07/18/2017

(2) COMPLAINTS #17LA0191, #17LA0197, #17LA0198

A formal hearing was convened this afternoon to address the above referenced cases. Investigator Kevin Kitashima read all of the pertinent data into the record. Afterward the owner's husband, Sergio Lopez, dropped a bombshell stating a hair follicle test had been performed on Winger and it was clear of Clenbuterol. At that point we terminated the hearing to allow the owner the opportunity to get a DNA test to verify that both samples are from the same horse. More to come.

(3) FILMS

Jockey Minor Arana was in to review Sunday's sixth race. From the outside post his mount broke in and continued to drift. The Stewards didn't feel the race was compromised; however we warned Minor to do a better job of maintaining a straight course.

(4) CLAIM VOIDED

The first race claim of Avo by trainer Keith Craigmyle was voided after Dr. Pattio placed the mare on the vet's list as unsound. She was returned to trainer Jesus Nunez.

(5) CLAIM VOIDED

The second race claim of Papa Al by trainer Ramiro Zuazo was voided after being placed on the vet's list as unsound by Dr. Pattio. He was returned to trainer Francis Meza.
