JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

ABEL CEDILLO met with the BOS to review the second race on Sunday at Santa Anita that involved an inquiry. After a review he was cautioned to make stronger efforts controlling his mounts. He stated he understood and would do better.

The BOS also reviewed the same race and the actions of NORBERTO ARROYO who was also involved in the same inquiry (ref: 6/29/18¹). In a three horse spread approaching the wire (Arroyo in the middle) he pulled his horse in bumping the Cedillo horse which sent that one inward. The majority felt his action was not careless riding. Steward Sawyer felt his action added to the heel clipping incident and he was deserving of a penalty.

MOREY RULING (ref 05-02-19(2), 06-03-19 (1) and 06-18-19(1))

After the above referenced hearings were completed, the opinion of the BOS is stated in the following ruling.

LATL RULING #01

Trainer WILLIAM MOREY, who had entered the horses "TICK TOCK" and "GATE SPEED" to start in the first and fifth race at Santa Anita Park on March 29, 2019, is suspended for FORTY FIVE (45) days from June 30, 2019 to August 13, 2019 pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule

#1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violations of California Horse Racing Board rules #1629 (Penalty For Late Declaration) and #1843.5 (Medication, Drug, and Other Substances Permitted After Entry in a Race – oral administration of “Blood Buffer” on race day).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of WILLIAM MOREY are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), WILLIAM MOREY is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

DELGADO RULING (ref 05-02-19(2), 06-03-19 (1) and 06-18-19(1))

The following ruling was issued after the decision of the BOS.

LATL RULING #02

Assistant Trainer MIGUEL DELGADO who treated the horses “TICK TOCK” and “GATE SPEED” on March 29, 2019 at Santa Anita Park, is suspended for THIRTY (30) days from June 30, 2019 to July 29, 2019 for violations of California Horse Racing Board rules #1629 (Penalty For Late Declaration) and #1843.5 (Medication, Drug, and Other Substances Permitted After Entry in a Race – oral administration of “Blood Buffer” on race day).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of MIGUEL DELGADO are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), MIGUEL DELGADO is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION/THIRD RACE 5/8

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident inside the sixteenth marker. Involved were #7 ST. RENO (A. Quinonez 2nd) and #8 ROCKEY’S SHOW

(S. Iniguez 3rd). In deep stretch #7 drifted out twice bumping #8 off of its path, #8 was beaten a head for second place. After speaking with the Patrol Judge and the jockeys involved. In a unanimous decision #7 was disqualified from second and placed third behind #8.

JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

DIEGO SANCHEZ met with the Stewards to review the second race at Santa Anita on Sunday. He was involved in an inquiry in which he clipped heels near the finish line. On a fast closing horse he chose to go on the inside of three horses and the hole closed before he got to it. He was advised, in the future to go inside one, outside two when having to make a decision. Warning.

ALONSO QUINONEZ also met with the BOS to review the third race yesterday that involved a disqualification of this mount. In deep stretch his horse came out twice under a left handed crop impeding a horse to his outside. He was issued the following ruling.

LATS RULING #03

Jockey ALONSO QUINONEZ, who rode ST. RENO in the third race at Los Alamitos Race Course on June 29, 2019, is suspended for THREE (3) RACING DAYS (July 7, 11 and 12, 2019) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch, causing interference which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from second to third. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rule – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

FUENTAS RULING

The following ruling was issued after Ruben Fuentes admitted by telephone he over used the crop.

LATL RULING #04

Jockey RUBEN FUENTES is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – fourth violation within the past 60 day period) during the eighth race at Los Alamitos Race Course on June 29, 2019.

INQUIRY/ACCIDENT/SECOND RACE 5/8

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident at the start. Involved was #4 MARGO WITH A T who stumbled and unseated jockey Modesto Linares. The horse was caught by the outrider, it was reported neither jockey nor horse were injured. See Accident Report attached.

06/30/19⁴ **VOIDED CLAIM**

After a physical examination by Official Veterinarian Nolton Pattio of #3 WAY GONE who raced in the first race, the horse was placed on the Veterinarian's List. The Stewards voided the claim and the horse returned to the stable of Librado Barocio.
