MORA FORMAL HEARING CASE #14SA179

The CHRB filed a complaint against Stable Foreman RAUL MARTINEZ MORA for a possible violation of CHRB rule #1902.5 (Animal Welfare). Court Reporter MICHELLE DERIEG recorded the proceedings. JIM HAMILTON represented the CHRB. Steward LUIS JAUREGUI was present to translate, if necessary. This complaint was filed in 2012 and Mr. Mora was suspended for failure to appear (CHRB #1547 - Failure to Appear). Mr. Mora now wants to return to the industry and stated that he never received the complaint packet to attend a hearing in 2012.

The accusation was that Mr. Mora had struck a horse in the head with the leather end of a shank. Mr. Mora testified that he put the horse he was walking into its stall and the shank got stuck while trying to remove it from around the nose of the horse, scaring the horse. The horse then backed into the rear of the stall which made a loud noise.

When the original complaint was filed, MARY ANN DONALD (assistant trainer for JIM CASSIDY), gave a statement, stating she witnessed the incident. At the hearing she stated that she heard a slap from the stall Mr. Mora was in and assumed he hit the horse with the leather end of the shank. She further stated she did not witness the incident. Decision to follow.

INQUIRY-SEVENTH RACE (6 1/2 turf) NO CHANGE

Following the running of the race, the Inquiry sign was posted to review an incident in the stretch run. Involved were #6 BLAKE'S MAGIC (A. Gryder, 5th) and #8 NOISE OF

THE CROWD (M. Smith, 1st). In the stretch run, #8 drifted inward closing the hole between his mount and a horse on the fence, and this caused #6 to take up and shift out. After a review of the race and conversations with the Patrol Judges and both jockeys involved, the original order of finish was made official. In the Stewards' unanimous opinion, AARON GRyder the jockey of #6, chose to take back and move his horse to the outside when racing in close quarters. In conversation with Mr. Gryder before making the race official, he stated that was what happened and his horse was never intimidated by the horse to his outside.

06/15/14³**RACE DELAY-NINTH RACE**

There was a 13 minute delay in this race when #4 QUEEN KALYRRA unseated her rider, ran off and fell over the inside rail of the main course while warming up for a turf race. The horse was stuck between the outside turf rail and main course inside rail. With the help of Track Veterinarian DANA STEAD, Outrider JESUS CAMACHO and Santa Anita's maintenance crew, the horse was removed from that area with a shallow laceration to her shoulder and traveled in the horse ambulance back to her stable. The jockey, ELVIS TRUJILLO, was not injured.

FILM REVIEW (Ref 06/15/14²)

Jockey MIKE SMITH met with the Stewards to review an Inquiry in the seventh race Sunday. The incident, (drifting in to tighten a hole), was discussed and it was agreed that although Mr. Smith was not facing a penalty, he was told to be less aggressive in the future. He agreed, and stated he would be more aware.

06/19/14²**INQUIRY - NO CHANGE - SEVENTH RACE (one mile turf)**

Following the running of the race, the Inquiry was posted to review the start of the race. Involved was #1 PUBLIC INTEREST (Tr. J. Shirreffs) who chose not to leave the gate when the field was dispatched. After a review of the race and conversation with Starter JAY SLENDER, it was a unanimous decision to declare the horse a starter. It took about 20 seconds to remove the horse from the gate, to allow the gate to be removed from the track so the race could be completed. The horse refused to walk out the front and had to be backed out. PUBLIC INTEREST also refused in its career start. Starter Slender has placed the horse on the Starter's List; it will not be allowed to race in California.

06/20/14¹**MORA RULING – LATS #210 (Ref 06/15/14¹)**

The following ruling was issued after a decision was made following his hearing. Due to testimony heard, the case was dismissed.

Stable Foreman RAUL MARTINEZ MORA, having appeared and the complaint filed against Mr. MORA having been dismissed, subject is restored to good standing. Ruling HRTH#011, issued at Hollywood Park Racing Association on November 30, 2012, is set aside.

06/20/14²**BOULANGER RULING – LATS #211**

The following ruling was issued after a meeting with apprentice jockey BRANDON BOULANGER concerning his removal from his only mount yesterday for being ten pounds overweight (seven is the limit). He stated he has had trouble with his weight since arriving in California, but feels he is gaining control.

Apprentice jockey BRANDON BOULANGER is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1683 (Maximum Overweight), resulting in a late rider change in the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on June 19, 2014.

06/20/14³**ACCIDENT – BREAKDOWN - EIGHTH RACE - NO CHANGE**

During the running of the race (one mile turf), #8 COLE FORTY FIVE (Tr. E. Freeman) near the 5/8 marker, on the outside, in the clear, went wrong. In the process of pulling the horse up, jockey KAYLA STRA became unseated. Accident Report attached.

Jockeys AARON GRYDER and JOE TALAMO met with the Stewards to review the sixth race yesterday (6 ½ turf). It was the consensus that entering the left turn down the hill, Tyler Baze and Joe Talamo should have eased back and Arron Gryder could have allowed more room to his inside. The film angle available did not reveal a perfect view of the location where the incident occurred.

06/21/14²**PEREZ RULING – LATS #212**

The following ruling was issued after a meeting with jockey FERNANDO PEREZ. Mr. Perez stood up early, a few strides before the wire, beaten a diminishing nose for third place. He stated his horse felt sore, he galloped out and then returned to unsaddle. Mr. Perez was informed that if a horse is that sore, he should pull up and get off. He said he understood.

Jockey FERNANDO PEREZ, who rode BOBBY Z MAN in the first race at Santa Anita Park on June 20, 2014, is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1692 (Requirements for Horse, Trainer and Jockey – failure to ride mount to the finish).

As the field entered the backstretch of the one mile turf race, #8 COLE FORTY FIVE suffered a severe injury to the left front leg. The rider Kayla Stra attempted to pull the horse up, however, in doing so she lost her balance and fell.

Jockey/Driver condition – Examined by paramedics – transported to Arcadia Methodist Hospital for observation; appeared to be uninjured

Horse condition – Fractured sesamoids left front, euthanized by the trainer's practicing veterinarian.
