JOCKEY OBJECTION/SIXTH RACE (6 ½ furlongs-turf)/NO CHANGE

Following the running of the race jockey Edwin Maldonado who rode #1 There Is No Limit (5th) and jockey Martin Garcia who rode # 10 Catienus Gold (4th) both lodged a claim of foul against #9 Mind Eyes (C. Nakatani 1st). After a review of the videos, and conversation with the Patrol Judges and all jockeys involved it was a unanimous decision that the original order of finish be made official. It was the opinion of the Stewards that #1 did take up and shift, and #10 shifted in the stretch run but there were multiple horses involved and that the two riders that claimed foul were not cost the opportunity of a better placing.

PRTS #009

Owner **DANIEL DEROSSI** is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility-Leonard Powell \$7,500.00).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Daniel DeRossi are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528(Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. DeRossi is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. De Rossi failed to abide by a previously signed financial agreement with trainer Leonard Powell, dated September 8, 2012.

O'NEILL HEARING CASE# 12SA150

This complaint was filed by Healing Hope (Holistic Veterinarian Treatments) against trainer Doug O'Neill for an alleged financial violation, pursuant to CHRB rule 1876 (Financial Responsibility). After the complainant failed to appear the case was dismissed. Mr. O'Neill was available for the hearing.

RIVERA HEARING CASE# 12PM022

This complaint was filed by the CHRB against groom Eric Rivera for a possible violation of CHRB rule 1489(h) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License). Mr. Rivera was arrested by the San Diego County Sheriff for 11377(A) H&S (possession of Methamphetamine).

Mr. Rivera appeared with documents from the court verifying he is required to sign up with a deferred justice program within a certain time frame. If he fulfills this requirement his record would be expunged. He was told by the Stewards he needs to show proof he has complied with the court order. More to follow.

INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION/FIRST RACE (1 mile-turf)

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident inside the 1/16 marker. Involved were #2 Buffalo Billy (J. Valdivia 2nd) and #3 McAllister Boys (R. Bejarano 1st). After a review of the videos and conversation with the Patrol Judges and both jockeys involved, it was a unanimous decision to disqualify #3 from 1st and place him 2nd behind # 2. Rafael Bejarano's mount #3 veered out into #2, bumped that one and knocked it off stride costing it the opportunity at a better placing.

BEJARANO RULING (ref. 10/18/12⁵)

During the film review the Stewards discussed with Mr. Bejarano his culpability in the disqualification of his horse. He admitted he made a mistake and took full responsibility for his lack of effort to maintain a straight course. The following ruling was issued:

PRTS #011

Jockey **RAFAEL BEJARANO** who rode "McAllister Boys" in the first race at Santa Anita Park on October 18, 2012, is suspended for THREE (3) RACING DAYS (October 25, 26, and 27, 2012) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch, causing interference which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from first to second position. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules-Careless Riding).

Term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).

PERIBAN HEARING CASE# 12SA158

This complaint was filed by Steve Warner Thoroughbred against trainer Jorge Periban in the amount of \$14,293.00. Mr. Periban had previously signed an agreement with the feed company and has not made a payment since May 2012. Ms. Lisa Brown, Esq. represented Steve Warner Thoroughbred. A new financial complaint agreement was agreed upon and was signed by both parties.
