11/22/2011

(1) DUTY STEWARD

Three races were offered CAL-BRED, none of which filled. The second race in the book for maidens, two years old, claiming price \$8,000, going 300 yards, was used open with two CAL-BRED preferred. Sub 1 for two year olds, claiming price \$8,000, going 330 yards, had one CAL-BRED entry. Sub 6 for three year olds and upward, claiming price \$8,000, going 330 yards, failed to attract an entry.
