Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of February 2, 2010 through February 6, 2010.

TUESDAY

02/02/2010

(1) DUTY STEWARD

James Dreyer will have morning duties and record the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The eighth race in the book for Friday, the Denim and Diamonds Handicap, was called off after receiving a total of four nominations.

(3) THE DRAW

Eight races will be presented Friday evening including three Thoroughbred and five Quarter Horse races.

WEDNESDAY

02/03/2010

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratch time resulted in one equipment and one rider change.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fifth race in the book for Saturday, three year olds for a claiming price of \$2,500, was called off with four.

(3) THE DRAW

Saturday evening will offer one Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse races. The Los Alamitos Maiden Stakes Trials attracted 49 entries and will make up six of the nine races.

THURSDAY

02/04/2010

(1) SCRATCHES

One rider substitution was the only change on Saturday's program.

(2) NO RACING

Holding to our new schedule, there will be no racing at Los Alamitos this evening.

FRIDAY

02/05/2010 (1) FLORES RULING

RULING #14

TRAINER JOSE FLORES IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)*FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1629 (PENALTY FOR LATE DECLARATION - FAILED TO SHOW) ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 31, 2010.

After speaking with trainer Jose Flores via phone, the foregoing ruling was issued. Jose explained that the groom tending the horse was new and he mistakenly brought the wrong horse to the Receiving Barn. He assured us it would not happen again.

(2) SERGIO FISCAL FINANCIAL (CASE #10LA0015)

Trainer Sergio Fiscal and groom Francisca Hernandez agreed to the following payment plan to satisfy his \$1,000 debt to her for services rendered. He will pay her \$200 on February 14th and the balance on March 2, 2010.

(3) FISCAL FINANCIAL (CASE #10LA0016)

Sergio's second financial to groom Mamorto Hernandez in the amount of \$4,700 was settled as follows: \$700 due on the 15th of March and \$1,000 monthly thereafter until the debt is satisfied.

(4) FOURTH RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION

The Inquiry sign was posted following the fourth race to review an incident shortly after the start. "Super Black Dash" (7th – Andrade) in post #4 forced #5 "Taken Fire" (8th – Aceves) to check. After consulting with the involved riders and reexamining the films, the Stewards voted unanimously to disqualify "Super Black Dash."

02/06/2010 (1) RAMIREZ RULING

RULING #15

EXERCISE RIDER JOSE ALFREDO RAMIREZ IS FINED TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1530 (CASES NOT COVERED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS – (UNAUTHORIZED VISTOR) ON FEBRUARY 2, 2010.

The above ruling was issued following exercise rider Jorge Ramirez's appearance before the Stewards. He accepted full responsibility for his actions.

(2)FIRST RACE – INQUIRY – NO CHANGE

The Inquiry sign was posted at the conclusion of the first race to review the stretch run. “De Car Chic” (1st – A. Bautista) and “First Contact” (2nd – G. Tapia) while racing head and head appeared to make contact several times during the stretch run. After speaking with the riders involved and reviewing the films, the Stewards felt both horses contributed to the contact and voted unanimously to make no change.

(3)FOURTH RACE – INQUIRY – NO CHANGE

The Inquiry sign was posted following the fourth race to look at the break. “Brooklyn Boy” (2nd – Andrade) in post #6 broke in, hitting #5 “Snitcher” (4th – Jerman) briefly interfering with him. After reviewing the start and speaking the involved riders, the Stewards felt “Snitcher” was not deprived of a better placing and voted unanimously to allow the original order of finish to stand.

(4)SEVENTH RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION

The Inquiry sign was hung following the seventh race to review the start of the race. “Duvalin” (3rd – Sanchez) out of post #5 broke into #4 “Rexy On Fire” (4th – Mendez) knocking his hind quarters out from under him. After examining the replay and speaking to the riders involved, the Stewards felt “Rexy On Fire” was definitely denied a better placing and voted unanimously to disqualify #5.
