(1) ZAMUDIO RULING

RULING #59

TRAINER VALENTIN ZAMUDIO IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1629 (PENALTY FOR LATE DECLARATION - NO LASIX) ON SATURDAY, APRIL 9, 2011.

The foregoing ruling was issued after conferring with trainer Zamudio and being assured that the miscommunication that resulted in the late declaration will not occur again.

(2) FILMS

Jockey Cesar De Alba was in to review the first race last evening. His mount broke from the six post and under a right-handed whip ducked into #4 who in turn hit #3. The Stewards did not feel the incident affected the outcome of the race and no discipline was warranted.

(3) FIRST RACE – INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION

Following the first race the Stewards posted the Inquiry to review an incident at the start. #5 "White Sox Special" (6th – A. Loza) broke in sharply, knocking #4 "Aunties Rare Secret" (7th – A. Bautista) off stride. After speaking with the riders involved and examining the films the opinion was unanimous that the outcome of the race had been compromised resulting in the disqualification.
