Ruling LATS #053 issued at Santa Anita Park on March 2, 2012 is set aside.

9/06/13²**STEWARDS' INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after the fourth race to review an incident near the 3 ½ pole when the horse #8 FLYING OPEN (E. Maldonado) fell and as a result caused #10 HORSE LAUGH (G. Nicolas) and #4 HITTER'S ALLEY (M. Pedroza) to lose their riders. After speaking to the riders involved, taking into account reports from the patrol judges, and reviewing the video of the race, we voted unanimously to make no change to the original order of finish. The films failed to determine what caused the #8 horse to fall. Jockey Accident Reports attached.

Carreno), drifted out causing the third place horse #8 ASTUTELY (O. Berrio) to take up and lose the opportunity of a better placing. After speaking to the patrol judges and the riders involved, we voted unanimously to disqualify the second place horse, #6, and place him third behind #8 who had lost second place by a head.

SUNDAY9/08/13¹**STEIN HEARING – CASE #13DM0011**

A formal hearing was held this morning on a Complaint filed by the CHRB (case #13DM0011) against trainer ROGER STEIN. The Complaint alleged a Phenylbutazone (3.3 UG/ML) overage on his horse LUCKBOX SAM that ran in the sixth race on July 14, 2013, at Betfair Hollywood Park. Court reporter MICHELLE DERIEG recorded the proceedings and Supervising Investigator RICK AMIEVA represented the CHRB. Mr. STEIN answered the Complaint telephonically. He stated he did not know how the overage occurred but that it would never happen again. Mr. STEIN was issued a warning since he has not had a medication violations in the past 24 months.

9/08/13²**ALZONA RULING – LAFP #002**

Bloodstock agent WILFREDO MUNOZCO ALZONA was suspended for failure to appear to answer a Financial Complaint filed by SERAFIN BARAJAS DELGADILLO alleging ALZONA owed a debt in the amount of \$22,190.00. The following ruling was issued:

Bloodstock Agent WILFREDO MUNOZCO ALZONA, having failed to respond to charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility - \$22,190.00 – SERAFIN BARAJAS DELGADILLO) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Mr. ALZONA are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. ALZONA is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

9/08/13³**JOCKEYS IN**

Apprentice jockey IRVING OROZCO was in our office this morning to explain why he didn't weigh in after the eighth race on Friday. Mr. OROZCO stated he had a troubled trip and he had to explain to his trainer what happened during the race. The young apprentice was very apologetic that he had forgotten to weigh in after talking to his trainer. Decision to follow.

Jockey JORGE CARRENO was in our office to review yesterday's second race in which he was disqualified from second and placed third. Mr. CARRENO had shifted out slightly approaching the finish line causing contact with the outside horse. He stated his horse did shift out slightly and that he did not notice there was a horse just outside of him. Mr. CARRENO was issued a warning but Steward KIM SAWYER voted for a three-day suspension.

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO was also in our office to explain why he failed to make his reported weight for yesterday's fourth and seventh races. Mr. MALDONADO stated

that he couldn't make weight and offered no explanation. The following ruling, LAFP #003, was issued:

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for failure to make his assigned weight in the fourth and seventh races on September 7, 2013. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1682 (Weighing Out, 1st offense).

9/08/13⁴**STEWARDS' INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

Immediately after the first race, the Inquiry sign was posted to review an incident when #2 ARTIE'S FANTASY had broken slowly. After speaking to the starter and reviewing the race, the film showed that the horse was acting up prior to the gates opening. Therefore, no change was made.

9/08/13⁵**CLAIM VOIDED**

Trainer CESAR DOMINGUEZ's horse RUN'N ON RESIDUALS was returned when the gelding was placed on the Vet's List as unsound after the second race. Trainer DREW FULMER was notified that his claim was voided.

9/08/13⁶**STEWARDS' INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the 11th race, the Inquiry sign was posted to review an incident at the quarter pole when horse #4 LETTHETHUNDERROLL lost his rider LUIS MEDINA. After speaking to the patrol judges and reviewing the films, we made no change to the Official order of finish. We noted in the film that the horse stumbled on his own when switching leads. The accident report is attached.

Entering the backstretch #7 GRAND PULPIT straightened out. However, #8 FLYING OPEN fell after appearing to clip the heels of #7 GRAND PULPIT. This unseated jockey Edwin Maldonado. #10 HORSE LAUGH (Gonzalo Nicolas) was trailing the accident and struck #8 FLYING OPEN. This unseated apprentice jockey Nicolas. #4 HITTER'S ALLEY (M. Pedroza), who was off very slowly, attempted to avoid the two other horses, ducked and also unseated jockey Pedroza.

Jockey/Driver condition: Cleared to ride following race by track physician Dr. David Brown

Horse condition: Led back to unsaddling area – walked off – appeared to be in good condition.
