RULING #185

JOCKEY FRANCISCO ORDUNA-ROJAS, WHO RODE "ROYAL SONG" IN THE FOURTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON AUGUST 9, 2020, IS SUSPENDED FOR FIVE RACING DAYS (AUGUST 21ST, 22ND, 23RD, 28TH, AND 29TH, 2020) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1692 (REQUIREMENTS FOR HORSE, TRAINER AND JOCKEY- FAILED TO RIDE THE MOUNT TO THE FINISH, COSTING HIM A PLACING).

PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1766 (DESIGNATED RACES), THE TERM OF SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES.

(6) **RULINGS #186**

RULING #186

PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1900 (GROUNDS FOR SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION), JOCKEY JOSE DOMINGUEZ IS SUSPENDED FOR FIFTEEN DAYS (AUGUST 15, 2020 THROUGH AUGUST 29, 2020) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1489 (A)(8) (GROUNDS FOR DENIAL OR REFUSAL OF LICENSE- ENGAGED IN THE USE OF DRUGS - AMPHETAMINE AND METHAMPHETAMINE). PRIOR TO RE-INSTATEMENT JOSE DOMINGUEZ MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF COMPLETION OF AN IN – HOUSE REHABILITATION PROGRAM ACCEPTABLE TO THE BOARD OF STEWARDS. ADDITIONALLY, JOSE DOMINGUEZ MUST SIGN A TESTING AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD AND MUST REMAIN ON PROBATION FOR AS LONG AS HE HOLDS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD.

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF JOSE DOMINGUEZ ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS TO SUSPEND OR FINE), JOSE DOMINGUEZ IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.
