THURSDAY01/02/14¹**HEADLEY HEARING – CASE #13HP111**

A financial complaint pursuant to CHRB rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility) was filed by the CHRB against trainer GUSTAV HEADLEY in the amount of \$810.37 for Southern Equine Foundation, Inc., for surgeries on two different horses. Mr. Headley called the Stewards and informed them he would pay his portion of the bill and give Southern Equine Foundation the proper address for billing the remainder of the debt. The complaint will not be withdrawn until verification of full payment.

01/02/14²**INQUIRY-DISQUALIFICATION (1st race – 1 mile – dirt)**

Following the running of the race, the Inquiry sign was posted to review an incident near the 3/16 pole. Involved were #2 OH BILLY BILLY (M. Garcia, 2nd) and #3 ELECTRIC EDDIE (M. Gutierrez, 1st). Coming off the turn, #3 ELECTRIC EDDIE shifted inward sharply, knocking #2 OH BILLY BILLY off stride, also causing the jockey of #2, MARTIN GARCIA, to lose his balance. After a review of the video, conversation with the Patrol Judges and both jockeys involved, it was a unanimous vote to disqualify #3 and place it second behind #2.

Following the running of the race, the Inquiry sign was posted to review an accident that occurred at the 3/16 pole. Involved was #8 SHAND who fell and unseated apprentice jockey GONZALO NICOLAS. It was the unanimous decision of the Stewards that the video of the race was inconclusive that any other horse was involved in the incident and the original order of finish was made official. Jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ met with the Stewards to review the disqualification of his mount in yesterday's first race. Mr. Gutierrez stated his horse was lugging in and when he tried to make him change leads, the horse over-reacted and shifted inward bumping the horse to his inside. A majority decision to blame the horse and not the jockey made Mr. Gutierrez eligible for a warning. Judge CHANEY voted for a three-day suspension.

01/03/14³**RESEIGNE RULING – LATS #009**

The following ruling was issued after Mr. RESEIGNE failed to appear for the scheduled hearing.

Owner ROBERT RESEIGNE, having failed to respond to charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – \$378.40 to Southern California Equine Foundation), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of ROBERT RESEIGNE are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. RESEIGNE is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

Mr. Gutierrez also explained that he normally gets permission from Mr. Toffan before he enters any of his horses; he did not do so this time. More to follow.

Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA met with the Stewards to review the fifth race yesterday. Mr. Espinoza's mount drifted in the stretch causing a horse to check. Mr. Espinoza has had issues with this in the past and although this incident was not penalty worthy, it needed to be reviewed with the hope that he would get back on track and correct his mount when needed.
