10/27/2015

The first race in the book for Friday, California-bred maidens, two years old, claiming price \$4,000, going 300 yards, failed to fill with four entries (1 CAL-BRED).

Friday scratches were taken at 9:00am resulting in one also-eligible scratch, no rider changes, and no equipment changes for Friday evening's program.

(2) ENTRIES AND DRAW

Nine races were drawn for Saturday night's card consisting of two Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse events. The draw was completed at 12:00pm.

(3) CAL-BRED REPORT

The seventh race in the book for Saturday, California-bred three year olds and upward, claiming price \$5,000, going 300 yards, failed to fill with four entries (4 CAL-BREDS). Sub race #1 also for Saturday, California-bred two year olds, claiming price \$5,000, going 330 yards, failed to fill with one entry (1 CAL-BRED).

(3) RANGEL FILM REVIEW & RULING

RULING #176

JOCKEY G. JAIRO RANGEL IS FINED THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP – MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND - SECOND OFFENSE), DURING THE SEVENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON OCTOBER 25, 2015.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Jockey G. Jairo Rangel and the Stewards reviewed film replays of the seventh race on October 25, 2015. Jockey Rangel acknowledged his violation, stating that he forgot about the whipping rule.

(4) GOOD NIGHT OF RACING

Friday night's program of racing was problem-free, making a good night of racing.

(1) SAFETY STEWARD REPLACEMENT

Safety Steward Randy Winick was absent for the evening.

(2) MENDEZ FILM REVIEW & RULING

RULING #177

JOCKEY CRUZ MENDEZ IS FINED THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP – MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND - SECOND OFFENSE), DURING THE SEVENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON OCTOBER 30, 2015.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Jockey Cruz Mendez reviewed the seventh race on October 30, 2015 with the Stewards. Jockey Mendez stated that he was unaware that striking his mount on the shoulder would be included in the three-strike count.

(3) FIFTH RACE – TRAINER’S OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

After the running of the fifth race (Thoroughbred – 4½ furlongs), the Stewards posted the Objection sign at the request of Trainer Robert Lucas. Trainer Lucas alleged that #4 “Storm Bid” (3rd – C. Chaparro) crossed over on #3 “Uncle Luck” (4th – C. Russell) at the 3/16th pole. After reviewing the film replays, the Stewards determined that “Uncle Luck” lugged out and blew the turn, causing his own problems. No change to the order of finish was warranted.

(2) GARCIA RULING

RULING #178

TRAINER MARIO GARCIA, WHO STARTED THE HORSE “PINK BERRETA” IN THE THIRD RACE ON JULY 12, 2015 AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE, IS FINED THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00)* AND SUSPENDED SIXTY (60) DAYS (NOVEMBER 6, 2015 THROUGH JANUARY 4, 2016) PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1887 (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) AND RULE #1859.5 (DISQUALIFICATION UPON POSITIVE TEST) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1843 (A & D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES – BOLDENONE - CLASS III), #1843.1 (B) (PROHIBITED DRUG SUBSTANCES) AND #1902 (CONDUCT DETRIMENTAL TO HORSE RACING).

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF MARIO GARCIA ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE), MARIO GARCIA IS DENIED ACCESS TO PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

Trainer Mario Garcia was notified of the Proposed Decision from the California Horse Racing Board. The results of the decision are reflected in the above ruling.

(3) GONZALEZ RULING

RULING #179

OWNER JOSE MARIA GONZALEZ, WHO STARTED THE HORSE "PINK BERRETA" IN THE THIRD RACE ON JULY 12, 2015 AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE, IS FINED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000.00)* AND SUSPENDED SIXTY (60) (NOVEMBER 1, 2015 THROUGH DECEMBER 30, 2015) DAYS PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1887 (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) AND RULE #1859.5 (DISQUALIFICATION UPON POSITIVE TEST) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1843 (A & D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES – BOLDENONE - CLASS III), #1843.1 (B) (PROHIBITED DRUG SUBSTANCES) AND #1902 (CONDUCT DETRIMENTAL TO HORSE RACING).

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF JOSE MARIA GONZALEZ ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE), JOSE MARIA GONZALEZ IS DENIED ACCESS TO PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

Owner Jose Maria Gonzalez was notified of the Proposed Decision from the California Horse Racing Board. The results of that decision are reflected in the above ruling.

(4) ARVIZU RULING

RULING #180

JOCKEY RODOLFO ARVIZU IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1872 (FAILURE TO FULFILL HIS JOCKEY AGREEMENT) ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 31, 2015.

The above ruling was issued after Jockey Rodolfo Arvizu failed to appear before the Stewards.

(5) PEINADO RULING

RULING #181

JOCKEY OSCAR PEINADO IS SUSPENDED TWO RACING DAYS (NOVEMBER 6TH AND 7TH, 2015) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP – MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND - FOURTH OFFENSE), DURING THE NINTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON OCTOBER 31, 2015.

THE TERM OF THIS SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES IN CALIFORNIA.

The preceding ruling was issued after Jockey Oscar Peinado reviewed replays of the ninth race on Saturday, October 31, 2015. Jockey Peinado was remorseful and explained he was a last minute replacement in the Derby and, per the trainer's instructions, got caught up in riding to win.

(6) FIRST RACE – CLAIM VOIDED

The first race \$2,500 claim of #3 "Lifetime Appeal" by Trainer Charles Treece was voided post-race after the three year old filly was placed on the Vet's List as unsound by Dr. Beck. "Lifetime Appeal" was returned to Trainer Lin Melton's barn.

(7) NINTH RACE INCIDENT

Before the start of the Golden State Million Futurity, four horses broke through the starting gate: #2 "Mi Viejo," #4 "Docs Best Card," #6 "Gotcha Bella," and #8 "Walk Thru Crystal." This mass mutiny was the result of #7 "Fire At Will" flipping in the gate, which caused a chain reaction from the above-mentioned horses. "Fire At Will" was scratched, and the remaining four were reloaded. The race went off without further incident.
