

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

There are no races scheduled for California-bred horses tonight due to it being "Golden State Futurity Trials" night.

(3) FILM REVIEW

Jockey Santiago Mendez reviewed the film from Sunday night's second race where he had an issue with the starter when his horse broke poorly. Upon a thorough review, it was determined that Santiago had the opportunity to be ready and that no blame could be put on the starter for his tardy break. Santiago was counseled on how to be better prepared for the start and that he must get tied on a little quicker, as the starter will send the field on their way once all horses are standing straight and ready. The Stewards told Mr. Mendez that both parties must show respect for each other and that disrespectful words will not be tolerated. Hopefully this review will be instructive.

(4) FIRST RACE – INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION

The Inquiry sign was posted after the field crossed the finish line for the first race to review the start. #4 "Paradigm Hawk" (8th – J. Cruz) broke inward, interfering with #3 "Shes Worth A Kiss" (9th – J. Andrade) who in turned was squeezed back and eliminated from all opportunity when she made contact with #2 "Big Jaime" (6th – C. DeAlba) to her inside. In a unanimous opinion the Stewards voted to disqualify #4 from eighth to ninth place (last) behind #3, for interference, costing her an opportunity at a better placing.

(5) TWELFTH RACE – INQUIRY – NO CHANGE

The Stewards called for the Inquiry light to be illuminated following the finish of tonight's twelfth race to review the start. #3 "Lady Mimosa" (9th – R. Aceves) sucked back and hesitated coming out of the gate. The tardy start was reviewed several times by the Stewards and the conclusion was reached that nothing mechanical or human was at fault and that the filly basically refused. The Stewards unanimously voted to make no change to the original order of finish.

(1) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fifth race in the condition book for this evening, California-bred maidens, three years old and upward for a claiming price of \$5,000 at a distance of 350 yards, failed to fill with only three subscriptions and was called off.

(2) SIXTH RACE – INQUIRY – NO CHANGE

The Inquiry was posted immediately after the finish of the sixth race (Quarter Horse – 300 yards) to review an incident inside the final 100 yards where #5 "Gemini Special SA" (1st – R. Aceves) drifted in slightly on #5 "Tony Bolony" (3rd – F. Rubio) putting pressure on #4 "Aztac" (4th – R. Lozano) who was dropping back at the time and also simultaneously #3 "El Jabonero" (2nd – A. Bautista) was drifting out slightly and contributed to the squeezing action on #4 to his outside. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the taped replay numerous times, the Stewards unanimously voted to make no change to the original order of finish in that although #4 did take up and was bothered somewhat, he was being outrun at the time and was going to

finish in fourth place and was not cost the opportunity of a better placing in the opinion of this Board of Stewards.

(3) TENTH RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign as soon as the field crossed the finish line of the tenth race to look at an event shortly after the start. #4 "Ajs Kissntell" (5th – E. Gomez) broke outward and filled an empty space when #5 broke slow and made contact with #6 "Noahs Rocket" (2nd – E. Nicasio). Eulices Gomez pulled off of #6 to correct him and that combined with the impact, made him veer in dramatically to his left and make contact with #3 "Team Nemo" (8th – E. Garcia) who in turn came on #2 "Fruitstand Hawk" (7th – A. Bautista) forcing him in on #1 "RM Switching Chicks" (4th – E. Aceves), causing him to clip heels and stumble. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the taped replays, the Stewards unanimously voted to disqualify #4 from fifth place to eighth (last) for interference shortly after the start, which cost #2 and #3 any opportunity at a better placing.

(1) CAL-BRED REPORT

The second race in the book for California-bred maiden two year olds for a claiming price of \$5,000 at a distance of 300 yards, failed to fill with only two entries and was called off.

(2) MARTIN RULING

RULING #115

JOCKEY GERARDO MARTIN IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR FAILURE TO FULFILL HIS RIDING ENGAGEMENT AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2010, A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1872 (FAILURE TO FULFILL JOCKEY AGREEMENT).

The above ruling was issued to Jockey Gerardo Martin for not arriving on time to Los Alamitos to fulfill his mount in the first race on Saturday, October 16, 2010. Mr. Martin told the Stewards he was in heavy traffic due to a car accident on the freeway. The Stewards told Gerardo he is responsible to be on time and that this is his obligation.

(3) FILM REVIEW

Jockey Eulices Gomez was in to review the film of Saturday night's tenth race where he was involved in a disqualification. Eulices said that when he pulled on his left rein to straighten up his mount from going outward leaving the gate, his horse was bumped hard in the shoulder from

the horse to his outside causing him to suddenly veer very hard to his left and make contact with horses to his inside before he could react to straighten him up. The video replays substantiate this and the Stewards held Mr. Gomez blameless. The horse was primarily responsible for his erratic behavior. No sanction was deemed necessary.

(4) TENTH RACE – ACCIDENT

About a sixteenth of a mile past the finish, the winner of the tenth race #7 “Reckless Secret” (jockey Jay Conklin) suddenly fell. The horse suffered a spinal fracture and was euthanized on the track. Jockey Conklin was shaken up but walked to the ambulance.
