PALMA HEARING CASE #13SA082

This case was filed by the CHRB against trainer Hector Palma for alleged violation of CHRB rule 1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse). Mr. Palma was present to discuss the events leading up to the discovery of the horse "Indian Classic" having been gelded without anyone reporting it. It was discovered this horse was no longer a colt in the receiving barn approximately thirty minutes prior to post time. Mr. Palma was very candid; he stated he forgot to report it when making the entry due to other barn issues he was solving at the time. Decision to follow.

LATS #064

Jockey **ESWAN FLORES** is fined **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1680 (Jockey and Drivers to Report-failure to request permission to report late to the Jockeys' Room) and #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers-failure to meet with the Board of Stewards in a timely manner) at Santa Anita Park on March 9, 2013.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Flores met with the Stewards to discuss his failure to report his weight and ask for permission to be late to the jockeys' room, and also his failure to meet with the Stewards when directed to do so. He had no reason for not taking care of his business other than he forgot.

03/16/13² **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Orlando Mojica met with the Stewards to review the fourth race (5 ½-dirt). Mr. Mojica approaching the 3/8's pole, second horse out on the heels of a two horse spread in front of him, had to shift and this caused the horse to his inside to take up. Mr. Mojica was informed that when folding into a turn, if he is not fully up inside of horses to his outside, take back. He stated he understood and would do so in the future.

Jockey Edwin Maldonado met with the Stewards to review the third race (1 mile-turf). Mr. Maldonado drifted out several paths approaching the wire while marginally clear. He was warned that the Stewards expect an effort to maintain a straight course at all times. He agreed and he stated he will be more aware in the future.

Jockeys' Guild Representative Darrell Haire joined the Stewards representing jockey Rafael Bejarano. Mr. Bejarano was directed to see the Stewards this morning concerning an incident in the third race on Friday; he rides at Oaklawn Park today and will not return until late Sunday morning. After viewing the videos and discussing the incident with Mr. Haire, it was a majority opinion (Ward dissent) that when Mr. Bejarano pulled his horse out in the stretch run, he was not clear of the horse to his outside, causing that one to check. The majority opinion was that this was careless riding and the following ruling was issued:

LATS #065

Jockey **RAFAEL BEJARANO** is suspended for **THREE (3) DAYS (March 22, 23, and 24, 2013)** for altering course without sufficient clearance and causing interference while riding "Unusual Lover" in the third race at Santa Anita Park on March 15, 2013. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules-careless riding).

The term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races).
