Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of April 21, 2015 through April 26, 2015.

**TUESDAY**

04/21/2015

(1) **DUTY STEWARD**

Ruben Moreno will be on duty this week attending to morning office matters and recording the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) **ENTRIES AND DRAW**

Eight races were drawn for Friday night's card consisting of three Thoroughbred and five Quarter Horse events. The draw was completed at 1:15 p.m.

(3) **CAL-BRED REPORT**

The third race in the book for Friday, California-bred maidens, three years old and upwards, claiming price \$3,200, going 300 yards, failed to fill with one entry (1 CAL-BRED).

**WEDNESDAY**

04/22/2015

(1) **SCRATCHES**

Friday scratches were taken at 9:00 a.m. resulting in no scratches, two rider changes, and no equipment changes for Friday evening's program.

(2) **ENTRIES AND DRAW**

Nine races were drawn for Saturday night's card consisting of four Thoroughbred and five Quarter Horse events. The draw was completed at 12:00 p.m.

(3) **CAL-BRED REPORT**

The third race in the book for Saturday, California-bred maidens, fillies and mares, three years old and upward, going 300 yards, failed to fill with four entries (4 CAL-BREDS).

**THURSDAY**

04/23/2015

(1) **SCRATCHES**

Scratch time for Saturday night's program was conducted promptly at 9:00 a.m. resulting in two also-eligibles for the fourth race being scratched, no rider changes, and no equipment changes for Saturday evening's program.

(2) **ENTRIES AND DRAW**

Eight races were drawn for Sunday night's card consisting of three Thoroughbred and five Quarter Horse events. The draw was completed at 2:20 p.m.

(3) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fourth race in the book for Sunday, California-bred maidens, three years old and upward, claiming price \$8,000, going 300 yards, went open with five entries (5 CAL-BREDS). Sub #2 in the book also for Sunday, California-bred three year olds and upward, claiming price \$4,000, going 350 yards, failed to fill with no entries (0 CAL-BREDS).

(1) SCRATCHES

Sunday scratches were taken at 9:00 a.m. resulting in no scratches, one rider change, and no equipment changes for Sunday evening's program.

(2) FIFTH RACE – JOCKEY OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

After the finish of the fifth race (Thoroughbred – 4½ furlongs), the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign at the request of Jockey Ramon Guce who was aboard the third place finisher, #3 "Now You're It." Jockey Guce alleged interference at the 3/8<sup>th</sup> pole by the second place finisher, #6 "Warren's Adam" (M. Medina). After reviewing the replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to dismiss the claim of foul. Replays failed to substantiate any wrongdoing.

(1) JONES RULING

RULING #68

TRAINER PAUL C. JONES WHO STARTED THE HORSE "KAY EARTH" IN THE FIFTH RACE ON MARCH 20, 2015, AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE IS FINED SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750.00)\* PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1887 (A) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1843 (A, B, &D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES), #1843.1 (B) (PROHIBITED DRUG SUBSTANCES) AND #1844 (F-4) (AUTHORIZED MEDICATION – DEXAMETHASONE (1,584 pg/ml) IN EXCESS OF PERMITTED LEVEL (5.0 pg/ml – CLASS IV).

The above ruling was issued after Trainer Paul Jones appeared before the Stewards to address the high Dexamethasone level found in "Kay Earth." Trainer Paul Jones stated that he felt there was an error in the administration of medication by his attending veterinarian.

(2) FIRST RACE – JOCKEY OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

Following the running of the first race (Thoroughbred – 4½ furlongs), the Objection sign was posted at the request of Jockey Gary Boag to review an incident at the quarter pole. Jockey Boag on the fourth place finisher, #1 "Monterey Legacy," stated that #4 "Audreys Dolly" (2<sup>nd</sup> – O. Santos), while switching leads, dropped in on him going into the turn. After speaking with the two riders involved and watching film replays, the Stewards felt no change to the order of finish was warranted as film analysis was inconclusive.

(3) SECOND RACE – TWO CLAIMS VOIDED

Two \$5,000 claims were voided in the second race. Trainer Elmer January's claim on #1 "Glorious Rebecca" (Tr. L. Campuzano) and Trainer Anthony Soto's claim for #7 "Hot List" (Tr. C. Treece) were both voided by the Stewards after Dr. Beck's examination of the filly and mare at the Receiving Barn post-race found them to be unsound. Both horses were placed on the Veterinarian's List and returned to their former trainer's barns.

Jockey Omar Santos appeared before the Stewards to address his ride in the first race on Saturday, April 25, 2015 aboard #4 "Audreys Dolley." While watching replays, Jockey Santos stated that "Audreys Dolley" had been wanting to lug in the entire run down the backstretch and then as she entered the turn, switched leads and continued to drift in. While agreeing that his mount was at fault, the Stewards cautioned Jockey Santos that he still needed to make a more determined effort to straighten his mount. No penalty was given.
