About 20 yards after the start, #9 DEMOCRACY (Daniel Vergara) veered in and made contact with the hind legs of #8 GOOD LUCK REDD (Martin Pedroza). This action caused #9 DEMOCRACY to bobble and unseat jockey Vergara. DEMOCRACY continued the about 1 1/8 miles riderless.

Jockey Vergara was attended to immediately by human ambulance paramedics. After returning to the jockey room, he was "cleared to ride" by the track physician, Dr. Brown.

Jockey/Driver condition: Good condition. Cleared to ride by track physician, Dr. Brown.Horse condition: Reported to be in good condition by receiving barn personnel.

During the post parade of the 6th race, #1 DREAM SQUAD acted up and unseated jockey Saul Arias. Human ambulance paramedics responded to jockey Arias immediately. Dr. Brown (track physician) reported that Arias had a contusion of the knee and would not be cleared to ride the rest of his engagements on the day's card. He said Arias "would be re-evaluated tomorrow."

#1 DREAM SQUAD was ordered scratched by the Stewards as he was unruly in the post parade warm-up.
