(3) OLIVERA RULING

RULING #13

JOCKEY JUAN MANUEL OLIVERA WHO RODE "WARRIOR FOR THE CROWN" IN THE FIRST RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 1, 2012, IS SUSPENDED THREE (3) RACING DAYS (JANUARY 13TH, 14TH AND 15TH, 2012) FOR FAILURE TO MAKE THE PROPER EFFORT TO MAINTAIN A STRAIGHT COURSE, CAUSING INTERFERENCE. A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1699 (RIDING RULES - CARELESS RIDING).

THE TERM OF THIS SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES IN CALIFORNIA.

After meeting with jockey Olivera concerning his ride in the first race Sunday evening the above ruling was issued. Juan's mount drifted from post #9 to the middle of the track with no effort by Juan to rectify the situation. Although #6 was bothered the outcome of the race was not compromised.

(4) NO PROBLEMS

Other than a bit of fog blanketing the ground for the final race, Friday evening was problem free.
