The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Nicasio was informed of his ride in Sunday night's ninth race. Subject abused California Horse Racing Board Rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop – Third Offense).

JOCKEY CODY JENSEN IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP – MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND - FIRST OFFENSE), DURING THE NINTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON NOVEMBER 1, 2015.

The above ruling was issued after Jockey Cody Jensen violated California Horse Racing Board Rule #1688 (b)(6) in the ninth race on November 1, 2015.

The preceding ruling was issued after Jockey Cayetano Chaparro violated California Horse Racing Board Rule #1688 (b)(6) on Friday, November 6, 2015 in the first race. This was his

second offense.

JOCKEY RODRIGO ACEVES IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP – MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND - FIRST OFFENSE), DURING THE EIGHTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2015.

After reviewing Saturday's eighth race with Jockey Rodrigo Aceves, the foregoing ruling was issued. The films confirm violation of Rule #1688 (b)(6). Mr. Aceves had no defense.

(3) ARAGON RULING

RULING #186

JOCKEY CHRISTIAN ARAGON IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP – MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND - FIRST OFFENSE), DURING THE THIRD RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2015.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Jockey Aragon violated Rule #1688 (b)(6) in the third race on November 7, 2015.

(4) FIFTH RACE – JOCKEY OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

Following the fifth race, the Stewards spoke with the jockeys on #3 "Stormy's Blazer" (2nd – R. Guce) and #1 "Silent Code" (3rd – V. Bednar). After speaking to the riders and reviewing the tapes, the Stewards felt the incident did not affect the outcome and elected unanimously to make no change.

TRACK SAFETY REPORT
