

(4) JOCKEY OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

The objection sign was posted after the first race as Minor Arana (10th, #8 Jacq's Cat) lodged a claim of foul against Edgar Orozco (5th, #9 Papa's Lady) for interference on the backstretch. After speaking with the riders involved and reviewing video of the incident the stewards unanimously voted to dismiss the objection as Papa's Lady maintained a straight course and was not involved in the incident. There was a slight shift from the inside horses, but not enough to warrant a disqualification.

(5) STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO START-NO CHANGE

The inquiry sign was posted after the third race as the Stewards reviewed the start of #5 Steaks Horse, with Cesar DeAlba aboard. After reviewing video of the incident the Stewards unanimously voted to declare the horse a "starter". The horse went in the air at the start, causing the rider to lose his balance and fall. It appeared that DeAlba may have hit his head on the crossbar of the gate, but his helmet prevented an injury. He was cleared to ride by the paramedics.

JOCKEY MARCIAL RAMIREZ IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-SECOND OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE FIFTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON NOVEMBER 18, 2016.

This ruling was issued after Mr. Ramirez had viewed the fifth race from last night, during which he violated the "crop" rule. He offered no excuse and accepted the penalty.

(3) VIDEO REVIEW

Jockeys Gallyn Mitchell, Efrain Hernandez, and Jesus Ayala were in the office to review video of the previous night's races. While none of the offenses gave rise to a sanction, all were cautioned to be more alert when leaving the gate and when altering course.

JOCKEY MARCIAL RAMIREZ IS FINED THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-THIRD OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE SIXTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON NOVEMBER 19, 2016.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Ramirez, who obviously either does not understand the "crop" rule, or chooses to ignore it, offered no excuse for another violation. He was just fined the previous evening for the same violation.

(5) RACING FATALITY

Sing Like A Bird, trained by Michael Casselman, was euthanized following the running of the twelfth race by the attending veterinarian.
