(1) DUTY STEWARD

Jockey Joel Valadez appeared to review the third race on March 2, 2008 (Quarter Horse – 300 yards). Mr. Valadez was cautioned he needs to use his reins to maintain a straight line during the running of the race. He was in full agreement and stated we would see a better effort in the future.

(5) KRIPPLE RULINGS – CASE # 08LA0029RULING # 77

TRAINER ZVI KRIPPLE, HAVING NOW APPEARED BEFORE THE BOARD OF STEWARDS TO ANSWER CHARGES ALLEGING VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1481 (a) II (OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES AND FEES) IS RESTORED TO GOOD STANDING. RULING # 70 ISSUED AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON FEBRUARY 29, 2008 FOR FAILURE TO APPEAR IS HEREBY SET ASIDE.

RULING # 78

TRAINER ZVI KRIPPLE IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1481 ((A) II) (OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES AND FEES – TRANSPORTING HORSES WITHOUT PROPER LICENSE).

The above rulings were issued after Mr. Kripple appeared to be reinstated and receive his penalty for not having the proper license while transporting horses for Morning Star van service on California Horse Racing Board licensed facilities. He has since attained the proper credentials and stated in the future he will not haul horses onto Los Alamitos Race Course property.

(6) NUON RULING – CASE # 08LA0053RULING # 79

GATEMAN DENNIS NUON IS FINED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* AND PLACED ON PROBATION THROUGH MARCH 2009, FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1530 (CASES NOT COVERED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS – FAILURE TO CHECK LICENSES AFTER BEING WARNED).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Nuon came forth to explain his neglect to review credentials of licensed horsemen as they pass his post entering the stable area. He stated his lack of effort was his fault and after serving a ten day suspension handed down by Los Alamitos Security he intends to fulfill his job duties of gateman.

(7) INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – ACCIDENT – 5TH RACE (300 YARDS)

As the horses crossed the finish line the inquiry sign was lit to review the start wherein # 2 “Wink Big” (jockey Santiago Mendez) stumbled leaving the gate and unseated his rider. Upon film review it was unanimous no other horses were involved and the original order of finish was made official. Accident report attached.

DURING THE TERM OF THE SUSPENSION ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF JUAN GOMEZ ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION).

The above rulings were issued after the above respondents failed to appear in response to complaints filed by Equine Sports Medicine.

PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1900 (GROUNDS FOR SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION) GROOM JOSE AMBRIZ, IS SUSPENDED THIRTY DAYS (30) (MARCH 8, 2008, THROUGH APRIL 6, 2008), FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1489 (H) (GROUNDS FOR DENIAL OR REFUSAL OF LICENSE – USE OF MARIJUANA AND METHAMPHETAMINE) AND #1902 (CONDUCT DETRIMENTAL TO HORSE RACING).

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF SUBJECT ARE SUSPENDED, AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE), SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

FURTHERMORE, AS A CONDITION OF REINSTATEMENT JOSE AMBRIZ SHALL SHOW PROOF OF A RECOVERY PROGRAM ACCEPTABLE TO THE STEWARDS AND SIGN A TEST AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD. SUBJECT IS PLACED ON PROBATION THROUGH MARCH 31, 2009.

The above ruling was issued after an informal hearing was held. Mr. Ambriz admitted taking the drug found in his system, then stated he wanted to get his life in order and promised not to repeat his mistakes.

(5) FILM REVIEW

Jockey Mario Gonzalez came before the Stewards to review the third race on March 6, 2008 (Quarter Horse – 300 yards). Warning was issued to Mr. Gonzalez that in the future he needs to make a better effort to maintain a straight course. He was in full agreement.

In attendance to adjudicate combined hearings involving California Horse Racing Board rules #1843(a)(d) (medication, drugs and other substances), #1887(a) (trainer to insure condition of horse) #1902 (conduct detrimental to horse racing) were trainer Jose Flores, owner Ricardo Sepulveda, California Horse Racing Board Senior Special Investigator Tom Blake and the Board of Stewards, George Slender, Kim Sawyer and Martin Hamilton. The record was opened, the witnesses were sworn in and their testimony was given, all the facts were declared, and all exhibits were entered into evidence. The hearing was closed. A decision will follow.

(7) INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – 4TH RACE (QUARTER HORSE – 300 YARDS)

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review a possible infraction leaving the starting gate. After a review of the films, conversation with the Patrol Judge and all jockeys involved it was a majority vote (Steward Slender dissent) that # 3 “Pure Corona Heat” (5th – jockey R. Ramirez) did break inward and into the path of # 2 “KC Specially Maid” (6th – jockey J. Andrade) and the latter compromised himself by his hesitation and a stumble the second stride out of the gate. The original order of finish was made official.

In attendance for a recorded hearing before the Board of Stewards, Kim Sawyer, George Slender, and Martin Hamilton, were Senior Investigator Dennis Drulias, Equine Medical Director Dr. Rick Arthur, trainer John Frousiakis along with his brother trainer George Frousiakis concerning the alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1843 (a)(d) medication, drugs and other substances, #1844 (b)(c)(1)(2)) authorized medication and #1887 (a) trainer to insure condition of horse. The record was opened, witnesses were sworn in, testimony was given and the exhibits were submitted as evidence. The hearing was closed and a decision will follow.

(4) FILM REVIEW

Jockey Raul Ramirez Jr. came forth to review the fourth race on March 7, 2008. It was in the Stewards' opinion Mr. Ramirez could have made a better effort in correcting his horse's direction leaving the gate. After some debate he admitted he could have done better.

TRAINER ADAN FARIAS, WHO STARTED THE HORSE "DOWNRIGHT SECRET," FIRST PLACE FINISHER IN THE TENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JANUARY 20, 2008 IS FINED ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,500.00)* AND SUSPENDED FIFTEEN (15) DAYS (MARCH 15, 2008 THROUGH MARCH 29, 2008) PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1887 (A) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1843 (A) (D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS, AND OTHER SUBSTANCES) AND # 1844(C) (AUTHORIZED MEDICATION – 5TH NSAID VIOLATION).

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF ADAN FARIAS ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS), SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

After due deliberation the above ruling was issued. Mr. Farias took full responsibility for the double NSAID. He stated he felt he was getting control of his stable now that all his horses were lodged on the grounds under his care.

DURING THE TERM OF THE SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF JOSE FLORES ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1525 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE), SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

The above ruling was issued after the decision by the Board of Stewards was derived from the fact that even though Mr. Flores did not request the medication be given to the two horses, he is still the trainer of record and this positive is his third Class IV within the last year. Mr. Flores accepted full responsibility.

DURING THE TERM OF THE SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF RICARDO SEPULVEDA ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE

#1525 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE), SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

The above ruling was issued after verification by his own admission that Mr. Sepulveda did employ the veterinarian who recommended the injection of Trenbolone to be used as an appetite stimulant on the two horses in question. Mr. Sepulveda failed to communicate this information on to Mr. Flores. Mr. Flores has employed Mr. Sepulveda for the last four years.
