Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of October 16, 2012 through October 21, 2012.

TUESDAY

10/16/2012

(1) DUTY STEWARD

George Slender will be present for morning duties and shall record the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The third race in the condition book was called off with four entries. Sub #1 was off with two entries.

(3) THE DRAW

Nine races were carded for Friday night's program which consisted of four Thoroughbred and five Quarter Horse races. The draw was completed at 3:45 p.m.

WEDNESDAY

10/17/2012

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratch time for Friday was conducted promptly at 9:00 a.m.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fifth race in the condition book was off with zero entries. The eighth race was called off with four entries.

(3) THE DRAW

Nine races were carded for Saturday night's program which consisted of one Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse races. The draw was completed at 3:15 p.m.

THURSDAY

10/18/2012

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratch time for Saturday was conducted promptly at 9:00 a.m.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

There were no CAL-BRED races offered on this date due to eleven races drawn for the Golden State Million Futurity Trials.

(3) THE DRAW

Eleven races were drawn for the futurity trials. The draw was completed at 12:00 p.m.

FRIDAY

10/19/2012

(1) EARLY PROGRAM SCRATCHES

4th Race - # 6 Berkley Gal (Tr. D. Montes) entered back, Stewards.
Refund: \$155.00.

8th Race - # 1 Dream The Day Away (Tr. G. Morales) injured, Dr. Hackathorn.
Refund: \$373.00.

(2) ALLEN RULINGRULING #164

TRAINER ROBERT W. ALLEN IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES # 1843 (c) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES) AND #1864 (LABELING OF MEDICATIONS).

The above ruling was issued after subject was afforded a hearing. California Horse Racing Board Investigator Tom Blake presented the case.

At issue was the unlabeled bottle of tablet form of acepromazine. Mr. Allen offered he bought the bottle two years ago and had a receipt which he produced but admitted it was not labeled.

(3) JOINER RULINGRULING #165

TRAINER CODY JOINER, WHO STARTED THE HORSE "ALL OUT ARROGANT" IN THE NINTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON AUGUST 25, 2012, IS FINED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1887 (A) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1843 (A&D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES - METHOCARBAMOL).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Joiner appeared to address the above referenced complaint. Subject who has a clean record could only surmise that his assistant trainer was not present to oversee the preparation prior to bringing the horse over and that his groom inadvertently grabbed the wrong syringe in rinsing the horse's mouth out.

(4) GOMEZ RULINGRULING #166

TRAINER JAIME GOMEZ WHO STARTED THE HORSE "ONE FAMOUS FIRE" IN THE FOURTH RACE ON SEPTMEBER 15, 2012, AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE IS FINED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1887(A) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1843 (a, b, & d) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES), #1844 (a & c-2) (AUTHORIZED MEDICATION - FLUNIXIN IN EXCESS OF PERMITTED LEVEL OF 20 NG/ML (32.3 NG/ML - CLASS IV).

Subject was afforded a hearing. Gomez stated that he never used banamine on this horse and has no idea how he could have received it. Exception being, that he had another horse in a different race who races on banamine and that it was quite possible it could have inadvertently been given to the wrong horse.

(5) SIXTH RACE – JOCKEY OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

Following the running of the sixth race jockey Joel Cruz who rode #2 "Seventy East" who finished sixth, lodges a claim of foul against #3 "AEG Corona Dash" for alleged interference near the finish. After a review of the films and speaking with the riders involved it was a unanimous decision to let the original order of finish stand due to the fact the films did not verify the claim of foul.

5th Race - # 6 Shady Votes (Tr. K. Craigmyle) sick, Dr. Hackathorn.

(2) FORMAL HEARING

A formal hearing was conducted to address California Horse Racing Board complaint #12LA0191. The case involves an alleged positive for clenbuterol. The respondent at the hearing was the trainer of record Guillermo Morales who was represented by his attorney Mr. John Cogorno. Also present were Supervising Investigator Tom Blake who presented the case for the California Horse Racing Board, the Board of Stewards and Court Reporter Michelle Derieg who recorded the proceedings. Argument was presented by both parties, exhibits marked, examination of witnesses completed and the record was closed. Decision in the matter to follow.

(3) PURSE REDISTRIBUTIONRULING #167

ACTING UPON A REPORT FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA DAVIS, AN OFFICIAL TESTING LABORATORY OF THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD THAT BLOOD AND URINE SAMPLES #LA21290, TAKEN FROM THE HORSE "MTC AINT HE COOL", THE SECOND PLACE FINISHER IN THE SIXTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON AUGUST 10, 2012, TESTED POSITIVE FOR CLENBUTEROL (CLASS III). IT IS ORDERED THAT "MTC AINT HE COOL" BE DISQUALIFIED FROM ALL PURSE MONIES EARNED IN SAID RACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1859.5 (DISQUALIFICATION UPON POSITIVE TEST).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT ALL PURSE MONIES (\$1,485) EARNED BY OWNER S AND S HORSES, TRAINER GUILLERMO MORALES AND JOCKEY SANTIAGO MENDEZ BE RETURNED TO THE PAYMASTER OF PURSES AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE BY NOVEMBER 19, 2012 FOR REDISTRIBUTION PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1760 (PURSE AWARD OR PRIZE TO BE WITH HELD)

REVISED ORDER OF FINISH IS AS FOLLOWS:

1ST	FLOOR BURN
2ND	VIVID MEGAN
3RD	SRQH STYLINMOCHAMAN
4TH	IMROCKN

ALL RECORDS ARE ORDERED TO REFLECT THIS RULING IN ACCORDANCE WITH CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1956 (RACE DECLARED OFFICIAL), THIS RULING SHALL NOT AFFECT THE PARI-MUTUEL PAYOFFS.

This ruling was issued in conjunction of the formal hearing for trainer Guillermo Morales' positive clenbuterol test.

(4) GOMEZ RULINGRULING #168

EXERCISE RIDER ADRIAN GOMEZ IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* AND PLACED ON PROBATION FOR ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF THIS RULING FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1890 (POSSESSION OF CONTRABAND) AND #1902 (CONDUCT DETRIMENTAL TO HORSE RACING).

FURTHERMORE, ADRIAN GOMEZ SHALL SIGN A TEST AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD.

The foregoing ruling was issued after subject was afforded a hearing. California Horse Racing Board Investigator Tom Blake presented the case.

At issue was the contraband found in a storage tack room. This consisted of old syringes and three cigarette lighters. Gomez stated that none of the contraband was his and was left there from a previous trainer who moved out. Subject was tested, which proved negative. Also, subject has a clean record.

(5) THIRD RACE – INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE

Following the running of the third race the Stewards immediately posted the Inquiry sign to review an incident shortly after the start. Tapes show while racing in the clear #5 “Jolly First Toll SA” (jockey Saul Ramirez, Jr.) stumbled and unseated her rider. No injury to rider or horse. Therefore, the race was made official.

(6) EIGHTH RACE – INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of the eighth race (Quarter Horse– 300 yards) to review an incident at the start and again near the 1/16 pole. Involved were #6 “This Partys Fire” (2nd – jockey S. Mendez) and #5 “Gone With A Win” (6th – jockey R. Guce).

After speaking with the riders involved and reviewing the tape replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to disqualify #6 from second to sixth position. Tapes reflect #6 ducking in at the start bumping #5 off stride then again near the 1/16 pole drifting in and again causes #5 to take up and lose an opportunity of better placement.

(1) MORALES RULING

RULING #169

TRAINER GUILLERMO MORALES WHO STARTED THE HORSE "MTC AINT HE COOL" IN THE SIXTH RACE ON AUGUST 10, 2012, AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE IS SUSPENDED FOR SIXTY (60) DAYS (OCTOBER 26, 2012 THROUGH DECEMBER 24, 2012) AND FINED THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00)* PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1887 (A&B) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE), #1843 (A,B&D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES - CLENBUTEROL) AND #1859.5 (DISQUALIFICATION UPON POSITIVE TEST).

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF GUILLERMO MORALES ARE SUSPENDED, AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE) SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

The above ruling was issued after evaluating the information from yesterday's formal hearing. The penalties for medication violations (California Horse Racing Board Rule #1843.3) were adhered to in reaching this decision.

(2) FIRST RACE – LATE DECLARATION - REFUND

A refund was ordered in the first race when #8 “Fall For Me” (jockey G. Arriaga) became

fractious in the starting gate and injured himself. Declared on recommendation of Track Veterinarian Dr. T. Hackathorn. Refund: \$10,086.00.
