After the running of the eighth race, the Inquiry sign was posted to review a bumping incident after the start in which #1 “Jp Rhythm” broke out into #2 “Stoli Powered.” Involved were the fourth place finisher #1 “Jp Rhythm” (jockey Santiago Mendez) and last place finisher #2 “Stoli Powered.” After talking with the riders and reviewing the film replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to disqualify #1 “Jp Rhythm” and place him last behind #2 “Stoli Powered” for interference.
