#### BREAKDOWN/INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

We posted the inquiry sign when #1 NOTBYEMYRULES (D. Dunham, trainer) went wrong near the 5/16ths pole on the dirt course. Films revealed that the horse was not interfered with by other runners and therefore no change was appropriate. The horse was euthanized, while the jockey SAUL ARIAS, despite being thrown to the track, appeared uninjured and was transported to first aid. Accident report attached.

04/03/14<sup>2</sup>**OROZCO HEARING AND RULING – LATS #139**

We heard complaint 13GG0154 with permission of the Golden Gate Fields Board of Stewards and the investigator who filed the case. This respondent groom ADRIAN OROZCO who was issued a ruling two months ago for failure to appear concerning several orders by stable security to leave the grounds, unless he could produce a license that had been validated (indicating he was on a trainer's work list). After hearing the facts, we followed the CHRB's recommendation and issued the following ruling:

Exercise rider ADRIAN OROZCO, having appeared before the Board of Stewards in response to complaint #13GG0154, is restored to good standing. Ruling #PRTG10, issued at Pacific Racing Association on January 12, 2014, is set aside. Additionally, ADRIAN OROZCO is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) and placed on probation for the term of his license for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers).

We explained that unless he was subject to imminent danger (he was not) that using the whip in this manner was not acceptable. The majority voted for a warning whereas Steward CHANEY voted for a fine.

**JOCKEY/DRIVER ACCIDENT REPORT**

Business and Professions Code Section 19481.3(e) provides that the stewards shall investigate and prepare a report regarding all on-track accidents involving jockeys that occur during the performance of their duties. The investigation shall commence no later than the next live racing day and shall be completed expeditiously. Board Rule 1536, Stewards' Minutes, includes drivers in this requirement. **Upon completion of the report it shall immediately be sent by facsimile or electronic mail to the Jockey's Guild or California Harness Horsemen's Association; the jockey/driver or his representative; the racing association; the owner; and the trainer of the horse the jockey/driver was riding/driving at the time of the accident.**

Approaching the 3/8 marker in the ninth race, #1 NOTBYEMYRULES went wrong, fell and unseated jockey Saul Arias. The Paramedics were on scene immediately to attend to Mr. Arias and he was transported to First Aid for further evaluation by the Track Physician.

**Jockey/Driver condition:** It was reported that Mr. Arias was body sore and released from First Aid. He must be cleared by the Track Physician before he rides again.

**Horse condition:** NOTBYEMYRULES was euthanized on track, due to a broken left front leg.
