WEEK 12 – Sunday, March 9, 2014 – Saturday, March 15, 2014.**SUNDAY**03/09/14¹**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey LUIS SAEZ came to the office as directed to review his ride in the sixth race yesterday during which his mount drifted out twice in the stretch. Mr. Saez explained that the horse had a tendency to drift out and he should have done a better job to prevent that move. We agreed and he left the office with a warning.

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO came to the office with Jockeys' Guild representative DARRELL HAIRE to review his ride in the tenth race yesterday in which his mount made contact with a rival twice in the stretch. He explained that he thought about pushing his way out but decided to wait when he realized he didn't have room. The majority agreed to a warning while Steward CHANEY voted for three suspension days.

03/09/14²**SECURITY CITATION**

Groom RAUL ROSADO came to the office in response to a security notice. We directed him to the security office where he was supposed to appear.

03/09/14³**VALENZUELA HEARING**

We held a formal hearing into case number 14SA026 which involved a complaint filed by the CHRB against jockey PATRICK VALENZUELA for missing mounts on two consecutive racing days. He was subsequently suspended when he failed to appear for the first hearing scheduled in this matter. Present at the hearing were CHRB Investigator Rick Amieva, Jockeys' Guild representative DARRELL HAIRE as well as the Respondent.

Mr. Valenzuela explained that he overslept the first day and was just embarrassed on the second. He apologized for his behavior and for not informing this Board of Stewards of his absences and intentions. Given Mr. Valenzuela's history, we were incredulous with respect to his explanation. The CHRB recommended that Mr. Valenzuela not be licensed as a jockey. Ruling to follow.

INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

We posted the inquiry sign after the ninth race Sunday to examine an incident at the head of the stretch where third place finisher #4 NUEVA FORTUNA (Fernando Perez, jockey) ducked out sharply, forcing #3 COAST STARLITE off his path. After a quick review, we let the original order of finish stand because the horse that suffered the interference finished in front of the interfeerer.

Jockey AARON GRyder came to the office to review his ride in the tenth race Saturday. We believed that after a clever move on the inside, he allowed his horse to drift out causing one of his rivals to check. He agreed and averred that he should have been more careful. Warning.

Apprentice jockey GONZALO NICOLAS came to the office with a medical clearance allowing him to begin riding again after an injury more than two months ago. He requested and was granted an extension to his apprenticeship in the following ruling:

LATS #056

Apprentice jockey GONZALO NICOLAS, having supplied medical documentation in support of his request for an extension of his apprentice jockey's license is granted an extension of 69 days. Gonzalo Nicolas's apprenticeship shall terminate on October 24, 2014, or until he has ridden his fortieth (40th) winner, whichever occurs later.

MORROW RULINGS

We suspended and reinstated trainer SHAUN MORROW when he failed to appear Sunday for a financial complaint (case number 14SA043) and contacted us later in the morning after we had published the suspension notice. A new hearing date will be established.

LATS #055

Trainer SHAUN MORROW, having failed to respond to charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – Owner Dennis Sowers \$8,800), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of SHAUN MORROW are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. MORROW is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

LATS #057

Trainer SHAUN MORROW, having contacted the Board of Stewards and rescheduled a hearing date, is reinstated. LATS ruling #055, issued at Santa Anita on March 13, 2014 is set aside.

We posted the inquiry sign after the fifth race to examine an incident occurring immediately after the starting gate opened during which #3 SCHMALTZY stumbled and lost his rider, apprentice DRAYDEN VAN DYKE. VALENZUELA RULING

In connection with the formal hearing regarding jockey PATRICK VALENZUELA last Sunday (Refer 03/09/14³), we issued the following ruling:

LATS #058

Jockey PATRICK VALENZUELA, having appeared before the Board of Stewards, ruling LATS #035, issued at Santa Anita Park on February 7, 2014, is set aside. Mr. Valenzuela is also fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) for failure to fulfill his riding engagements at Santa Anita Park on January 24 and 25, 2014, pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

Furthermore, Mr. Valenzuela’s jockey license is suspended for its term, and it is recommended that Mr. Valenzuela not be eligible for a jockey’s license or exercise rider’s license.

INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION

Following the running of the fifth race, we posted the inquiry sign to examine two incidents: (1) #2 BOSS OF ME clipped heels near the five eighths pole and was eventually pulled up and (2) the second place finisher #1 WONDERFUL UNION (E. Maldonado) checked sharply in the stretch when the winner #8 BRAVE ACT (R. Bejarano) appeared to drift into his path. With respect to the first incident, video was somewhat unclear but it appeared as if #2 simply became rank, and ran up on heels, causing his own problems. His rider, Joe Talamo, confirmed this and therefore no change was appropriate. With respect to the second incident, films revealed that the winner did drift in while not clear causing the second place finisher to check for five strides. After shifting out, the second place finisher rallied to finish one length behind the winner. In a unanimous decision, we voted to disqualify the winner and place him second. In our opinion, #1 WONDERFUL UNION was cost the opportunity at a better placing.

SIXTH RACE – HEAT STROKE

Following the running of the sixth race, as the horses were walking off the track, #8 ANN’S GOLD (J. Carava, trainer) suffered heat stroke, flipped over and became stuck underneath the outside rail in the drainage gutter. After a superlative effort led by Racing Veterinarian Dr. DANA STEAD, and supported by Safety Steward LUIS JAUREGUI, the outriders and Track Superintendent DENNIS MOORE and his maintenance team, the horse was extracted, jumped to her feet and jogged off the track. The races were delayed about 20 minutes.

Business and Professions Code Section 19481.3(e) provides that the stewards shall investigate and prepare a report regarding all on-track accidents involving jockeys that occur during the performance of their duties. The investigation shall commence no later than the next live racing day and shall be completed expeditiously. At the start of the fifth race, #3 Schmaltzy stumbled and unseated apprentice jockey Drayden Van Dyke. The Paramedics were available immediately and Mr. Van Dyke was transported to First Aid for further evaluation. The loose horse was caught by the Outriders.

Jockey/Driver condition: Drayden Van Dyke was cleared by the Track Physician to ride the remainder of his mounts.

Horse condition: It was reported that Schmaltzy had a few scrapes, but nothing serious.
