Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of May 17, 2011 through May 22, 2011.

**TUESDAY**

05/17/2011

(1) DUTY STEWARD

James Dreyer will cover morning situations and will record the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

Friday evening will offer three races for Cal-Breds. The second race in the book, maiden fillies two years old, was used open with 3 Cal-Breds. The fourth race in the book, maidens three and up for a \$6,250 tag, was called off with two (1 Cal-Bred). The eighth race in the book, three and up for a claiming price of \$8,000 was called off with no entries.

(3) THE DRAW

Friday's program will be comprised of ten races including four Thoroughbred and six Quarter Horse races.

**WEDNESDAY**

05/18/2011

(1) SCRATCHES

Two equipment and one rider change completed Friday's program adjustments.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The sixth race in the book for Saturday, three year olds for a claiming price of \$12,500 was called off with no entries. The seventh race in the book, three and up for \$2,500, was called off with three (1 Cal-Bred).

(3) THE DRAW

Ten races will make up Saturday evening's card consisting of three Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse races.

**THURSDAY**

05/19/2011

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratch time was conducted at 9:00 a.m. resulting in two declarations.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The second race in the book for Sunday, maiden two year olds for a claiming price of \$6,250, was called off with no entries. The eighth race, three and up for \$10,000, was called off also with no entries.

(3) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Sunday consisting of four Thoroughbred and six Quarter Horse races. Highlighting Sunday's program will be the \$339,600 Kindergarten Futurity.

(4) GONZALO MEDINA (CASE #11LA0096)

A formal hearing was held today to address the above referenced case. Present were Gonzalo Medina, Senior Investigator Tom Blake, Stewards James Dreyer, Albert Christiansen, Ruben Moreno, Safety Steward Randy Winick, interpreter Alex Medina and Court Reporter Barbara Weinstein.

Medina testified the Clenbuterol was given four or five days prior to the race; the level tends to contradict that. He also testified that all medications used at the ranch are prescribed by Dr. Rick Overly. Gonzalo denied giving the horse any medication after being entered. Jesus Nunez, testifying for the Board, was under the impression the Clenbuterol was given four to five days out.

After all of the testimony was heard, defendant Gonzalo Medina was advised that a decision would be forthcoming and the hearing was adjourned.

(5) GONZALO MEDINA (CASE #11LA0097)

A formal hearing was held to address case #11LA0097. The same individuals were present. The testimony was essentially the same as were the end results. Just for the record the levels were 1247 pg/mL in the blood and urine 80ng/mL.

(6) GONZALO MEDINA (CASE #11LA0098)

The third and final hearing concerning Medina was heard today to address another high Clenbuterol. Present were the same individuals as in the two prior cases. No new testimony or evidence was introduced. The Stewards' decision will be forthcoming at a later date.

(7) DANNY MONTES (CASE #11LA0104)

A formal hearing was held to address a high Clenbuterol, 154 pg/mL blood and 8.0 ng/mL urine, from "Illegal Velocity" trained by Montes. Montes testified that the medication was given at the owner's Riverside Ranch by ranch employee Ramon Sanchez. Sanchez does not have a California Horse Racing Board license. Danny testified the horse is on a daily regimen of Clenbuterol and was last given the drug the day he was entered. He had no explanation as to why the reading was so high. He was advised a decision would be forthcoming.

**FRIDAY**

05/27/2011

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratch time resulted in the first race also being declared, one blinker and two jockey changes.

(2) DR. BECK EXCUSED FOR WEEKEND

Due to personal obligations State Veterinarian Gary Beck will be unavailable this weekend. In his place, Dr. William Bell will assume responsibilities of the state vet.

(3) CLAIMING OPTION ERROR

In this evening's tenth race "Aunts Corona Secret" was entered exercising the claiming protection of Rule #1634. After closer examination of his last race date he was seven days short of being eligible to take advantage of the rule. Assistant Racing Secretary Ed Reese advised trainer Edwin Sirin of the situation and he agreed to run the horse without the protection of Rule #1634. It was announced throughout the evening, put on the television

monitors and the paymaster of purses was apprised of the situation.

(4) STARTER BAKER VISITS

At the request of Guild Director Darrell Haire we met with Starter Baker to discuss some complaints Darrell had received from the riders. The riders feel his presence in the Jockey's Room is a disruption. We told them both that Starter Baker is an official and he has the authority to be in the Jockey's Room if he so desires. However, in the interest of harmony, John has agreed to keep his presence in the Jockey's Room to a minimum.

(2) AMARO RULINGRULING #82

GROOM ROSEMARY AMARO IS FINED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1874 (DISORDERLY CONDUCT - STABLE AREA DISTURBANCE).

The above ruling was issued after meeting with Rose Amaro concerning her disorderly conduct citation issued by Los Alamitos Security. She was warned that in the future if she does not temper her attitude the fines will escalate considerably.

(3) REED RULINGRULING #83

GROOM ALLEN REED IS FINED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1874 (DISORDERLY CONDUCT - STABLE

The foregoing ruling was issued after groom Allen Reed admitted to spitting at and cussing groom Rose Amaro. He was given the same warning.

RULING #84

OWNER GONZALO MEDINA IS SUSPENDED ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY (180) DAYS (MAY 23, 2011 THROUGH NOVEMBER 18, 2011) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1843 (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES) AND CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1844 (AUTHORIZED MEDICATION - CLENBUTEROL).

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF GONZALO MEDINA ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE), SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

The foregoing ruling was issued after testimony was weighed following a hearing conducted on May 19, 2011 regarding complaints #11LA0096, #11LA0097, and #11LA0098.

(5) SERGIO SANCHEZ (CASE #11LA0102)

A formal hearing was held this evening to hear the above referenced case. Present were respondent Sergio Sanchez, owner Douglas Christensen, Senior Investigator Tom Blake, Stewards Albert Christiansen, James Dreyer, Ruben Moreno, Safety Steward Randy Winick and Court Reporter Barbara Weinstein.

Sergio testified that all training is done at the owner's ranch in Oxnard. He is in regular contact with owner Melgoza instructing him as to the horse's training schedule. All medications are administered by the owner at the ranch. Sergio testified it was his understanding that the Clenbuterol was given five or six days prior to running. While in his barn at the track, the horses are under constant camera surveillance.

After all testimony was given, Mr. Sanchez was advised that he would be notified of our decision and the hearing was adjourned.

(6) RAMON MELGOZA (CASE #11LA0109)

A formal hearing was held today to address the above case. Present were Ramon Melgoza, Senior Investigator Tom Blake, Stewards Albert Christiansen, Ruben Moreno, James Dreyer, Safety Steward Randy Winick and Court Reporter Barbara Weinstein.

Owner Melgoza corroborated trainer Sanchez's testimony with the exception of the scheduling of the Clenbuterol administration. He testified it was given by him three days prior to running. The injection was 5CC. He said the horse was quite small and could have contributed to the overage. Mr. Melgoza was advised a decision will be forthcoming.

The above ruling was issued following testimony that was given confirming the presence of Clenbuterol in excess of the permitted level.

(8) SEVENTH RACE – INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION

The Inquiry was posted following the seventh race to review the start. #5 “Go Class Go” (3<sup>rd</sup> – A. Loza) broke in hitting #4 “Windy Skirt” (4<sup>th</sup> – C. Mendez) who in turn collided with #2 “Choice For Toby” (6<sup>th</sup> – A. Alberto) causing her to clip “Cashs Version’s” (2<sup>nd</sup> – O. Peinado) heels. #3 “One For Chivato” (7<sup>th</sup> – A. Ramirez) did not break and was never a factor. After speaking with the riders involved and examining the replays the Stewards felt “Choice For Toby” was denied the opportunity at a better placing. The vote was unanimous to disqualify “Go Class Go” and place her behind “Choice For Toby.”

(9) EIGHTH RACE – INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION

Following the eighth race the Inquiry was posted to review an incident near the gap. #7 “Hit It Big” (1<sup>st</sup> – C. De Alba) was intimidating #6 “First Runaway Dash” (5<sup>th</sup> – A. Loza) throughout the race. Nearing the gap, “Hit It Big” crossed in front of “First Runaway Dash” causing him to check. After speaking with the involved riders the Stewards agreed “First Runaway Dash” was deprived a better placing and voted unanimously to disqualify.

(10) NINTH RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION

Rubio) ducked in at the start, pushing #3 “Mr Luvly Dial” (2<sup>nd</sup> – R. Aceves) into #2 “Run Naked” (8<sup>th</sup> – R. Sanchez) who was shoved in behind #1 “Anazoom” (4<sup>th</sup> – C. Mendez) causing him to clip heels and stumble. After examining the films and speaking to the riders involved the Stewards voted unanimously to disqualify “Like A Zephyr.”
