEETING**

The stewards met with Ferndale jockeys prior to this afternoon's first race. Along with the stewards present were Clerk of Scales Cheryl White, Track Superintendent Steve Wood (Trackmasters, Inc.) and new Track Veterinarian Dan Chapman [REF: 8-14-2013(2)]. The jockeys were introduced to Dr. Chapman and it is obviously a goal of ours (stewards) that a healthy dialog always take place between race riders and the track equine practitioner. The stewards discussed safety protocol for riding on this half (1/2) mile racetrack. The stewards also encouraged riders to be timely in their arrival to the jockey's room and paddock. 'Quick Official' and procedures for claiming foul (lodging an objection) were also reviewed.

08-14-13⁵ **WELL KNOWN GUESTS**

Jockey Russell Baze and Golden Gate Fields/Santa Rosa Track Announcer Michael Wrona visited Ferndale today as special guests of the Humboldt County Fair. Prior to the first race, Baze and Wrona signed autographs for all interested patrons. The fair provided all patrons appearing prior to the races a free 8"x10" glossy color photo of Baze which he autographed for everyone. Michael Wrona was the 'guest announcer' for the day's third race. The day's fourth race was named for Russell Baze. Ray Harris (Baze's agent) and Baze, accompanied by their wives (Peggy and Tami respectively), received a loud ovation from opening day racegoers.

08-14-13⁶ **RACE #1 – INQUIRY / OBJECTION**

The stewards posted the Inquiry sign and Trainer Willie Whitehouse lodged an objection in this race. Whitehouse, who trained third place finisher #2 ZOE'S CAJUN (Chris Russell), lodged a claim of foul against second place finisher #1 MY LAST TYCOON (Hugo Herrera) for alleged interference at the start.

In this race, #1 MY LAST TYCOON (Hugo Herrera) breaks out into #2 ZOE'S CAJUN (Chris Russell) who in turn makes contact with fifth (last) place finisher #5 MINISTER MACHINE (Rachel Goodgame). There was a two (2) length margin between #1 MY LAST TYCOON and #2 ZOE'S CAJUN at the finish. After film review, all three (3) stewards felt this incident did not necessitate the original order of finish to be altered. No change.

08-14-13⁷ **RACE #2 – SCRATCH / NO SHOW WAGERING**

A scratch of #4 ROCKET TRAIN (Trainer Helen Shelley) led to the cancellation of show

wagering in today's second race. Post time favorite #3 LOOKIN WILD (Hugo Herrera) won this four horse event at odds of 3-5.

08-14-13⁸ **HOT TRAINER**

Trainer Quinn Howey won four (4) out of the five (5) races contested here today at Ferndale. The winners were:

- Race 1 – SHANGHAI VOYAGE (Matt Garcia) – odds 2-5
- Race 2 – LOOKIN WILD (Hugo Herrera) – odds 3-5
- Race 3 – SURFER DAVE (Matt Garcia) – odds 7-5
- Race 4 – S S TRIBAL GIRL (Matt Garcia) – odds 9-5

Trainer Howey flirted with history, of some sort, when TIZ THE BLIZ finished fourth in the final race of the day. Consequently Quinn Howey leads the trainer standings now at Ferndale, with an eighty (80) percent win percentage.

08-15-13¹ **ENTRY / SCRATCH DAY / DARK DAY**

Scratch time for Saturday, August 17 was held this morning in the racing office. Steward Will Meyers was present to supervise. All changes were disseminated after the 9:00 a.m. deadline. Entries were taken today for Sunday, August 18. Seven (7) races filled. Forty four (44) mules/horses are scheduled to go to post.

Friday

08-16-13¹ **Race #1 – INQUIRY / DISQUALIFICATION**

The stewards posted the Inquiry sign following this mule race. In the early stages of this race the second place finisher #4 BAR JF PARTY GIRL (Hugo Herrera) bears out badly after the start. The actions of this mule severely impeded fifth place finisher #5 RECRUIT'S WILLIE (Freddy Rodriguez) and sixth place finisher #6 BLUE MCGEE PHD (Martin Arriaga). This essentially eliminated all chance for these two (2) mules. In a unanimous decision, the stewards disqualified #4 BAR JF PARTY GIRL and placed her sixth (last). Jockey Hugo Herrera was ordered to film review.

08-16-13² **Race #4 – INQUIRY / DISQUALIFICATION**

The stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing original third place finisher #2 PURPLE STARDUSTER (Hugo Herrera) bear out going into the first turn. This action forced original fourth place finisher #4 YOUR SPECIAL DAY (Jesus Velazquez) out into the middle of the

racetrack. For this action #2 PURPLE STARDUSTER was disqualified and placed fifth (last). Jockey Hugo Herrera was also ordered to film review for this race.

In a separate inquiry the stewards reviewed the actions of #3 PLATINUM RULES (Matt Garcia – odds 1-2) who reared badly at the break losing roughly 10 lengths. Film review shows this horse causing her own problems. There was no gate malfunction of any sort She was deemed a 'starter' in an unanimous decision.

08-16-13³ **Race #6 – INQUIRY / DISQUALIFICATION**

The stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident on the first turn of this five (5) furlong race. Heading into the turn original third place finisher #7 SMOKIN BOMB (Chris Russell) passes rival #6 WHITE MARK (Jesus Arriaga) who originally finished sixth. After passing this horse #7 SMOKIN BOMB steps into the path of #6 WHITE MARK causing that rival to clip heels and lose ground. The stewards spoke with both jockeys involved and reviewed all camera angles of the incident. In a unanimous decision #7 SMOKIN BOMB was disqualified and placed sixth. Jockey Chris Russell was ordered to film review.

08-17-13¹ **RULING NO. 2 – JAMES MERIDETH MEETING**

Trainer James Meredith appeared in the stewards office to explain why his horse LUVS A COURTING was late to the receiving barn prior to yesterday's sixth race. LUVS A COURTING arrived in the paddock at seventeen (17) minutes after being identified at the receiving barn while all other horses were in the paddock. Meredith placed some blame on the caretaker of the horse. The majority of the stewards voted to issue the following ruling. Steward Stauffer preferred a warning.

Trainer **JAMES MEREDITH** who started **LUVS A COURTING** in the sixth (6) race at the Humboldt County Fair (Ferndale) on August 16, 2013 is hereby fined the sum of fifty dollars (\$50) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1852 (Reporting to the Receiving Barn – Arriving Late).

08-17-13² **HUGO HERRERA FILM REVIEW (REF: 08-16-13¹ and 08-16-13²)**

Jockey Hugo Herrera appeared in the steward's office to review the first and fourth race from August 16. In the first race Herrera rode the mule #4 BAR JF PARTY GIRL who bore out throughout the race. Herrera picked up this mount when Jockey Antonio Marquez

called in sick. Herrera used a right handed whip instead of his reins while drifting out. This mule has a history of somewhat racing erratically.

In the fourth race Herrera rode #2 PURPLE STARDUSTER who bore out while racing on the first turn. The stewards place blame on PURPLE STARDUSTER in this case. Herrera was placed 'on notice' for his ride in the first mule race. He was told that even though the mule has an eventful past a similar ride in the future will likely result in a sanction.

08-17-13³ **RULING NO. 3 – CHRIS RUSSELL FILM REVIEW (REF: 08-16-13³)**

Jockey Chris Russell appeared, along with his agent (Tall) Dave Kasparian in order to view his ride in yesterday's (August 16) sixth race. Jockey Russell was aboard #7 SMOKIN BOMB who finished third in a race in which he was disqualified from third place and placed sixth. In this race Jockey Russell and SMOKIN BOMB dropped over in front of #6 WHITE MARK forcing that eventual sixth place finisher to clip heels and lose ground. Jockey Russell told the stewards after watching race replays he realized that he wasn't clear of his rival while crossing over going into the turn. Jockey Russell accepted responsibility for a self acknowledged sub-par performance. In a unanimous decision the stewards issued the following ruling.

Jockey **CHRIS RUSSELL** who rode **SMOKIN BOMB** in the sixth (6) race at the Humboldt County Fair (Ferndale) on August 16, 2013 is hereby suspended three (3) racing days (August 24, 25, 28 2013) for crossing in front of a rival without sufficient clearance causing interference resulting in a disqualification of his mount from third to sixth. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (D) and (F) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

08-17-13⁴ **RULING NO. 4 – LUIS LIRA MEETING (REF: 8-16-13⁴)**

Jockey **LUIS LIRA** is fined the sum of fifty dollars (\$50)* for failure to fulfill his engagements to ride races one (1) and two (2) at the Humboldt County Fair (Ferndale) on Friday, August 16, 2013, a violation of California Horse Racing Rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

Jockey Luis Lira filed to show in Ferndale yesterday to ride his mounts in the first (#5 RECRUIT'S WILLIE) and second (#1 IMAGE OF TOMAHAWK). Lira knew he was named on these mules on Tuesday, August 13. The decision was unanimous.

08-17-13⁵ **RACE #1 – WIN WAGERING ONLY**

The first race today had win wagering only. In this six (6) mule field, #6 BAR JF RED TICKET (Hugo Herrera) finished first at odds of one to five (1/5)

08-17-13⁶ **RACE #1 – INQUIRY / ACCIDENT**

The stewards posted the Inquiry sign following this two hundred and twenty (220) yard mule race. In this race fifth place finisher #2 JANI NELSON (Francisco Maldonado) bears in shortly after the start knocking original sixth (last) place finisher off stride. In a unanimous decision the stewards disqualified #2 JANI NELSON and placed him sixth (last). Jockey Francisco Maldonado was ordered to film review with the stewards.

There was an accident following this race. #2 JANI NELSON bucked while pulling up unseating Jockey Francisco Maldonado. Track paramedics examined Jockey Maldonado and he was cleared to ride race two (2). An accident report will be attached to these minutes.

08-17-13⁷ **RACE #2 – INQUIRY / ACCIDENT**

The stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing #4 BLAZE AWAY (Luis Lira) prop and then lose her rider fifty (50) yards after the start while racing in seventh position. This incident did not affect any of her rivals. The stewards made no change in the order of finish. Luis Lira was examined by ambulance attendants and appeared to be fine. Accident report attached.

08-17-13⁸ **RACE #3 – NO SHOW WAGERING**

#2 CRESTA LAD (Trainer Jim Hill) was scratched this morning (sick – Dan Chapman, D.V.M.) which led to this race being contested as a four (4) horse field. The stewards subsequently ordered show wagering to be cancelled.

08-17-13⁹ **RACE #7 – INQUIRY**

The stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing #4 DESTINY KNOCKS (Freddy Rodriguez) rear high in the air at the start. Jockey Freddy Rodriguez stepped off his mount and onto the starting gate pontoon as a safety precaution leaving DESTINY KNOCKS riderless. The stewards viewed all camera angles and determined the starting gate worked properly and that the incident at the start was caused solely by the actions of DESTINY KNOCKS. This horse was declared a 'starter' by the stewards in a unanimous decision.

Sunday08-18-13¹ **RULING NO. 5 – FRANCISCO MALDONADO FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Francisco Maldonado appeared in the steward's office to review his ride in yesterday's (August 17) first race. Jockey Maldonado was aboard original fifth place finisher #2 JANI NELSON who was disqualified (REF: 08-17-13⁵) and placed sixth (last) for interfering with #1 BAR JF LOTTOTICKET. Maldonado took responsibility for his mule bearing inward and acknowledged he didn't take good preventative measures. The contact between these two (2) mules was significant and in a unanimous decision the stewards issued the following ruling.

Jockey **FRANCISCO MALDONADO** who rode **JANI NELSON** in the first (1) race at the Humboldt County Fair (Ferndale) on August 17, 2013 is hereby suspended three (3) racing days (August 25, September 20, 21 2013) for crossing in front of a rival without sufficient clearance causing interference resulting in a disqualification of his mount from fifth to sixth. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (D) and (F) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

08-18-13² **JESUS VELAZQUEZ MEETING**

Jockey Jesus Velazquez appeared in the steward's office, at our request, in order to explain his tardiness yesterday. Jockey Velazquez called the steward's yesterday morning and asked for permission to be late. However the steward's interpretation of late and

Velazquez's definition are different. Now we believe we are all on the 'same page.'
Warning issued.

- 08-18-13³ **RACE #2 – CLAIM VOIDED**
Trainer Ryan Kenney claimed fourth place finisher #3 MADI TWO SHOES from Trainer Salvador Naranjo for two thousand five hundred (\$2,500) dollars out of today's second race. CHRB Veterinarian Don Dooley called the stewards later to inform us that the horse was going on the Veterinarian List (lame). Claim voided.
- 08-18-13⁴ **RACE #4 – DELAY**
The stewards called all horses in this race back into the paddock from the fourth race post parade. Jockey Chris Russell (#2 DONTELDA EYE AR ES) reported that the wrong saddle was on his horse. Further it was discovered #3 WHISKEY TALKS also had the wrong saddle. After the problems were corrected, there was a four (4) minute delay to the start of this race.
- 08-18-13⁵ **RACE #4 – ACCIDENT**
#3 WHISKEY TALKS reared with jockey Freddy Rodriguez three (3) steps before setting foot on the racetrack while leaving the paddock prior to the fourth race. Jockey Rodriguez was shaken up and the track paramedics attended to his needs. WHISKEY TALKS reared only and was not injured. Jockey Jesus Arriaga replaced Rodriguez and WHISKEY TALKS went on to finish fifth. An accident report is attached to these minutes. Jockey Freddy Rodriguez was transported via ambulance to Redwood Memorial Hospital in Fortuna, California.
- 08-18-13⁶ **RACE #5 – OBJECTION**
Jockey Hugo Herrera, who was aboard second place finisher #1 CAPTAIN GAVEL, lodged a claim of foul against first place finisher #2 FASTER CAT (Matt Garcia) for alleged interference in the opening furlong of this five (5) furlong race. Jockey Herrera felt Jockey Garcia squeezed him along the race's early stages causing him to steady in tight quarters and lose ground (possibly clipping heels). The stewards felt third place finisher #3 UNMATCHED FORCE (Chris Russell) initiated pressure on both #2 FASTER CAT and #1 CAPTAIN GAVEL which in turn forced #1 CAPTAIN GAVEL to 'take up' along the rail. #1 CAPTAIN GAVEL finished in front of #3 UNMATCHED FORCE therefore in a unanimous decision there was 'no change' in the order of finish. Jockey Chris Russell was ordered to film review.
- 08-18-13⁷ **RACE #6 – ACCIDENT**
The stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of the sixth race. #3 MADISON SHORE (Matt Garcia) was racing inside of the three (3) rivals while the field was approaching the first turn. #3 MADISON SHORE bore out on the turn unseating Jockey Garcia. Track paramedics attended to Jockey Garcia who was transported to Redwood Memorial Hospital in Fortuna, California via ambulance. An accident report is attached to these minutes.
