(1) DUTY STEWARD

Kim Sawyer was available for the morning duties and recorded the minutes for this reporting period.

Mr. Lewis came before the Board of Stewards for an alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule # 1876 (Financial Responsibility). The complainant Carlos Frausto failed to be present. Mr. Lewis stated he may owe Mr. Frausto more money but would like to discuss the details with him present. There was evidence that Mr. Frausto might not have been informed of the time and date of set hearing. A decision will follow after reception of further information.

Jockey Alex Bautista joined the Stewards to discuss the fourth race (300 yards) on Thursday's card. Mr. Bautista's mount broke outward making solid contact with the horse to his outside. It was the Stewards' opinion the onus was applicable to his horse. Mr. Bautista was informed we expect a quick response in making corrections out of the gate. He vacated the office in full agreement.

(1) THE DRAW

The entries for Thursday were drawn at 12:00 p.m. with a combination of six Quarter Horse and two Thoroughbred races.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

Second race in the book for Saturday; maiden two year olds, claiming price \$10,000 going 300 yards failed to make the program with only five horses entered.

(3) INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – 4TH RACE (300 YARDS)

Following the finish of the race the Inquiry sign was posted to review a possible infraction leaving the gate. Involved were # 7 “Conquer The Mountain” (5th – A. Bautista) who broke out sharply into # 8 “For All Time” (6th – C. Huerta) who then bounced into # 9 “Bettencourt” (9th – R. Sanchez) knocking him sideways. It was a unanimous decision to disqualify # 7 and place him last behind # 8 and # 9 for taking away their opportunity for a better placing.

(4) INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – 11TH RACE (300 YARDS)

The Inquiry sign was lit following the running of the race to review an incident just after the start wherein # 1 “Sheswilliegotrhythm” (5th – J. De La Torre) bore out pushing # 2 “Laguerfanita” (7th – J. Chavis) off of his path into # 4 “Going Express” (9th – J. Andrade). The Stewards felt the displacement of these two horses cost them the opportunity for a chance of a better placing thus disqualifying # 1 and placing him ninth.

(2) FILM REVIEW

Jockey Julio De La Torre came to the Stewards' office to review the disqualification of his mount in the eleventh race. The films verified that Mr. De La Torre made a strong effort to control his horse. He left the office without penalty.

Jockey Alex also joined the Stewards to review a disqualification in the fourth race. Mr. Bautista's mount who was tied in the gate with a flipping halter created the infraction leaving the gate on his own. Mr. Bautista went unpunished after the blame fell on the horse.

(3) HUERTA RULINGRULING # 214

GROOM ARTURO HUERTA IS FINED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1922 (IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED – UNLICENSED VISITOR).

This ruling was issued after an informal hearing was conducted wherein Mr. Huerta admitted to his awareness of an unlicensed person in the barn area.
