Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of July 9, 2013 through July 14, 2013.

TUESDAY

07/09/2013

(1) DUTY STEWARD

Ruben Moreno will be on duty this week, attending to morning office matters and recording the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) ENTRIES AND DRAW

Nine races were drawn for Friday night's card consisting of three Thoroughbred and six Quarter Horse events. The draw was completed at 1:40 p.m.

(3) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fourth race in the book for Friday, California-bred maidens, three and four year olds, claiming price \$12,500, going 300 yards, failed to fill with no entries. The eighth race in the book for Friday, the Governor's Cup Derby for California-bred three year olds, going 400 yards, was split into two races with eight entries in each trial division.

WEDNESDAY

07/10/2013

(1) SCRATCHES

Friday scratches were taken at 9:00 a.m. resulting in no scratches, no rider changes and one equipment change.

(2) ENTRIES AND DRAW

Nine races were drawn for Saturday night's card consisting of one Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse events. The draw was completed at 11:45 p.m.

(3) CAL-BRED REPORT

The second through ninth races in the book for Saturday, all trials for the Governor's Cup Futurity for California-bred two year olds, going 350 yards, filled with sixty-one entries split among eight races.

THURSDAY

07/11/2013

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratches for Saturday were held at 9:00 a.m. resulting in no scratches, one rider change and no equipment changes for Saturday evening's program.

(2) ENTRIES AND DRAW

Nine races were drawn for Sunday night's card consisting of three Thoroughbred and six Quarter Horse events. The draw was completed at 1:15 p.m.

(3) CAL-BRED REPORT

The first race in the book for Sunday, California-bred maiden two year olds, claiming price \$12,500, going 300 yards, failed to fill with only two entries. Sub #2 in the book for Sunday, California-bred maiden three year olds and upwards, claiming price \$4,000, going 330 yards, also failed to fill with only two entries.

FRIDAY

07/12/2013

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratches for Sunday were held at 9:00 a.m. resulting in one scratch, one rider change and no equipment changes for Sunday evening's program.

(2) TORRES RULING

Apprentice Jockey Devan Torres appeared before the Stewards to review replays of his ride in the third race on Sunday, July 7, 2013 where his mount #6 "Wallbanger" drifted in excessively at the head of the far turn, causing #3 "Excessive Pride" with jockey Cheryl Charlton aboard to alter course to avoid incident. Torres' mount "Wallbanger" was disqualified.

RULING #107

APPRENTICE JOCKEY DEVAN TORRES WHO RODE "WALLBANGER" IN THE THIRD RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON SUNDAY, JULY 7, 2013, IS SUSPENDED THREE (3) RACING DAYS (JULY 19TH, 20TH, AND 21ST, 2013) FOR CAUSING INTERFERENCE RESULTING IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF HIS MOUNT FROM FIRST TO SIXTH POSITION. A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1699 (RIDING RULES – CARELESS RIDING).

THE TERM OF THIS SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES IN CALIFORNIA.

(3) CAMARGO INFORMAL HEARING

Mr. Damien Camargo appeared to address California Horse Racing Board case #13LA0161 concerning nonpayment of training bills owed to trainer Tom Bazley. Both parties were in agreement as to the amount owed, and terms were worked out whereby Mr. Camargo was given three weeks to satisfy the bill. An agreement was signed by both parties to this effect.

(4) GOOD EVENING

Friday evening's program of nine races were completed without a reportable incident.

(5) VOIDED CLAIM

The third race claim of #3 "Feature Miss America" (Tr. G. Morales) by trainer Paul Jones was voided after an early evening veterinarian scratch by Dr. Hackathorn due to colic.

SATURDAY

07/13/2013

(1) SECURITY VIOLATION

Exercise rider Carlos Gomez was in before the Stewards with his interpreter concerning a security violation. Mr. Gomez had been photographed by security personnel accepting money from trainer Jaime Gomez. Security personnel perceived Mr. Carlos Gomez was selling jockey whips for which a vendor's license would be needed. While Mr. Carlos Gomez admitted that he sold jockey whips to various parties, he stated that these transactions always occurred off the grounds of Los Alamitos Race Course. Mr. Gomez claimed the money he was photographed taking was for fly spray that he was to purchase at a feed store in Norco, CA for trainer Jaime Gomez. Lacking evidence to support the security violation, a stern warning was given to Mr. Carlos Gomez to be careful in the future and that a vendor's license would be necessary for any transactions on Los Alamitos Race Course premises.

(2) SEVENTH RACE – OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

The Inquiry sign was posted after the running of the seventh race as trainer Jose De La Torre objected to #2 "Fire Cliff" (2nd – R. Aceves) bumping his horse #3 "Crystal Sola On Fire" (6th – E. Nicasio) at the start. Taped replays showed #2 "Fire Cliff" breaking out at the start but also showed #3 "Crystal Sola On Fire" hopping away from the gate and breaking in. After review and discussion, the Stewards unanimously ruled that both horses contributed to the incident and that no change would be made to the order of finish.

SUNDAY

07/14/2013

(1) GOOD EVENING

Sunday evening's program of nine races were completed without a reportable incident.

(2) VOIDED CLAIMS

3rd Race – Trainer Charles Treece's \$2,500 claim for #2 "Morning Frost" (Tr. M. Ingebritson) was voided when jockey Joel Cruz refused to ride "Morning Frost," stating the horse felt unsound as he approached the starting gate. Track Veterinarian Dr. Hackathorn called in the scratch to the Stewards pre-race from the gates. "Morning Frost" was later examined at the Receiving Barn by Dr. Beck and deemed sound and returned to trainer Mark Ingebritson's barn.

3rd Race - Trainer Justin Clark's \$2,500 claim on #5 "Random Luck" (Tr. S. Rodriguez) was voided by the Stewards after Veterinarian Dr. Gary Beck's examination of the five year old mare at the Receiving Barn post-race found her to be unsound.

"Random Luck" was placed on the Veterinarian's List and returned to trainer Santiago Rodriguez's barn.
