Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of November 12, 2013 through November 17, 2013.

TUESDAY

11/12/2013

(1) **DUTY STEWARD**

Ruben Moreno will be on duty this week attending to morning office matters and recording the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) **ENTRIES AND DRAW**

Nine races were drawn for Friday night's card consisting of three Thoroughbred and six Quarter Horse events. The draw was completed at 1:00 p.m.

(3) **CAL-BRED REPORT**

The seventh race in the book for Friday, California-bred three year olds and upward, claiming price \$10,000, going 330 yards, failed to fill with one entry (1 CAL-BRED). Sub #2 in the book, also for Friday, California-bred two year olds, claiming price \$16,000, going 330 yards, failed to fill with three entries (3 CAL-BREDS).

(1) **SCRATCHES**

Friday scratches were taken at 9:00 a.m. resulting in no scratches, no rider changes and no equipment changes for Friday evening's program.

(2) **ENTRIES AND DRAW**

Nine races were drawn for Saturday night's card consisting of five Thoroughbred and four Quarter Horse events. The draw was completed at 12:45 p.m.

(3) **CAL-BRED REPORT**

The first race in the book for Saturday, California-bred maidens, two year olds, claiming price \$4,000, going 330 yards, failed to fill with three entries (3 CAL-BREDS). Sub #2 in the book also for Saturday, California-bred two year olds, which have never won three races, allowance, going 330 yards, failed to fill with no entries (0 CAL-BREDS).

THURSDAY
11/14/2013

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratches for Saturday were held at 9:00 a.m. resulting in two also-eligible scratches, no rider changes, and no equipment changes for Saturday evening's program.

(2) ENTRIES AND DRAW

Nine races were drawn for Sunday night's card consisting of five Thoroughbred and four Quarter Horse events. The draw was completed at 1:30 p.m.

(3) CAL-BRED REPORT

The sixth race in the book for Sunday, California-bred maidens, three years old and upward, going 300 yards, failed to fill with four entries (4 CAL-BREDS). Sub #1 in the book for Sunday, California-bred two year olds, claiming price \$4,000, going 330 yards, also failed to fill with no entries (0 CAL-BREDS).

FRIDAY
11/15/2013

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratches for Sunday were held at 9:00 a.m. resulting in no scratches, no rider changes and no equipment changes for Sunday evening's program.

(2) RUBIO RULING

Jockey Francisco Rubio appeared before the Stewards with his valet/interpreter, Pepe Magana, to review his disqualification in the fourth race on Sunday, November 10, 2013 in which his mount, #4 "Kiddychan" impeded #3 "Lavish John D" away from the gates and then at the 1/8th pole drifted in, causing "Lavish John D" to almost clip heels. Jockey Rubio had very little to say in defense of his ride. It was pointed out to Jockey Rubio that he was a better rider than his effort demonstrated. The Stewards unanimously agreed to the following ruling:

RULING #159

JOCKEY FRANCISCO C. RUBIO WHO RODE "KIDDYCHAN" IN THE FOURTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 10, 2013, IS SUSPENDED THREE (3) RACING DAYS (NOVEMBER 22ND, 23RD AND 24TH, 2013) FOR FAILURE TO MAKE THE PROPER EFFORT TO MAINTAIN A STRAIGHT COURSE, CAUSING INTERFERENCE RESULTING IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF HIS MOUNT FROM THIRD TO EIGHTH POSITION. A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1699 (RIDING RULES – CARELESS RIDING).

THE TERM OF THIS SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES IN CALIFORNIA.

(1) TORRES FILM REVIEW

Jockey Devan Torres was in to review his ride in the first race on Friday, November 15, 2013 aboard #7 "Tribal Brat" in which his mount bumped #4 "Rags For Ben" at the head of the turn while ducking away from a left-handed whip. Jockey Torres had no explanation as to why "Tribal Brat" reacted to the whip in the manner he did. The Stewards pointed out to Jockey Torres that the difference between run-of-the-mill riders and top riders is their ability to respond quicker to correcting their mounts. No penalty was warranted.

RULING #160

ACTING UPON A REPORT FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA DAVIS, AN OFFICIAL TESTING LABORATORY OF THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD THAT URINE SAMPLE# LA24368, TAKEN FROM THE HORSE "MY CHARMING CHANCE", THE SECOND PLACE FINISHER IN THE SECOND RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON OCTOBER 6, 2013, TESTED POSITIVE FOR CLENBUTEROL (CLASS III). IT IS ORDERED THAT "MY CHARMING CHANCE" BE DISQUALIFIED FROM ALL PURSE MONIES EARNED IN SAID RACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1859.5 (DISQUALIFICATION UPON POSITIVE TEST).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT ALL PURSE MONIES (\$1,985.00) EARNED BY OWNER JESUS J. URANGA, TRAINER JOSE A. MORENO AND JOCKEY DIONICIO NAVARRO BE RETURNED TO THE PAYMASTER OF PURSES AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE BY DECEMBER 17, 2013 FOR REDISTRIBUTION PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1760 (PURSE AWARD OR PRIZE TO BE WITH HELD)

RULING #161

ACTING UPON A REPORT FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA DAVIS, AN OFFICIAL TESTING LABORATORY OF THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD THAT URINE SAMPLE# LA24353, TAKEN FROM THE HORSE "SURE FIRE FIRST", THE SECOND PLACE FINISHER IN THE FOURTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON OCTOBER 5, 2013, TESTED POSITIVE FOR CLENBUTEROL (CLASS III). IT IS ORDERED THAT "SURE FIRE FIRST" BE DISQUALIFIED FROM ALL PURSE MONIES EARNED IN SAID RACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1859.5 (DISQUALIFICATION UPON POSITIVE TEST).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT ALL PURSE MONIES (\$1,822.00) EARNED BY OWNER ROCIO LUNA RIVERA, TRAINER JOSE A. MORENO AND JOCKEY JUAN P. ANDRADE BE RETURNED TO THE PAYMASTER OF PURSES AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE BY DECEMBER 17, 2013 FOR REDISTRIBUTION PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1760 (PURSE AWARD OR PRIZE TO BE WITH HELD)

The foregoing rulings were issued after Trainer Jose Moreno failed to appear before the Stewards.

(3) GALVAN RULING

Owner/groom Luis Galvan appeared before the Stewards to address a Security violation he had received for leaving his car parked in the stable area. Mr. Galvan stated that his car malfunctioned, necessitating leaving it parked until it could be repaired. The Stewards issued the following fine:

RULING #162

OWNER/ GROOM LUIS GALVAN IS FINED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1530 (CASES NOT COVERED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS – OVERNIGHT PARKING IN BARN AREA).

(4) LOMA RULING

The following ruling was issued after Trainer Humberto Loma admitted to speeding in the barn area while trying to quickly move out of a horse transport's way. Mr. Loma was told that under no circumstances would speeding be permitted in the stable area. The following fine was given:

RULING #163

TRAINER HUMBERTO LOMA IS FINED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1530 (CASES NOT COVERED BY RULES AND REGULATIONS – SPEEDING IN BARN AREA).

(5) VOIDED CLAIM

Trainer Valentin Zamudio's fourth race \$3,200 claim on #7 "Bonos Jeans" (Tr. H. Loma) was voided by the Stewards after Track Veterinarian Dr. Gary Beck's examination of the three-year-old gelding at the Receiving Barn post-race found him to be unsound. "Bonos Jeans" was placed on the Vet's List and returned to Trainer Humberto Loma's barn.

(1) CHARLTON FILM REVIEW

Jockey Cheryl Charlton appeared before the Stewards to review her ride in the sixth race on Saturday, October 16, 2013 aboard #4 "Future Readings." Film review showed her mount, "Future Readings" lugging out and bumping #5 "Captain Camelot" at the 1/8th pole. "Captain

Camelot" went on to win the race thereby negating the incident as to grounds for disqualification. Jockey Charlton offered no explanation as to why the horse lugged out. A warning was issued by the Stewards cautioning Jockey Charlton to make a better effort in the future to maintain a straighter course.

(2) GONZALEZ RULING

RULING #164

TRAINER FELIX L. GONZALEZ IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1895 (TRAINER'S DUTY TO INSURE LICENSED PARTICIPATION).

Trainer Felix Gonzalez was notified via telephone by the Stewards that he would be fined for employing unlicensed help. Trainer Gonzalez affirmed his acceptance of the penalty.
