

(3) RUSSELL RULING

RULING #30

JOCKEY CHRIS RUSSELL IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1872 (FAILURE TO FULFILL JOCKEY AGREEMENT) ON SUNDAY, MARCH 21, 2010.

This ruling was issued when jockey Russell missed his first mount last Sunday. The rider opted to ride the last race at Santa Anita and could not arrive at Los Alamitos in time for his mount.

(4) RODRIGUEZ RULING

RULING #31

TRAINER MIGUEL RODRIGUEZ WHO STARTED THE HORSE "CLYDETTE MIA" IN THE FOURTH RACE ON JANUARY 22, 2010, AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE IS FINED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1887(A) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1843 (A&D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES) AND # 1844 (c-1) (AUTHORIZED MEDICATION - PHENYL BUTAZONE IN EXCESS OF PERMITTED LEVEL – 5.89 UG/ML – CLASS IV).

This ruling was agreed upon after trainer Rodriguez agreed to an informal hearing. The trainer stated the horse was treated at the ranch and then shipped into his barn the day before the race. Official Veterinarian Dr. Beck has directed the trainer to have horses from this ranch to be on the grounds 48 hours before the race. The bute overage of 5.89 ug/mL was low enough that the Stewards elected for the minimum fine.

(5) VASQUEZ RULING

RULING #32

GROOM JOSE R. VASQUEZ, HAVING COMPLIED WITH THE PROVISIONS OF RULING #11, ISSUED AT LOS ALAMITOS QUARTER HORSE ASSOCIATION ON JANUARY 23, 2010 (PROOF OF A RECOVERY PROGRAM ACCEPTABLE TO THE STEWARDS) IS RESTORED TO GOOD STANDING AND HIS LICENSE IS REINSTATED.

FURTHERMORE AS A CONDITION OF REINSTATEMENT, MR.VASQUEZ IS REQUIRED TO SIGN AND ABIDE BY THE TERMS OF A DRUG TESTING AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD.

This ruling was issued when groom Vasquez appeared and produced documentation of a program acceptable to the Stewards. Subject signed a testing agreement and tested negative.

(1) CAL-BRED REPORT

The seventh race in the book for four year olds and upward, claiming price \$5,000, going 350 yards, failed to fill Cal-Bred.

(2) CASE DISMISSED

Trainer Keith Craigmyle appeared to address California Horse Racing Board complaint #10LA0055. It alleged that Mr. Craigmyle employed an unlicensed groom, Julio Zarate. Testimony established that the groom involved lived in a tack room and was the son of a maintenance worker. Los Alamitos Security was aware that the unlicensed person was temporarily on the backside. One of trainer Craigmyle's grooms was showing Mr. Zarate how to muck a stall. Under the circumstances, the Stewards felt Mr. Craigmyle was not responsible.

(3) EIGHTH RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION

After the finish of the eighth race (Quarter Horse – 300 yards) the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to review an incident about halfway through the race. Involved were #5 “Ocean Secret” (jockey Francisco Rubio) and #6 “Race Tracking” (jockey Eduardo Nicasio) who finished in a dead heat for third. After talking with the riders involved and reviewing the tape replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to disqualify #6, split the dead heat, and place the latter in fourth place, behind #5, for interference halfway into the race. Replays show #6 lug in under a right-hand whip, and bump #5, costing the latter a better placing.

In the Stewards' opinion the rider's action did not quite rise to careless riding.
