TUESDAY

10/25/2011

(1) DUTY STEWARD

James Dreyer will be present for morning duties and shall record the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The sixth race in the book for Friday, maiden fillies and mares three and up, was called off with four (1 CAL-BRED). The sub 6 in the book, three and up for a \$20,000 claiming price, was called off with three (2 CAL-BREDS).

A late draw resulted in three Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse races for Friday evening.

(2) BAZE RULING (REFER 10/22/11 (2))

RULING #223

JOCKEY TYLER BAZE IS SUSPENDED NINETY (90) DAYS FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1902 (CONDUCT DETRIMENTAL TO HORSE RACING), #1874 (DISORDERLY CONDUCT - UNTRUTHFUL STATEMENTS) AND #1485 (D) (LICENSE SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS AND AGREEMENTS - FAILED TO ABIDE BY TESTING AGREEMENT). THE NINETY DAY SUSPENSION SHALL START FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2011, THE DAY OF DEL MAR RULING #070, AND CONTINUE THROUGH NOVEMBER 29, 2011.

FURTHERMORE, TYLER BAZE SHALL BE EVALUATED AND COMPLETE AN IN-HOUSE REHABILITATION PROGRAM OF A MINIMUM OF THIRTY (30) DAYS. ALSO, SUBJECT SHALL BE EVALUATED AND ABIDE BY THE TERMS SPECIFIED BY THE WINNERS FOUNDATION. IN ADDITION SUBJECT MUST COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF A TESTING AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD SIGNED ON AUGUST 24, 2011.

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF TYLER BAZE ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE) SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

After a lengthy deliberation the foregoing ruling was issued.

(3) PURSE REDISTRIBUTIONS

RULING #224

ACTING UPON A REPORT FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA DAVIS, AN OFFICIAL TESTING LABORATORY OF THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD THAT BLOOD SAMPLE# LA18132, TAKEN FROM THE HORSE "ONE RAMBLIN LADY", THE FIRST PLACE FINISHER IN THE NINTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JUNE 10, 2011, TESTED POSITIVE FOR CLENBUTEROL (CLASS III). IT IS ORDERED THAT "ONE RAMBLIN LADY" BE DISQUALIFIED FROM ALL PURSE MONIES EARNED IN SAID RACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1859.5 (DISQUALIFICATION UPON POSITIVE TEST).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT ALL PURSE MONIES (\$23,688) EARNED BY OWNER GUSTAVO DE LA TORRE, TRAINER UGO DE LA TORRE AND JOCKEY ADRIAN LOZA BE RETURNED TO THE PAYMASTER OF PURSES AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE BY NOVEMBER 28, 2011 FOR REDISTRIBUTION PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1760 (PURSE AWARD OR PRIZE TO BE WITH HELD)

ACTING UPON A REPORT FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA DAVIS, AN OFFICIAL TESTING LABORATORY OF THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD THAT BLOOD AND URINE SAMPLE# LA18479, TAKEN FROM THE HORSE "LAS VEGAS LUCKY", THE SECOND PLACE FINISHER IN THE FIRST RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JULY 23, 2011, TESTED POSITIVE FOR CLENBUTEROL (CLASS III). IT IS ORDERED THAT "LAS VEGAS LUCKY" BE DISQUALIFIED FROM ALL PURSE MONIES EARNED IN SAID RACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1859.5 (DISQUALIFICATION UPON POSITIVE TEST).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT ALL PURSE MONIES (\$1,440) EARNED BY OWNER JOSE DE LA TORRE, TRAINER UGO DE LA TORRE AND JOCKEY RAMON GUCE BE RETURNED TO THE PAYMASTER OF PURSES AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE BY NOVEMBER 28, 2011 FOR REDISTRIBUTION PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1760 (PURSE AWARD OR PRIZE TO BE WITH HELD)

After an informal telephonic hearing with Richard Moore, counsel for trainer Ugo De La Torre, we were informed that Mr. De La Torre would not protest the disqualifications resulting in the foregoing rulings.

(4) AQUINO RULING

RULING #226

OWNER/TRAINER ANGELA AQUINO IS FINED FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1437 (CONDITION OF A RACE MEETING - COMPETED AT NON-RECOGNIZED AQHA MEET).

The above ruling was issued after an informal hearing was held with Ms. Aquino concerning case #11LA0304. Angela testified that she was unaware that it was necessary to inform the Racing Office that "Regardless" had racing experience in Mexico since the colt was still a maiden. That proved to be an incorrect supposition.

(5) FILMS

Jockey Antonio Alberto was in to discuss his lackluster effort in the seventh race Sunday evening. His mount drifted in steadily throughout the first half of the race with Alberto making no attempt to correct his wayward path. He was warned that had his mount bothered anyone he would most assuredly have received days.

JOCKEY RAMON SANCHEZ IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR FAILURE TO FULFILL HIS RIDING ENGAGEMENT AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2011, A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1872 (FAILURE TO FULFILL JOCKEY AGREEMENT).

The foregoing ruling was issued after jockey Sanchez failed to fulfill his commitment in the third race Sunday evening. He explained that his flight was late arriving from Phoenix.

(2) DOMINGO RAMIREZ HEARING

Exercise rider Domingo Ramirez was in to address a ticket he received last evening for intoxication. Testimony was given by Supervising Senior Investigator Tom Blake, Senior Investigator Dennis Drulias and Los Alamitos Security Chief Rick Castaneda. All testified that Domingo had admitted to having consumed several alcoholic beverages during the day. At the time he was questioned he had been engaged in saddling and taking horses to the gate. Domingo consented to a drug test which was negative. Management has barred subject from the property until a formal case can be filed.
