She blamed the Assistant Clerk of Scales for her tardiness but was told to appeal if she wasn't satisfied with the \$100 penalty.

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO came to the office this morning to review his ride in the sixth race yesterday during which we believed he angled out turning into the stretch and caused some interference with the horse to his outside. While the lion's share of the blame could be placed on jockey Corey Nakatani (will be in Sunday) for initiating the move outward, we felt that Mr. Maldonado could have limited the interference somewhat. He agreed and was warned.
