Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of January 4, 2011 through January 9, 2011.

TUESDAY

01/04/2011

(1) DUTY STEWARD

James Dreyer will assume morning responsibilities and shall record the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fourth race in the book for Friday, three year olds for a claiming price of \$5,000, was used open with three Cal-Breds.

(3) THE DRAW

Ten races will be presented Friday evening consisting of three Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse races.

WEDNESDAY

01/05/2011

(1) SCRATCHES

One rider change completed Friday's scratches and changes.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fifth race in the book for Saturday, maidens four and up for a claiming price of \$5,000, was called off with four (one Cal-Bred).

The sixth race in the book for Saturday, four year olds for a \$4,000 tag, failed to fill with five (two Cal-Breds).

(3) THE DRAW

Three Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse races will comprise Saturday evening's program.

THURSDAY

01/06/2011

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratch time was completed at 9:00 a.m. resulting in one blinker change.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The first race in the book for Sunday, three year old maidens for a claiming price of \$2,500, was not used (two Cal-Breds).

The sixth race in the book for Sunday, \$2,000 four year olds and upward, was used open after attracting only four Cal-Breds.

(3) THE DRAW

Sunday's ten race card will offer three Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse races.

FRIDAY

01/07/2011

(1) SCRATCHES

Two scratches completed Sunday's program changes.

(2) TREECE RULINGRULING #5

TRAINER CHARLES S. TREECE IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1629 (PENALTY FOR LATE DECLARATION – INADVERTENTLY BROUGHT WRONG HORSE TO RECEIVING BARN) ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 2, 2011.

The above ruling was issued after speaking with Trainer Treece during which he explained that he had claimed two horses for the Loeb Trust on the same evening. He then shipped both horses to the Loeb ranch. When "Maggie's Patches" got in, the wrong horse was sent back in.

(3) LOZA RULINGRULING #6

JOCKEY ADRIAN LOZA, WHO RODE "HARRY POTTER BRYAN" IN THE TENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 2, 2011, IS SUSPENDED THREE (3) RACING DAYS (JANUARY 14TH, 15TH, AND 16TH, 2011) FOR FAILURE TO MAINTAIN A STRAIGHT COURSE AND CAUSING INTERFERENCE. A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1699 (RIDING RULES - CARELESS RIDING).

THE TERM OF THIS SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES IN CALIFORNIA.

The foregoing ruling was issued after meeting with Jockey Adrian Loza to discuss his ride on "Harry Potter Bryan" Sunday evening. The films confirmed he made no effort to keep his mount straight. Loza agreed his performance was less than adequate.

(4) PIMENTEL RULINGRULING #7

GROOM JOEL A. PIMENTEL IS FINED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1530 (CASES NOT COVERED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS - UNAUTHORIZED VISITOR) ON DECEMBER 19, 2010.

The above ruling was issued after Joel Pimentel admitted to having an unauthorized visitor in the barn area overnight.

(5) CARRILLO HEARING (CASE #10LA0272)

A formal hearing was held this afternoon to address case #10LA0272. Present were the accused Jario Carrillo, interpreter G. Castellanos, Safety Steward Randy Winick, Senior Investigator Tom Blake, Court Reporter Barbara Weinstein and Stewards George Slender, Albert Christiansen, and James Dreyer. Security Captain Rick Castaneda joined the hearing in progress. Tom Blake presented the case for the California Horse Racing Board. Defendant Carrillo accepted full culpability and admitted he was guilty of all charges against him. The hearing was adjourned and a decision will be forthcoming.

(6) SIXTH RACE – INQUIRY – NO CHANGE

The Stewards posted the Inquiry following the sixth race to examine an accident mid-stretch. #6 “Sumway Sumhow” (C. De Alba) while racing in the clear fell for no apparent reason. Initially he appeared to break down but when he was loaded into the horse ambulance seemed to be traveling reasonably well.

(1) FISCAL HEARING (CASE #10LA0280)

A formal hearing was held today to address the above referenced case. Present were Senior Supervising Investigator Ken Lady, Senior Investigator Tom Blake, Head of Security Rick Castaneda, accused Sergio Fiscal, Court Reporter Barbara Weinstein, and Stewards Albert Christiansen, George Slender and James Dreyer. Tom Blake presented the case for the California Horse Racing Board and introduced nine bags of syringes and assorted injectibles into evidence. Fiscal admitted the contraband was his and was aware all of the paraphernalia was illegal to have on the track. The hearing was adjourned with a decision to be decided at a later date.

(2) JENSEN RULINGRULING #8

JOCKEY CODY JENSEN WHO RODE "HES A FORTUNE TELLER" IN THE SECOND RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON FRIDAY, JANUARY 7, 2011, IS SUSPENDED THREE (3) RACING DAYS (JANUARY 15TH, 16TH, AND 21ST, 2011) FOR FAILURE TO MAINTAIN A STRAIGHT COURSE AND CAUSING INTERFERENCE. A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1699 (RIDING RULES – CARELESS RIDING).

THE TERM OF THIS SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES IN CALIFORNIA.

The foregoing ruling was issued after meeting with Jockey Cody Jensen and reviewing the second race last evening. Cody admitted his mount was drifting in when he reached and hit his mount right-handed causing a tight situation to escalate.

(3) POST RACE ACCIDENT

Following the second race (Quarter Horse – 350 yards) “Chicks So Rare” (C. Jensen) appeared to attempt to jump the outside fence, throwing Cody over the railing. The horse expired on the track and the rider was transported to the hospital with a possible broken hip.

(1) CARRILLO RULING

RULING #9

EXERCISE RIDER JARIO CARRILLO IS HEREBY SUSPENDED FOR ONE YEAR (JANUARY 12, 2011 THROUGH JANUARY 12, 2012) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1489 (H) (GROUNDS FOR DENIAL OR REFUSAL OR LICENSE – MARIJUANA), #1890 (POSSESSION OF CONTRABAND - ELECTRICAL DEVICE) AND #1902 (CONDUCT DETRIMENTAL TO HORSE RACING).

DURING THE TERM OF THIS SUSPENSION ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF JARIO CARRILLO ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS) MR. CARRILLO IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES WITHIN THIS JURISDICTION.

The foregoing ruling was issued after due deliberation.

(2) FILMS

Jockey Antonio Alberto was in at the Stewards' request to review the sixth race from last evening. His mount "Checkachick" broke out sharply at the start. Although the horse to his outside broke slowly the Stewards felt he should have reacted a bit more quickly. We felt a warning would suffice.

(3) FILMS

Jockey Abel Ramirez was in to review the tenth race Friday evening. His mount broke out sharply at the start. Fortunately the horse outside of him broke slowly so the interference was minimal. Abel was warned that in the future a better effort would be expected from him.

(4) STEWARDS MEET WITH RIDERS

The Stewards met with the jockeys for a second time Sunday evening to discuss a lack of security in the Jockey's Room. Because of fire safety regulations the rear doors to the room must remain unlocked during the races. They were warned however that the doors are unlocked for just that reason, fire safety, not for ingress or egress.

(5) NO PROBLEMS

Sunday evening's program went off with nothing of significance arising.
