Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of April 8, 2008 through April 13, 2008.

TUESDAY

04/08/2008

(1) DUTY STEWARD

Kim Sawyer was available for the morning duties and recorded the minutes for this reporting period.

(2) SCRATCHES

Thursday scratches were completed at 9:00 a.m. with one first time sex alteration.

Ten races were carded for Friday's program consisting of eight Quarter Horse, and two Thoroughbred races.

(1) SCRATCHES

There were two rider changes for Saturday's program, which were completed at 9:00 a.m.

(2) THE DRAW

The draw was conducted at 2:00 p.m. and the card was a combination of six Quarter Horse, two Thoroughbred, and one Arabian race.

(3) CAL-BRED REPORT

Thursday's third race in the book for three year olds, claiming price \$2,500, going 300 yards was withdrawn with zero entries.

(4) INQUIRY – DOUBLE DISQUALIFICATION – 4TH RACE – QUARTER HORSE – 300 YARDS

Following the running of the race the Inquiry sign was posted to review a possible infraction soon after the start. Involved were # 1 "La Corona Del Mar" (4th – Rodrigo Aceves), # 2 "Don't Azoom" (7th – Cesar De Alba), # 3 "Play Your Card" (6th – Alejandro Luna), # 4 "Sheza Cool Horse" (8th - Alex Bautista) and # 5 "Nothin But A Breeze" (2nd – Norberto Aceves). After further study of the film and conversation with all jockeys involved it was a unanimous vote to disqualify # 5 and place him behind # 4 for lugging in and impeding both numbers 3 and 4. Also, # 1 was disqualified and placed behind # 5 for bearing out and impeding numbers 2, 3, and 4.

DURING THE TERM OF THE SUSPENSION ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF JOSE A. JARAMILLO ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION).

RULING #113

OWNER JANA K. STUCKY (DBA S BAR S RACING), HAVING RECEIVED NOTICE, AND HAVING FAILED TO APPEAR BEFORE THE BOARD OF STEWARDS AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON APRIL 10, 2008, TO ANSWER A COMPLAINT REGARDING CASE NUMBER 08LA0093, ALLEGING VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1876 (FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,596.58) IS HEREBY SUSPENDED PENDING APPEARANCE BEFORE THE BOARD OF STEWARDS PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1547 (FAILURE TO APPEAR).

DURING THE TERM OF THE SUSPENSION ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF JANA. K. STUCKY ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION).

The above two rulings were issued after Ms. Stucky and Mr. Jaramillo failed to come forth to answer to the alleged financial complaints filed by Equine Sports Medicine.

(4) URTIZ RULING

RULING #114

GROOM JERARDO URTIZ IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1874 (DISORDERLY CONDUCT – INDECENT EXPOSURE IN STABLE AREA).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Urtiz came forth to explain his conduct which resulted in a penalty. He firmly vowed not to be involved in any acts of promiscuity in the future.

(5) FARIAS RULING (REFERENCE 4-3-08(4))

RULING #115

TRAINER ADAN FARIAS, WHO STARTED THE HORSE "CHISELLED IN GLORY," SECOND PLACE FINISHER IN THE EIGHTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON FEBRUARY 24, 2008 IS FINED THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00)* AND SUSPENDED FIFTEEN (15) DAYS (APRIL 18, 2008 THROUGH MAY 2, 2008) PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1887 (A) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1843 (A) (D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS, AND OTHER SUBSTANCES) AND # 1844(C)

(AUTHORIZED MEDICATION – 6TH NSAID VIOLATION).

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF ADAN FARIAS ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS), SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Farias stated the horse in question had been treated prior to being transported to the track to race. He also admitted he is responsible for all horses listed in his care.

(6) FILM REVIEW

Jockey Juan Olivera came before the Stewards to review the sixth race (4½ furlongs). On April 10, 2008 Mr. Olivera was reminded he needs to maintain a straight path until clear of all others. He promised to be more aware in the future.

Jockeys Norberto and Rodrigo Aceves appeared to review the disqualification in the fourth race on the night of April 10, 2008 (Quarter Horse – 300 yards). Even though it was necessary to disqualify both racing interests the Stewards felt the horses could be cited for the infraction. The Aceves' were released without penalty.

(7) INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – SECOND RACE (QUARTER HORSE – 300 YARDS)

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was lit to review an incident occurring soon after the start involving # 4 “Willie Ugh” (2nd – C. De Alba) who ducked in leaving the gate bumping # 3 “Arwan” (5th – A. Bautista) and again impeding the same horse about 100 yards into the race. It was a unanimous decision to disqualify # 4 and place him behind # 3. The Stewards felt # 3 was cost the opportunity of a better placing.

(8) INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – TENTH RACE (QUARTER HORSE – 350 YARDS)

After the finish of the race the Stewards posted the inquiry sign to further view a possible infraction which occurred out of the gate. Involved were # 5 “Hummer In The Sky” (7th – C. Huerta) who was bumped and impeded by # 6 “Red Hot Hawk” (2nd – J. Cruz). The Stewards unanimously agreed # 5 was cost an opportunity at a better placing therefore # 6 was placed behind the former.

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF BARRY S. WILLIAMS ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE) SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES WITHIN THIS JURISDICTION.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Williams failed to submit himself and be available for an alleged violation which was originally issued in June 2005, wherein he also failed to appear for his hearing.

(4) FILM REVIEW

Jockey Joel Cruz and Juan Andrade appeared to review the tenth race on April 11, 2008. Mr. Cruz was told his effort was apparent but could have been more visual on film. Mr. Andrade was warned he needs to practice making a more pronounced effort in keeping a straight path. Both riders agreed to partake in these recommendations.

Jockey Cesar De Alba came in to review the first and second race on April 11, 2008. In the first, he was warned to be aware when drifting and in the second his horse was held culpable.
