(1) VAZQUEZ RULING

RULING #55

GROOM JOSE R. VAZQUEZ, HAVING FAILED TO APPEAR BEFORE THE BOARD OF STEWARDS AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON MAY 21, 2010, TO ANSWER A COMPLAINT REGARDING CASE NUMBER 10LA0086, ALLEGING VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1489 (H) (GROUNDS FOR DENIAL OR REFUSAL OF LICENSE - USE OF METHAMPHETAMINE) AND #1930 (OBEDIENCE TO SECURITY OFFICERS AND PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS - ALTERCATION) IS HEREBY SUSPENDED PENDING APPEARANCE BEFORE THE BOARD OF STEWARDS PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1547 (FAILURE TO APPEAR).

DURING THE TERM OF THE SUSPENSION ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF JOSE R. VAZQUEZ ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION)

The above ruling was issued after Jose Vazquez failed to appear to answer charges of alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board Rules #1489 (h) and #1930.

(2) FILMS

Jockey Reuben Lozano was in to review the fourth race last evening. His mount, "My Cassandra," in the four post broke out but was immediately pushed back down by the six horse. The first incident was not his fault but further into the race he whipped his mount into the horse to his inside. The incident did not rise to any action on our part but he was reminded that he needs to react a little quicker in the future.

Jockey Alex Bautista was also in to review the fourth race last night. His mount, "Garfields Beduino," in the six hole broke in and although it again did not amount to the Stewards getting involved we felt that Alex should have gotten him under control a bit quicker with which he agreed.
