Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of May 29, 2012 through June 3, 2012.

TUESDAY

05/29/2012

(1) DUTY STEWARD

James Dreyer will be responsible for morning entries and will record the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fourth race in the book for Friday, maiden three and four year olds, was called off with three (1 CAL-BRED). The seventh race in the book, three and up for a claiming price of \$4,000 received no entries.

THURSDAY

05/31/2012

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratch time was completed at 9:00 a.m. resulting in one rider change.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

Sunday's third race, maiden fillies two years old, was called off with three (1 CAL-BRED).

Sub 3 in the book, three year olds for a claiming price of \$8,000, was called off with one (1 CAL-BRED).

(3) THE DRAW

A late draw resulted in three Thoroughbred and six Quarter Horse races.

FRIDAY

(1) SCRATCHES

One rider change was the only adjustment to Sunday's program.

(2) FILMS

Apprentice Osvaldo Macias was in to review the first race Sunday. Down the backstretch his mount was running a bit erratically. Although he caused minimal damage the Stewards warned him that we expect a better effort on his part to control his mounts.

(3) ABEL RAMIREZ VISITS

Jockey Ramirez failed to arrive in time to fulfill his engagement on Saturday evening for which he was fined. To compound the situation he did not show up the next day to explain himself. For that he was told that if he wants to continue riding here he needs to change his attitude.

(4) FILMS

Jockey Guillermo Suarez was in to address his disqualification in the fourth race Sunday evening. The horse ducked in so quickly the Stewards felt there was not much Suarez could have done to alleviate the situation.

(5) JONES VS. BECK

A formal hearing was held today to address case #12LA0095. Present were trainer Paul Jones, Dr. Gary Beck, Senior Investigator Dennis Drulias, Security Guard Jorge Avina, receiving barn custodian Peggy Lighthill, receiving barn tester John Lynch, Court Reporter Barbara Weinstein, and Stewards Albert Christiansen, George Slender, and James Dreyer. Paul Jones testified that he went to the Receiving Barn to discuss a horse Dr. Beck had put on the Vet's List. Jones said he knocked on Dr. Beck's door and entered his office. He said Dr. Beck proceeded to stick his finger in Paul's face, told him not to pound on his door and began swearing at him. At this point Paul admitted to knocking several items on Beck's desk to the floor. Dr. Beck at that point asked Guard Avina to come to his office. Avina testified that upon his intervention the situation seemed to temper somewhat. Peggy Lighthill and John Lynch shed very little light on the situation, claiming they were not in close enough proximity to hear the exchange. After all testimony was heard, Mr. Jones was advised a decision would be forthcoming within a couple of days.
