Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of June 8, 2010 through June 13, 2010.

TUESDAY

06/08/2010

(1) DUTY STEWARD

James Dreyer will be present for morning duties and compose the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The second race in the book for Friday, maiden two year olds, was used open having failed to attract a sufficient number of Cal-Breds.

(3) THE DRAW

Three Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse races will make up Friday evening's ten race card.

WEDNESDAY

06/09/2010

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratch time at 9:00 a.m. resulted in one rider and one equipment change on Friday evening's program.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The sixth race in the book for Saturday, three year olds and up for \$2,000, was called off with two entries.

(3) THE DRAW

Saturday evening fans will be entertained with two Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse races.

THURSDAY

06/10/2010

(1) SCRATCHES

One declaration was the only change on Saturday evening's program.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The second race in the book for Sunday, maiden two year olds for a claiming tag of \$10,000, was called off with two entries.

(3) THE DRAW

Sunday's card will be evenly divided with five Thoroughbred and an equal number of Quarter Horse races.

FRIDAY

06/11/2010

(1) SCRATCHES

Two rider changes, one equipment change and one first time gelding completed scratch time at 9:00 a.m.

(2) SHORT DELAY

At five minutes to post, outrider Craigmyle informed us that #2 "Wild Fire SR" had lost a shoe while warming up. Horseshoe Inspector Jim Stump was contacted in the Receiving Barn. He met the horse at the starting gate where the shoe was reset. During the adjustment all riders were instructed to take the weight off of their mounts. The delay put us five minutes over post time.

(3) FOURTH RACE – INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION

The Inquiry was posted following the fourth race to look at the start of the race. #7 "Girl Checker" (3rd – A. Bautista) broke in sharply hitting #6 "Eyes Of Night" (1st – S. Mendez) who was then pushed into #5 "Running In Snow" (9th – F. Rubio) who was completely denied any opportunity at a better placing. After consulting with the involved riders and examining the replay the decision was unanimous to place "Girl Checker" behind "Running In Snow."

(1) FILMS

Jockey Julio De La Torre was by to review the third race last evening. His mount, #7 "Royaltys Oblege," began his adventure by breaking into #8 "Arctic Winner" then began drifting inward causing #6 "Eyesa Blues Girl" to steady. Both incidents were minor with the second being exacerbated by #5 "Jess Jets" being on a steady drift outward.

Jockey Alex Bautista was in to review the fourth race last evening (refer 06/11/10 (3)). Although Alex made a commendable effort his mount made it very uncomfortable on the three horses to his inside, resulting in his disqualification.

(2) FINANCIAL CASE (CASE #10LA0148)

An informal hearing was held regarding the above referenced case. Present were trainer Babok Mirghafouri, Senior Investigator Tom Blake, groom Francisco Gomez, translating for Gomez Security Officer J. Avina and the Board of Stewards. An agreement was finally reached after much arguing with nobody leaving completely satisfied.

(3) FIRST RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION

The Inquiry was posted following the first race to look at an incident shortly after the start. #4 "A Fast Choice" (5th – C. Huerta) broke straight but shortly thereafter ducked in sharply, causing both #3 "LV

Correcamino" (8th – F. Rubio) and #2 "Pocuts" (9th – R. Aceves) to take up sharply. After speaking with the riders involved and reviewing the films the Stewards voted unanimously to disqualify "A Fast Choice" and place her behind the horses she interfered with.

GROOM PABLO PEREZ IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1874 (DISORDERLY CONDUCT -INTOXICATION) ON JUNE 12, 2010.

The above ruling was issued after meeting with groom Pablo Perez to address the ticket he received from security for being intoxicated in the barn area. He had no defense because he was so intoxicated he had no recollection of the incident.

(3) RULING #63

GROOM CARLOS ORANTES IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1874 (DISORDERLY CONDUCT -INTOXICATION) ON JUNE 12, 2010.

The foregoing ruling was issued after groom Carlos Orantes was in to explain his ticket for intoxication. He too had a lapse of memory but did admit to harrassing a young lady. He was warned that if it happened again he would be ejected from the property.
