**TUESDAY**

05/03/2016

(1) **DUTY STEWARD**

Safety Steward David Nuesch will fill in for the three non racing days this week for ailing Steward Randy Winick, who is out with a bad cold.

(2) **ENTRIES AND DRAW**

Today's entries for Friday's program were drawn at 2:00 p.m., and the eight races attracted 57 horses. The breakdown is five Quarter Horse and Three Thoroughbred races.

(3) **CAL- BRED REPORT**

The seventh race in the condition book for Friday was a Cal-Bred maiden claiming affair for a tag of \$10,000 at 300 yards. This race was called off with two.

**WEDNESDAY**

05/04/2016

(1) **SCRATCH TIME**

This morning scratch time resulted in one rider and one equipment change. There was also a report of a first time gelding.

(2) **ENTRIES AND DRAW**

The eight race program for Saturday was drawn at 1:30 p.m., and the 56 total horses were divided into the following categories, six Quarter Horse, one Quarter Horse Thoroughbred mixed event and one straight Thoroughbred contest.

(3) **CAL- BRED REPORT**

The Cal-Bred race for Saturday, maiden two year olds, claiming price \$8,000 at a distance of 300 yards was called off with only two entries.

**THURSDAY**

05/05/2016

(1) **SCRATCH TIME**

The only changes called for at this mornings scratch time was a blinker change.

(2) **ENTRIES AND DRAW**

The entries for Sunday were drawn at 3:00 p.m. and the eight race program attracted 53 horses. They will be divided between four Quarter Horse and four Thoroughbred events.

(3) CA – BRED REPORT

The Cal-Bred fourth race in the book for maiden three year olds, claiming price \$5,000 at 330 yards failed to fill with only one entrant and was then called off.

**RULING # 108**

IN THE MATTER OF: PEDRO GARCIA

HAVING NOW SATISFIED THE OUTSTANDING FINANCIAL OBLIGATION TO EQUINE SPORTS MEDICINE, THE LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF OWNER PEDRO GARCIA ARE RESTORED AND LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE RULING #9, DATED JANUARY 8, 2016, SUSPENDING PEDRO GARCIA FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1876 (FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY) IS HEREBY SET ASIDE AND PEDRO GARCIA IS RESTORED TO GOOD STANDING.

The above ruling reflects the outstanding financial obligation of owner Pedro Garcia to Equine Sports Medicine being paid in full and he is now restored to good standing.

(1) JOCKEY CROP VIOLATIONS – RULINGS – #109 - #113

The following five rulings reflect various levels of infractions concerning overuse of the riding crop, CHRB rule # 1688 b(6) use of riding crop more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond. These five rulings are between first and third offenses during the allotted sixty day period. Some were increased due to a more serious nature of violation.

**AYALA RULING # 109**

JOCKEY JESUS AYALA IS FINED THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-THIRD OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE TENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON MAY 1, 2016.

**RANGEL RULING # 110**

JOCKEY G. JAIRO RANGEL IS FINED FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-THIRD OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE SEVENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON MAY1, 2016.

**NICASIO RULING # 111**

JOCKEY JOSE NICASIO IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-FIRST OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE FIFTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON MAY 1, 2016.

**ARRIAGA RULING # 112**

JOCKEY MARTIN ARRIAGA IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-SECOND OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE THIRD RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON MAY 1, 2016.

MENDEZ RULING # 113

JOCKEY SANTIAGO MENDEZ IS FINED THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-SECOND OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE SECOND RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON MAY 1, 2016.

(2) GRAYSON COMPLAINT – 16LA0120

Trainer Bobby Wayne Grayson responded to the above complaint telephonically to the Stewards at Los Alamitos Race Track concerning an incident from Sunday, April 17, 2016, in the fourth race. Mr. Grayson had a second time starter maiden in that evening who was treated with lasix, as per his orders. However, it was later learned that the lasix – bleeder request form was never received in the official Veterinarian's office. Mr. Grayson stated that his vet Dr. Patio was let go and hired Dr. Hardgrove to treat his horse with lasix, which she did, all the while Mr. Grayson assumed Dr. Patio turned in the lasix report for him, however he apparently did not. Mr. Grayson took full responsibility for the slip up and realized his mistake in not being on top of this. Official Veterinarian Dr. Beck along with The Stewards agreed to allow this horse to run since he had been treated and it was the trainer's wish to do so. The following ruling was issued to Mr. Grayson.

RULING # 114

TRAINER BOBBY WAYNE GRAYSON IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1845 (A) (AUTHORIZED BLEEDER MEDICATION – CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD FORM 194 WAS NOT RECEIVED BY THE OFFICIAL VETERINARIAN).

(3) NUNEZ COMPLAINT – 16LA0113

Trainer Jesus Nunez appeared before the board of Stewards to answer the above complaint regarding a double NSAID violation following a workout to have a horse removed from the Vet's List. The horse in question, "Hiya Hiya" failed the post workout blood sample and was found to have both Phenylbutazone (Bute) and Flunixin (Banamine) in his system, which is a clear violation of CHRB rules. In addition to both readings, one, the Flunixin (Banamine) was over the allowable level. This is considered a double violation. Mr. Nunez said he doesn't train on or use oral medication in his barn, such as bute or banamine, however he did point out that his vets treated "Hiya Hiya" pre work out with both medications and that it may have been over the limit to show a positive test. We informed Mr. Nunez it is his responsibility to monitor the treatments of his horses and work with his Veterinarians to map out a protocol for compliance. Mr. Nunez said he would do his best in the future. The Stewards told Mr. Nunez they would deliberate on this and return a decision soon. More to follow.

(4) OBJECTION – FIRST RACE – NO CHANGE

The Stewards posted the objection sign following the running of the first race, 870 yards mixed Quarter Horse and Thoroughbreds, at the request of Jockey Branden Boulanger aboard #2 "Paralyzing Eyes (5<sup>th</sup>). Mr. Boulanger claimed that horse #5 "Rockourouky" (1<sup>st</sup> –R. Guce) came in from the four or five path, over in front of him, on about the two path, and cut it very close, causing him to take up and alter course. After looking at all views and angles, the Stewards unanimously decided to make no change to the official order of finish. In the opinion of the Stewards, the incident was two fold. First the coming over and taking up part was minor in nature and secondly it did not have an effect on the order of finish.

(6) VOIDED CLAIMS

There were two claims that were voided tonight for soundness reasons. The first voided claim happened in the fourth race. #5 "All Fired Up" was claimed for \$2,500 out of a 300 yard Quarter Horse race by Jesus Nunez from trainer Charles Treece. The horse was not vanned off, however did return to the receiving barn as unsound, once examined by Official Veterinarian Dr. G. Beck, The horse was therefore returned to trainer Charles Treece.

The second voided claim came in the fifth race, a 4 ½ furlong Thoroughbred event for a claiming

price of \$2,500. #6 "Lana Caprina" also trained by Charles Treece, was claimed by trainer Santos Perez. Jockey Ramon Guce noticed something amiss in the midstretch and eased the horse up just before the finish and jumped off. Lana Caprina was ambulance removed, put on the vet's list and was able to return to the barn of original trainer Charles Treece.

(1) GUERRERO COMPLAINT – 16LA0117

The above complaint is to reflect a decision by the Superior Court of California, Riverside County, in favor of trainer Gail Ruffu for \$5,365.00 on a judgment entered on 3/16/2016 for the purchase of a gelding pony horse named "Big Red". Mr. Guerrero sold Ms. Ruffu the pony horse with the condition that he was sound, and as it turned out, he was not. A Veterinarian exam showed that this horse had chronic injuries that may have been one to two years old, preexisting Mr. Guerrero stated to Ms. Ruffu he was getting out of racing and wanted to sell Big Red.

The Stewards explained to Mr. Guerrero that this was not a hearing per se, that he may not re-argue his case. It is a cut and dried issue that he must pay the amount to Ms. Ruffu or be suspended. The Possibility of a settlement was brought up by Ms. Ruffu, and after a short while an agreement was reached for a lesser amount by Ms. Ruffu with some stipulations. Mr. Guerrero agreed to pay \$2,000 cash, \$500 more in 30 days, plus "Big Red" would be signed over to her. Initially the judge ordered she return the horse to Mr. Guerrero. Both parties were as happy as reasonably expected. Case closed.

(2) DORMAN COMPLAINT – 16LA0121

The above complaint was heard in the Stewards office in an informal manner, approved by both respondents'. Present at this hearing were trainer Frank Dorman, respondent, Senior Supervising Investigator Tom Blake, and the Board of Stewards, Jim Dreyer who was in charge of the proceeding, Tom Ward and Randy Winick. After Judge Dreyer opened the hearing, trainer Ruffu described what brought her to this action. Ms. Ruffu stated that Mr. Dorman had removed articles of hers from a stall that had been assigned to her from the Galway Downs stable Superintendent. Some of these items were damaged, and she requested reimbursement from Mr. Dorman. Mr. Dorman had a different view of this as he said he spoke to the owner of Galway Downs and requested a couple more stalls. In his words he was given the stall previously held by Ms. Ruffu and thought he was entitled to it.

There was a lot of back and forth, he said, she said concerning whose stalls were whose. In the end the Stewards asked if there was a possibility of a reconciliation in this matter. After more banter and talk about things not related to the case, the Stewards were able to get a reimbursement from Mr. Dorman to Ms. Ruffu for \$84.00 and closed the case as resolved.

The following rulings were a result of various incidents' that were addressed yesterday, Saturday, May 7, 2016. The reason that they were not posted until today is that the Stewards were squeezed for time after hearing's and viewing all of the separate issues involved.

RULING # 115

TRAINER JESUS NUNEZ WHO WORKED THE HORSE HIYA HIYA ON APRIL 2, 2016, FOR REMOVAL FROM THE VETERINARIAN'S LIST, IS FINED SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750.00)\* PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1843(A&D)(MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES), #1843.1(B) PROHIBITED DRUG SUBSTANCES), #1844(C)(C2)(AUTHORIZED MEDICATION – MORE THAN ONE APPROVED ANTI-INFLAMITORY DRUG SUBSTANCE ALONG WITH FLUNIXIN IN EXCESS OF AUTHORIZED LIMIT), AND #1866(VETERINARIAN'S LIST).

The above ruling was issued to trainer Jesus Nunez for a double NSAID violation as a result of a post workout blood test. Refer 5/6/16 (4)

RULING # 116

JOCKEY MINOR ARANA WHO RODE WALKIN INDY IN THE SECOND RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON MAY 6, 2016 IS SUSPENDED FOR FIVE(5) RACING DAYS (MAY 14, 15, 20, 21 AND 22, 2016) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1699(E)(RIDING RULES – WILLFULLY STRIKE AT ANOTHER HORSE OR RIDER), PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1766(DESIGNATED RACES), TERM OF SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES IN CALIFORNIA.

The above ruling is a reflection of an incident on Friday evening May 6, 2016 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> race, 4 ½ furlongs. As the field was just past halfway down the back stretch, Mr Arana looked slightly to his right at the horse lapped on him with Jockey Vinnie Bednar and in what appeared to be an intentional move, slapped that horse's nose with his whip. Mr. Arana was and is very apologetic for his loss of control and said he really didn't mean to do it, but perhaps out of frustration of being crowded by his rival he may have momentarily lost his best decision making power and reacted very poorly. It did not appear malicious; however, we explained to Minor that this is absolutely

against the rules of racing not only here but universally. He apologized several times and felt badly. He promised to never do it again.

JOCKEY CHERYL CHARLTON IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-FIRST OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE FIRST RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON MAY 6, 2016.

MORALES RULING # 122

TRAINER GUILLERMO MORALES IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1846(RACING SOUNDNESS EXAMINATION (FAILURE TO PRESENT HORSES FOR PRE-RACE EXAMINATION) AND #1894(DUTIES OF TRAINER).

The above ruling is being issued to trainer Guillermo Morales for four separate violations of not complying with having his horses prepared for the morning soundness exam conducted by Racing Veterinarian Dr. Rebecca Fitzgerald. Guillermo in an interview with the Stewards agreed somewhat with a portion of these incidents, however he thinks there may be some disgruntled actions being taken against him. Dr. Fitzgerald however vehemently disagreed with this assessment. The doctor says this is an ongoing issue with Mr. Morales.
