Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of September 7, 2010 through September 12, 2010.

TUESDAY

09/07/2010 (1) DUTY STEWARD

Albert Christiansen will be present for morning activities and shall author the week's minutes.

(2) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Friday's program. All ten races are Quarter Horse events.

WEDNESDAY

09/08/2010 (1) SCRATCHES

One scratch and three rider changes completed scratch time at 9:00 a.m.

(2) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Saturday's program. Nine of the races are trials for the PCQHRA Breeder's Futurity.

THURSDAY

09/09/2010 (1) SCRATCHES

Two rider changes and a blinkers on completed scratch time at 9:00 a.m.

(2) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Sunday's program. Four Thoroughbred and six Quarter Horse races complete the card.

FRIDAY

09/10/2010 (1) SCRATCHES

One scratch completed scratch time at 9:00 a.m.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The third race in the book for maiden fillies two years old, going 300 yards, failed to fill.

(3) ALEMAN RULING (REFER 08/06/10 (5))

RULING #99

TRAINER JUAN ALEMAN, WHO STARTED THE HORSE "MANITAMANITA" IN THE FOURTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON APRIL 18, 2010, IS FINED THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00)* AND SUSPENDED THIRTY (30) DAYS (SEPTEMBER 19, 2010 THROUGH OCTOBER 28, 2010) PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1887 (A) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1843 (A&D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES) AND #1844 (E)(9) & (F) (AUTHORIZED MEDICATION - CLENBUTEROL - 140 PG/ML IN THE BLOOD (AUTHORIZED LEVEL 25 PG/ML) AND 7.9 NG/ML IN THE URINE (AUTHORIZED LEVEL 5 NG/ML)).

TWENTY (20) OF THE DAYS OF SUSPENSION ARE STAYED PENDING THE PASSAGE OF ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF THIS RULING, DURING WHICH TIME JUAN ALEMAN IS PLACED ON PROBATION AND SHALL NOT HAVE ANY VIOLATIONS FOR CLASS I, II, OR III SUBSTANCES. IF PROBATION IS VIOLATED, SUBJECT SHALL SERVE THE TWENTY (20) STAYED DAYS. ACTUAL DAYS OF SUSPENSION WILL BE SEPTEMBER 19, 2010 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 28, 2010.

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF JUAN ALEMAN ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE) JUAN ALEMAN IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

This ruling was issued today after due deliberation. Also, a Statement of Decision was forwarded to all involved parties.

(4) JOCKEY REVIEWS RACE

Jockey Francisco Rubio appeared to review last Sunday's seventh race with the Stewards. The rider was cautioned to make a better effort to maintain a straight course.

(5) RIDER TAKEN OFF

Luis Alberto Godoy was removed from his one Quarter Horse mount tonight. The new rider on this circuit is licensed for Mules only. The rider will attempt to get his jockey's license tomorrow.

(6) THIRD RACE – INQUIRY – NO CHANGES

After the finish of the third race (Quarter Horse – 300 yards) the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to review two separate incidents. The first incident involved the winner #9 "Queens R Blue" (jockey Cesar De Alba) and the two horses inside of her. After talking with the riders involved and reviewing the replays the Stewards unanimously agreed to make no change. Replays show #9 break in at the start, slightly bump #8 into #7, however the incident did not cost either of the latter better placings.

The second incident involved the second place finisher #4 "Oh La Traffic" (jockey Francisco Rubio), #3 "Kiesa Bryn" (jockey Jay Conklin) the seventh place finisher and #2 "Prize Wine" (jockey Joel Cruz) who finished sixth. After talking with the riders involved and reviewing the replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to make no change. Replays show #4 break in and lightly bump #3 into #2. Both #3 and #2 are not cost the opportunity at better placings.

(7) TENTH RACE – JOCKEY OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

After the finish of the tenth race (Quarter Horse – 300 yards) the Stewards posted the Objection sign at the request of jockey Alex Bautista aboard the second place finisher #7 "Pleasant Personality." Jockey Bautista alleged interference by the winner #8 "Fruitstand Hawk" (jockey Juan Andrade) nearing the wire. After talking with the riders involved and reviewing the replays the Stewards unanimously agreed to make no change in the order of finish. Replays show the contact nearing the wire between #7 and #8 was caused by #7.

(1) CAL-BRED REPORT

The tenth race on the card for maidens three years old and upward, claiming price \$5,000, going 300 yards, was used open with five Cal-Breds in a seven horse field.

(2) APPRENTICE REVIEWS REPLAYS

Apprentice jockey Cruz Mendez appeared to review three races he rode on Friday's program. The new rider has now completed his four check rides expressed in California Horse Racing Board Rule #1499 (Qualifications for Jockey). Apprentice Mendez has ridden five mounts and is looking pretty good so far.

(3) LADIES PROBLEMS

Morning outrider Sandy Christensen reported jockey Cheryl Charlton and apprentice Emily Mode had a shouting match on the track Friday morning. Both riders appeared before the Stewards, each blaming the other for the dispute. Both were warned that further conflict was unacceptable. Further, both riders were cautioned not to take their dispute out on the racetrack.

(4) TENTH RACE – INQUIRY/ ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE

After the finish of the tenth race (Quarter Horse – 300 yards) the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to review an accident shortly after the start. Involved were #1 "Go Check Him SA" (jockey Rodrigo Aceves) who lost the rider and the last place horse #2 "Mts Fishers Spicy" (jockey Eddie Garcia). After reviewing the replays the Stewards unanimously agreed to make no change in the order of finish. Replays show, at the start, #1 breaks out and #2 breaks in, the two horses bump, causing the rider of #1 to lose his balance and fall off. Both horses contribute to the incident so no change was warranted. Jockey Aceves got to his feet and appeared okay. The loose horse joined the field, causing some interference nearing the wire.
