OWNER DORA CORELLA-CRUZ HAVING NOW SATISFIED THE OUTSTANDING FINANCIAL OBLIGATION TO EQUINE SPORTS MEDICINE, THE LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF DORA CORELLA-CRUZ ARE RESTORED AND LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE RULING # 183, DATED NOVEMBER 17, 2012, SUSPENDING DORA CORELLA-CRUZ FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1547(FAILURE TO APPEAR), IS SET ASIDE.

The above ruling was issued after receiving confirmation that the debt to Equine Sports Medicine had been satisfied.

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF JIM HERNANDEZ ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE) SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Hernandez failed to appear to answer charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1876.

PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1766 (DESIGNATED RACES), JOCKEY ANTONIO ALBERTO, HAVING PARTICIPATED IN A DESIGNATED RACE IN TEXAS ON FRIDAY, DECEMBER 7, 2012, SHALL SERVE AN ADDITIONAL SUSPENSION DAY – FRIDAY, DECEMBER 14, 2012, IN ORDER TO SATISFY THE TERMS OF L.A.Q.H. RULING # 185, DATED NOVEMBER 17, 2012.

The foregoing ruling was issued after jockey Antonio Alberto participated in a designated race in Texas while under suspension.

(2) FIRST RACE – INQUIRY – NO CHANGE

The Stewards posted the Inquiry following the first race to review the run into the turn. Jockey Gerardo Gavica on #5 (2<sup>nd</sup>) argued that #7 “C’m on Marquis” (1<sup>st</sup> – D. Navarro) dropped in on him going into the turn. The films failed to substantiate that contention. It appeared to the Stewards that Gavica’s mount was running out and no change was warranted.
