FILM REVIEW

Jockey JOEL ROASRIO rode here yesterday and was represented by Jockeys' Guild Representative DARRELL HAIRE and retired jockey CHRIS McCARRON in the review of two races. In both cases, we believed that Mr. Rosario was riding the line of carelessness and being too aggressive. Mr. Haire acknowledged the mistakes and will relay our impressions and warning to Mr. Rosario.

Jockey BRICE BLANC came to the office to review his ride in the sixth race yesterday after which his mount was the subject of an inquiry. Films revealed that while his mount did drift out slightly, he quickly corrected the drift and therefore deserved a warning.

ACCIDENT/BREAKDOWN/9TH RACE

#4 HE'S NOT TOO SHABY broke down at the sixteenth pole on the turf course while racing last, unseating jockey ALONSO QUINONEZ. The horse was euthanized but Mr. Quinonez appeared to be uninjured (accident report attached).

Trainer SILVERIO MARTINEZ is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1845 (Authorized Bleeder Medication – did not receive Lasix) necessitating the late declaration of INTERFERONS CIM from the second race on February 16, 2014, at Santa Anita Park.

Following the running of the first race, jockey TYLER BAZE aboard third place finisher #4 PASSION BUCKET, claimed foul against the winner #1 MARLA HOOCH (I. Orozco) for interference in the stretch. It was Mr. Baze's assertion that Mr. Orozco drove his mount between horses without sufficient room. While we agreed, we did not think the move cost Mr. Baze the opportunity at a better placing. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved, we voted unanimously to make no change to the original order of finish.

SATURDAY02/22/14¹**FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice jockey IRVING OROZCO came to the office as directed this morning to review his ride in the first race yesterday after which his mount was the subject of a jockey's claim of foul. Films revealed that Mr. Orozco guided his mount into the space between horses with marginal room at best and caused some bumping among his rivals. The majority felt that there were some other factors that caused the interference but Steward CHANEY strongly dissented and voted for three suspension days.

Jockey TYLER BAZE was called to the office to get his further input into the first race yesterday after which he claimed foul. He asserted that although his horse wasn't cooperating fully he would prefer that Mr. Orozco ride less aggressively.

02/22/14²**COMPLAINT WITHDRAWN**

Veterinarian MELINDA BLUE withdrew her complaint against owner JOHN COLETTI when they agreed upon a contract to resolve the financial complaint (case number 13PM0004).

02/22/14³**INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

We posted the inquiry sign after the ninth race to examine the circumstances under which #5 ANZEAU (B. Kelly, trainer) broke extremely slowly. Films revealed that the horse simply stood there when the gates opened; this was confirmed by Starter JAY SLENDER. Therefore we declared the horse to be a starter.

JOCKEY/DRIVER ACCIDENT REPORT

Business and Professions Code Section 19481.3(e) provides that the stewards shall investigate and prepare a report regarding all on-track accidents involving jockeys that occur during the performance of their duties. The investigation shall commence no later than the next live racing day and shall be completed expeditiously. Board Rule 1536, Stewards' Minutes, includes drivers in this requirement. **Upon completion of the report it shall immediately be sent by facsimile or electronic mail to the Jockey's Guild or California Harness Horsemen's Association; the jockey/driver or his representative; the racing association; the owner; and the trainer of the horse the jockey/driver was riding/driving at the time of the accident.**

Near the 1/16 pole in the ninth race, #4 HE'S NOT TOO SHABY, went wrong and unseated jockey Alonso Quinonez. The Paramedics were on scene immediately and Mr. Quinonez was escorted to First Aid for evaluation.

Jockey/Driver condition: It was reported that Mr. Quinonez had a swollen left knee. He will be cleared by the Track Physician before his next ride.

Horse condition: The horse was euthanized in the horse ambulance.
