This ruling was issued after the trainer accepted responsibility for having his horse improperly shod for the turf.

Trainer **DAN L. HENDRICKS** is fined **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations) for failure to have his horse "Lamm" properly shod for the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on October 28, 2012.

Laborer **STEVEN GUERRERO**, having appeared as ordered, is restored to good standing. Ruling PRTS #016, issued at Santa Anita Park on October 25, 2012, is set aside.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Guerrero provided documentation to the Board regarding a conviction which had recently been expunged.

Groom **ERIC RIVERA**, having appeared as ordered, is restored to good standing. Ruling PRTS #013, issued at Santa Anita Park on October 20, 2012, is set aside.

This ruling was issued after Mr. Rivera complied with the conditions which the Board set after a conviction for a drug related offense.

11/01/12⁵**COMPLAINT DISMISSED**

A complaint filed by Assistant Trainer Tirso Limon against Assistant Trainer Julie Barry alleging disorderly conduct and verbal harassment was dismissed as the assertions could not be substantiated. Ms. Barry's cross-complaint against Mr. Tirso was similarly dismissed.

A refund was ordered in the fourth race as #5 Lady Rochelle flipped while being saddled and was declared on the recommendation of Racing Veterinarian Stead. The refund amounted to \$4,437.20.

11/01/12⁷**REFUND**

The Stewards ordered a refund in the fifth race as #2 Light Shine was off in the left hind leg during warm up and was declared after examination by Racing Veterinarian Stead. The amount refunded came to a total of \$67,919.40.

A refund was ordered in the fourth race as #4 South Floyd was off in the left foreleg during warm up and was declared on the advice of Racing Veterinarian Stead. The refund totaled \$472,557.94

STEWARDS' INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign after the fourth race in order to review an incident in the final one sixteenth between the first and second place finishers, #1 Hightail(R. Maragh) and #3 Merit Man(P. Valenzuela). After speaking with the riders involved, taking into account reports from the Patrol Judges and reviewing video of the stretch run the Stewards unanimously voted to make no change to the original order of finish. Video review established that Merit Man was the catalyst in the incident as it drifted in just past the one sixteenth pole, bumping Hightail in the hind quarters and tipping that horse out. Since the second place finisher was responsible for the contact, there was no need for a disqualification.
