JOCKEY CESAR DEALBA IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* FOR A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION, WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-SECOND OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE FOURTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON OCTOBER 14, 2016.

After speaking to Jockey Cesar DeAlba and his admission that he was in violation of rule #1688 (b)(6) the foregoing ruling was issued.

(2) Ruling #283

RULING # 283

PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1530(CASES NOT COVERED BY RULES OR REGULATIONS), JOCKEY MARCIAL RAMIREZ IS FINED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* FOR NOT APPEARING AS ORDERED TO FILM REVIEW BY THE STEWARDS.

The above ruling was issued after Jockey Marcial Ramirez failed to attend the films after having been instructed to.

Saturday's entire nine race card was conducted with nothing of significance to report.

(1) RULING #284

RULING # 284

JOCKEY JUAN ANDRADE IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION, WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-FIRST OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE THIRD RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON OCTOBER

15, 2016.

Yet another rider falls prey to Rule #1688(b)(6). Jockey Juan Andrade was in violation of the rule in the third race last evening.

(1) PAUL ATKINSON SUBS

Safety Steward David Nuesch was absent during this three day period to address personal issues in Virginia. He was replaced by Paul Atkinson for the week.

(2) INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION

The stewards posted the inquiry following the first race to review the start. #8 Caydence (7th - C. Huerta) broke in sharply pushing #7 Tarzanita (1st - E. Garcia) into #6 Staggering Stride (8th - R. Acevez) eliminating him. After speaking to the riders involved and a thorough review of the break the Stewards voted unanimously to disqualify Caydence.

(3) INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION

The inquiry was posted by the stewards following the sixth race #6 Time For Stoli (2nd - C. DeAlba) broke and lugged in throughout the race interfering with #5 Keep Walkin (8th - R. Sanchez, #3 Fitz (6th - C. Mendez) and #2 Better Google Me (5th – O. Peinado). Afterpolling the riders involved and examining the disc the stewards voted unanimously to disqualify Time For Stoli.

(4) RIDER CHANGE

Approaching the gate for the ninth race Jockey Rodrigo Aceves was thrown by his mount North Entry after which he refused to ride her. He was replaced by Minor Arana. The stewards instructed the jocks room not to pay Aceves as he refused to ride the filly.

(5) LATE DECLARATIONS

9th – Race #3 Midori Sparkle (D. Ekins) broke through gate. Stewards Refund: \$9919.44.
