Jockey Julien Leparoux was in our office to review yesterday's sixth race (Rodeo Drive Stakes) in which he came in sharply near the eighth pole (turf) first time through the stretch. Mr. Leparoux came in sharply causing #2 Lady of Shamrock(Garrett Gomez) to steady. After reviewing the film a few times, he stated he didn't notice Mr.Gomez because he was in his blind spot just inside of him. He agreed to be more cautious in the future, therefore a warning was issued.

**RACE DELAYED**

Prior to the running of the eighth race (John Henry Turf Championship) we were notified by the outrider that # 9 Code of Conduct had lost a front shoe during the post parade. After quick work from our Plating Inspector Victor Tovar, the race was only delayed approximately seven minutes.

**JOCKEY OBJECTION/NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the ninth race we posted the objection sign when the jockey of the second place horse # 5 Wild Dude (R. Bejarano) lodged a claim of foul against the winner #6 Let's Get Crackin (A. Delgadillo). Mr. Bejarano requested us to review an incident near the quarter pole (dirt) in which he had to take up slightly. After reviewing the films and speaking to both jockeys and the patrol judges, we made no change to the original order of finish. The films showed that Mr. Delgadillo had established his position and didn't give Mr. Bejarano any extra room to avoid stopping horses. Mr. Delgadillo demonstrated good race riding tactics, without violating any race riding rules.

Owner **GUSTAVO RODRIGUEZ**, having failed to appear to respond to a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility-Blue Turf LLC, \$2,350.00), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Gustavo Rodriguez are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528(Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Rodriguez is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

These rulings were issued after Mr. Salinas and Mr. Rodriguez failed to appear in response to the complaints filed against them by Board investigators.
