9/11/13¹

URBINA CONTINUANCE

Gateman LEO URBINA appeared to answer a complaint (case number 13DM0046) filed by the CHRB alleging violation of the animal welfare rule. Given the nature of the allegation and the fact that Mr. Urbina might explore retaining counsel, we continued the case in order to secure a court reporter.

9/11/13²

RUSSELL RULING – LAFP #004

Jockey CHRIS RUSSELL was fined after failing to make his reported weight on two separate racing days:

Jockey CHRIS RUSSELL is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) for failure to make his assigned weight in the first race on September 6, 2013, and the seventh race on September 8, 2013, which constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1682 (Weighing Out, 1st and 2nd offenses).

MORRISON RULING – LAFP #005

Owner BRYAN MORRISON was suspended when he failed to appear for a hearing based on a complaint (case number 13DM034) alleging unpaid veterinary expenses:

Owner BRYAN MORRISON, having failed to appear to answer a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility –von Bluecher, Blea, Hunkin Inc., \$3,525.00) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of BRYAN MORRISON are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. MORRISON is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

9/11/13⁴**INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the eighth race we posted the Inquiry sign to examine the stretch run involving the first and third placed finishers. Films revealed that the winner #8 ADDENDUM (E. Maldonado) drifted in and caused the third place finisher to his inside, #1 WILD IN THE SADDLE (I. Orozco), to steady. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved, we unanimously believed that #1 was not cost the opportunity at a better placing and therefore voted to make no change to the original order of finish.

THURSDAY9/12/13¹**GUCE RULING – LAFP #006**

Jockey RAMON GUCE was fined in response to being extremely late to the paddock for the sixth race last Sunday:

Jockey RAMON GUCE is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – late to paddock – 1st offense) for the sixth race at Barretts Race Meet at Fairplex on September 8, 2013.

9/12/13²**AMATEUR JOCKEY MEETING**

We met with the ten women who will be riding in the first race today in the Ladies World Championship Ladies Cup (amateurs). We explained our rules and expectations to these Arabian riders, all of whom have ridden at least three winners.

9/12/13³**ACCIDENT/INQUIRY**

Following the running of the first race, we posted the Inquiry sign to examine the circumstances under which the amateur rider of #2 was unseated shortly after the start. Films revealed that the horse caused her own problem and therefore no change was appropriate. Incidentally, two other riders were unseated (one right before the wire and one right after) during the race. None of the jockeys or horses was injured. Jockey Accident Reports attached.

9/12/13⁴**INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

Following the running of the seventh race, we posted the Inquiry sign to examine an incident in the stretch involving the first two finishers. A review of the video indicated that the second place finisher, #1 FULL CONSENT (M. Pedroza), initially came in and brushed the winner, #3 I BUY GOLD (E. Hernandez). The two drifted apart and then the winner came out and made solid contact with his rival. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved and given the small winning margin (head), we unanimously voted to disqualify the winner and place him second.

FRIDAY9/13/13¹**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey EFRAIN HERNANDEZ came to the office to review his ride in the seventh race yesterday. His horse was disqualified for interference in the lane. Although he drifted and interfered with the second place finisher, we felt that he made a sufficient effort to correct his horse to spare himself suspension days.

Jockey RICARDO JAIME came to the office to discuss his whip use yesterday. We felt that he was allowing his strikes to get a little forward on his mounts. We explained our whip rules, expectations, and that the next infraction would result in a fine.

Jockey MARTIN PEDROZA came to the office to review his ride in the third race yesterday leaving the starting gate. He was cautioned to make the angle of his move to the inner rail less acute. He agreed.

Jockey JORGE CARRENO came to the office to review his ride in the fourth race yesterday during which he allowed his horse to drift in during the stretch run while only marginally clear of a rival. He accepted a warning.

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO came to the office to review his ride in the eighth race on Wednesday after which his mount survived an inquiry for interference in the lane. Films revealed that he allowed his mount to drift in while not clear. The majority cautioned him to maintain a straighter course. (Steward Chaney voted for three suspension days).

9/13/13²**RACING OFFICE RULING – LAFP #007**

The following ruling was published when the racing office inadvertently omitted the claiming price from the overnight and program for an entrant in an allowance optional claimer:

Racing Association BARRETT'S RACE MEET at FAIRPLEX is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1583 (Receipt of Entries and Declarations – omitted claiming price from entry).

9/13/13³**BEDNAR HEARING AND RULING – LAFP #008**

Jockey VINNIE BEDNAR appeared for a formal hearing this morning (case number 13PM0001) with Winners' Foundation representative Bob Fletcher. This case involved a methamphetamine positive discovered in a drug test taken after he failed to show up for two mounts. Mr. Bednar and the CHRB negotiated a stipulated agreement which we approved and memorialized in the following ruling:

Pursuant to the terms of a stipulated agreement with the California Horse Racing Board, the license privileges of jockey VINNIE BEDNAR are revoked; however, the revocation is stayed. Mr. BEDNAR will serve a 30-day suspension from September 7, 2013, through October 6, 2013. Mr. BEDNAR is also fined TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) and placed on probation through September 13, 2015, for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1500.1(a) (Random Drug Testing – use of methamphetamine and amphetamine), 1680 (Jockeys and Drivers to Report), and 1902.

Terms of probation provide that Mr. BEDNAR must submit to an evaluation by the Winners' Foundation by September 18, 2013, and agree to abide by any recommendations from that organization. Further, Mr. BEDNAR must submit to drug testing by the California Horse Racing Board described in the agreement and abstain from any mood altering substances. Failure to abide by the terms of probation and/or the terms of the stipulated agreement may result in the revocation of Mr. BEDNAR's license privileges.

9/13/13⁴**OROZCO RULING – LAFP #009**

The following ruling was issued to jockey IRVING OROZCO when he failed to weigh in after a race on opening day:

Apprentice jockey IRVING OROZCO is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1700 (Returning to Finish After the Race – failure to weigh in after the eighth race on September 6, 2013).

9/13/13⁵**HARRISON COMPLAINT RESOLUTION**

Equine Medical Center withdrew its complaint (case number 13DM051) against owner HAROLD HARRISON when the alleged debt was paid in full.

9/13/13⁶**GARCIA HEARING**

Trainer VICTOR GARCIA appeared for a formal hearing (case number 13DM018) involving phenylbutazone discovered in the post race blood sample of one of his runners. Given the low level and his license history, Mr. Garcia was eligible for and received a warning.

9/13/13⁷**ACCIDENT**

Following the running of the first race, jockey RAMON GUCE was unseated from his mount. The horse was corralled and Mr. Guce was transported to First Aid by the ambulance, complaining of knee pain. The track physician recommended that he be excused from his mounts. Replacement riders were named. Accident report attached.

9/13/13⁸**GATE ACCIDENT**

During the starting gate loading procedure prior to the sixth race, #10 CONCERT MAN became stuck on the rear stall door when he pushed the right half closed as he was entering the gate. The racing veterinarian and gate crew were able to dislodge the horse, which was scratched and sent to the equine clinic with possible broken ribs. We asked the CHRb investigative staff to investigate the incident.

SATURDAY9/14/13¹**MEDINA TEST**

We received a report from the Clerk of Scales and his assistant about an incident in the jockeys' room yesterday involving jockey LUIS MEDINA and a valet. Given his license history and the fact that he is on a testing agreement, we called him in, directed him to submit to a drug and alcohol test and referred the matter to the CHRB investigators.

9/14/13²**LEE RULING – LAFP #010**

Trainer JERRY LEE contacted us this morning and informed us that his horse in the second race had not received lasix. Apparently there was a miscommunication with the veterinarian. We scratched the horse and issued the following ruling:

Trainer JERRY LEE is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1845 (Authorized Bleeder Medication – did not receive lasix), necessitating the late declaration of BROKEN SKY from the second race on September 14, 2013, at Barretts Race Meet at Fairplex.

9/14/13³**INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

We posted the Inquiry sign after the running of the second race to examine an incident between the third and fourth place finishers as the field turned into the stretch. Films revealed that the third place finisher #3 FULL OF SPICE (O. Figueroa) angled out and made contact with fourth place finisher #8 ARA WEST nearly knocking her rider, FELIPE MARTINEZ, off his mount. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved, we voted unanimously to disqualify #3 FULL OF SPICE and place her fourth.

Original order of finish: 5-6-(3)-8-1-2-7

Corrected order of finish: 5-6-8-(3)-1-2-7

9/14/13⁴**INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the sixth race, we posted the Inquiry sign to examine an incident shortly after the start in which jockey MARTIN PEDROZA aboard #7 OUR CLASSIC TRIP was unseated. Films revealed that the #1 (A. Jimenez) drifted out a bit causing a chain reaction in the field. They also revealed that the outside horse #8 (R. Jaime) angled in sharply making hard contact with Mr. Pedroza's mount (#7) causing that horse to stumble and unseat his rider. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved, the majority (Chaney and Jauregui) voted to make no change because in our view, the major cause of the accident (#8) finished last. Steward Sawyer believed that the #1 should be disqualified. See attached accident report.

9/14/13⁵**INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

Following the running of the second race, we posted the Inquiry sign to examine an incident going into the first turn (6.5 furlongs) during which sixth place finisher #2 PAY THE DEBT lugged out badly and interfered with several horses, one which eventually pulled up. After viewing the films and speaking with the patrol judges, we voted unanimously to disqualify the #2 and place him unplaced.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey RICARDO JAIME came to the office to review his ride in the sixth race yesterday. His mount was the subject of an Inquiry. Films revealed, and Mr. Jaime admitted, that he angled in a bit too acutely and was unable to correct his mount in time to prevent a collision. The majority (Sawyer voted for a warning) issued the following suspension:

LAFP #014

Jockey RICARDO JAIME is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (September 21, 22, and 27, 2013) for altering course without sufficient clearance down the backside and causing interference while riding MINE FEVER in the sixth race at Barretts Race Meet at Fairplex on September 14, 2013. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races). Jockey JESUS VELAZQUEZ came to the office to discuss his tardiness to the jockeys' room and the argument with the gate personnel that resulted from the aforementioned tardiness. He accepted the following ruling:

LAFP#012

Jockey JESUS VELAZQUEZ is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1680 (Jockeys and Drivers to Report) and #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – arguing with security).

Jockey OMAR FIGUEROA was represented this morning by ALBERTO DELGADO regarding his ride in the second race yesterday after which his mount was disqualified. Unfortunately, there was little Mr. Delgado could do as Mr. Figueroa was too aggressive in gaining an opening for running room and in the process nearly knocking a fellow rider off his mount. He was issued the following ruling:

LAFP #013

Jockey OMAR FIGUEROA who rode FULL OF SPICE in the second race at Barretts Race Meet at Fairplex on September 14, 2013, is suspended for THREE RACING DAYS (3) (September 21, 22, and 27, 2013) for altering course without sufficient clearance and causing interference which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from second to third position. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).

Jockey ALEX JIMENEZ came into the office as directed in order to discuss his role in the collision in the sixth race yesterday. He was candid in admitting that his horse drifted out a bit leaving the gate but felt that he attempted to correct the horse in a timely

manner. The majority reluctantly agreed (Steward Sawyer voting for three suspension days), and he was therefore issued a warning. He was, however, issued a ruling for taking off his mount today because of a conflict at Los Alamitos.

LAFP #015

Jockey ALEX JIMENEZ is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) for failure to fulfill his riding engagement in the eleventh race at Barretts Race Meet at Fairplex on September 15, 2013. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

GONZALEZ RULING – LAFP #011

The following ruling was issued when jockey SAL GONZALEZ, Jr., missed two mounts because of a travel issue:

Jockey SAL GONZALEZ, Jr., is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) for failure to fulfill his riding obligations in the fourth and ninth races on September 13, 2013, at Barretts Race Meet at Fairplex. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

9/15/13³

GERSON HEARING

We held a formal hearing this morning (case number 13SA071) that was a continuance from a case that started in May. The CHRB filed a Complaint against owner SEAN GERSON concerning the allegation of selling/transporting a substance (canine wormers) across state lines. Apparently, there is a warrant for his arrest and the case continues to linger. We gave Mr. Gerson sufficient time to resolve the warrant and more generally the case itself. He requested a continuance today which was denied, and will most likely be suspended for failure to appear. Ruling to follow.

9/15/13⁴

RIOS HEARING

We held a formal hearing this morning into a complaint (case number 13HP069) against groom HILARIO RIOS who allegedly struck another license with a lead shank. Mr. Rios failed to appear and a ruling will be issued Wednesday.

9/15/13⁵

RIDER INJURED

After the accident noted in the minutes yesterday (refer 9/14/13³), jockey MARTIN PEDROZA was cleared to ride the card this morning by the track physician. Unfortunately, during the warm up for the second race, it became clear the Mr. Pedroza was going to be unable to ride that mount or any of his remaining mounts. The horses were returned to the paddock, the weight was removed, a new rider was named and weighed out, and the race went off without incident. The total delay was seven minutes.

INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

Following the running of the tenth race (Barretts Juvenile), we posted the Inquiry sign to examine several incidents. First, when the gates opened, #10 WILLIE BE AWESOME, refused to beak. Films revealed that the assistant starter let go of the horse and the gates opened properly. After speaking with the starter, we declared the #10 a starter. Second, we examined an incident going into the first turn between the first two finishers. Films revealed that the winner, #5 HI FASHIONED (M. Garcia) lugged out, forcing the second place finisher #6 I EARNED IT BABY (A. Delgadillo) to steady. In our unanimous

opinion, the incident happened at a point in the race where #6 was not cost the opportunity at a better placing. This was reinforced by the fact that #6 actually took over the lead as the field entered the stretch. Lastly, we looked into some bumping between the first two finishers in the stretch. The winner initially came in to make contact with the second place finisher and then both horses came together to make contact again. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved, we felt unanimously that the contact was mostly mutual and that no change was appropriate.
