Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of September 4, 2012 through September 9, 2012.

TUESDAY

09/04/2012

(1) DUTY STEWARD

George Slender will be present for morning duties and shall record the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The second race in the condition book was called off with two entries and went open. Sub #5 was off with one entry.

(3) THE DRAW

Nine races were carded for Friday night's program which consisted of two Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse races. The draw was completed at 4:00 p.m.

WEDNESDAY

09/05/2012

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratch time for Friday was conducted promptly at 9:00 a.m.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fifth race in the book was called off with zero entries. Also the sub #5 was off with one entry.

(3) THE DRAW

Eight races were drawn for Saturday's racing card consisting of two Thoroughbred and six Quarter Horse contests. The draw was completed at 4:15 p.m.

THURSDAY

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratch time for Saturday was conducted promptly at 9:00 a.m.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

Both CAL-BRED races for Sunday's racing card were called off due to insufficient entries.

(3) THE DRAW

One Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse races will make up Sunday's program. The draw was completed at 4:00 p.m.

FRIDAY

09/07/2012

(1) SUAREZ RULINGRULING #141

JOCKEY GUILLERMO SUAREZ IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR FAILURE TO FULFILL HIS RIDING ENGAGEMENT AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 7, 2012. A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1872 (FAILURE TO FULFILL JOCKEY AGREEMENT).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Suarez informed the Stewards that he would not be able to fulfill his riding engagements due to being overweight.

(2) FINANCIAL RESOLVED

A complaint for \$289.00 for veterinary services tendered against trainer Steve Miyadi has been satisfied when subject paid in full.

(3) RODRIGUEZ RULINGRULING #142

TRAINER YANET RODRIGUEZ WHO STARTED THE HORSE "FAMOUS FURY" IN THE THIRD RACE ON JULY 20, 2012, AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE IS FINED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1887(A) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1843 (A&D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES), #1844 (C-1) (AUTHORIZED MEDICATION - PHENLBUTAZONE IN EXCESS OF PERMITTED LEVEL OF 2.0 UG/ML (3.47 UG/ML - CLASS IV).

Trainer Yanet Rodriguez appeared to address the above referenced complaint. She waived her rights to a formal hearing. She stated that there was a mix-up between her grooms and the veterinarian but denied any wrongdoing by her vet. She emphasized that she will personally oversee all medications. The Stewards informed Ms. Rodriguez that she should be doing that in the first place.

(4) SEVENTH RACE – INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE

Following the running of the seventh race the Stewards immediately posted the Inquiry sign to review an incident near the ¼ pole. Tapes show #6 "Si Mar's Dear" (jockey A. Bautista – Tr. G. Morales) while trailing the field and in the clear broke down and unseated her rider. As no other horses were involved, the race was declared official.

Jockey Bautista appeared to be okay and walked back to the Jockey's Room. Later he was removed from his remaining mount complaining of a sore wrist. Unfortunately #6 "Si Mar's Dear" was euthanized. There was a claim in for #6, which was voided.

(5) LATE DECLARATION - REFUND

A refund was ordered in the ninth race when Track Veterinarian Dr. Tom Hackathorn reported that #2 "Man Of Mine" (Tr. D. Givens) was unsound. Declared by the Stewards. Refund: \$11,148.00.

(1) THIRD RACE – INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE

Following the running of the third race the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to review an incident at the start involving #7 “Swiss Guard” (jockey R. Guce – Tr. J. Avalos) who stumbled badly at the start and lost his rider. No injury to rider or horse. No action by the Stewards was warranted.

(2) SIXTH RACE – INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE

The Inquiry was posted following the sixth race to review an accident midway into the race. #5 “An Warm Corona” (jockey G. Arriaga – Tr. F. Gonzalez) while racing in the clear broke down and fell rolling over the rider. The track ambulance was quickly on the scene transporting Arriaga to Los Alamitos General Hospital for observation. Track Veterinarian Dr. Tom Hackathorn indicated that the horse suffered a spinal injury and had to be put down.

After reviewing the incident the Stewards made no change in the placings.
