#### VIDEO REVIEW

Jockey KAYLA STRA was in the office to review a race from earlier in the week during which she used her whip on a horse which had achieved its maximum placing. She said the horse was running "green" and she was trying to keep the horse's mind on its business. While not serious enough for a sanction, Ms. Stra was cautioned that a repeat offense would result in a fine.

#### ACCIDENT/INQUIRY/NO CHANGE

The Inquiry sign was posted after the first race as jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE was unseated from his mount, #6 HEYYOUCAN, just prior to the finish. After speaking with the Patrol Judges and reviewing video of the spill, the Stewards voted unanimously to make no change to the original placings. It was clear that the horse ducked out on its own and that no other horses or riders were involved.

The rider was examined by the track physician and cleared to ride his remaining mounts. Accident report attached.

10/12/14<sup>4</sup>**CLAIM VOIDED**

The claim of the horse WHEN I'M CALLING U by trainer JAVIER SIERRA from the fifth race this afternoon was voided as the horse was unsound while cooling out in the Receiving Barn. The horse was returned to the barn of trainer R. B. HESS, JR.

Jockey MARTIN PEDROZA was in the office this morning to review the fourth race from Sunday, during which his mount drifted out during the stretch run and caused interference in the process. Mr. Pedroza acknowledged his mistake and while the interference was not serious enough to warrant days, he was cautioned to make a stronger effort to maintain a straight course.

10/13/14<sup>3</sup>**RULING – LATC #017**

TOMMY DUNCAN, having participated in a fitness for license hearing, is declared eligible for licensure by the California Horse Racing Board.

This ruling was issued after Mr. Duncan participated in a license fitness hearing. He failed to note a conviction for a minor offense eight years prior.

10/13/14<sup>4</sup>**REFUND**

A refund was ordered in the eighth race as #9 EXOTIC SLEW did not warm up to the satisfaction of Racing Veterinarian STEAD and was declared on his recommendation. The refund amounted to \$62,248.64

10/16/14<sup>2</sup>**RULING – LATC #018**

Jockey DESIREE STRA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1680 (Jockeys and Drivers to Report) and #1682 (Weighing Out – failure to report proper riding weight) on October 12, 2014.

This ruling was issued after Ms. Stra accepted responsibility for not reporting the proper weight.

10/16/14<sup>3</sup>**RULING – LATC #019**

Jockey FRANCISCO TORRES, having appeared for a fitness for license hearing, is reinstated. Furthermore, Mr. Torres is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1489 (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License – material misrepresentation on a license application).

This ruling was issued after Mr. Torres provided paperwork regarding his failure to note a conviction which has since been removed from his record. He was fined for his transgression as the removal did not relieve him of the obligation to note the conviction.

10/17/14<sup>2</sup>**VIDEO REVIEW**

AGAPITO DELGADILLO was in the office this morning to review his ride – a winning one – in the sixth race yesterday afternoon. At issue was the fact that the rider continued to use a left-hand whip as his horse was drifting out. Mr. Delgadillo, who was making his first start since coming off a three-day suspension for a similar violation, acknowledged his mistake and pledged to make a better effort in the future. The ride did not give rise to a sanction, but drifting in the stretch is not something we condone.

10/17/14<sup>3</sup>**RULIING – LATC #020**

Having withdrawn his appeal of DMTD Ruling #18 dated August 8, 2014, jockey ELVIS TRUJILLO is suspended THREE (3) days (October 23, 24, and 25, 2014).

This ruling was issued after the Stewards received information that Mr. Trujillo, through his counsel, ROGER LICHT, withdrew his appeal of a suspension issued at Del Mar this past summer.

10/17/14<sup>4</sup>**BREAKDOWN/INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

The Inquiry sign was posted after the third race to review an incident near the 3/8 pole involving #4 FLY TO FREEDOM (M. Pedroza). After speaking with the Patrol Judges and reviewing video of the incident the Stewards voted unanimously to make no change to the original order of finish. The review made it obvious that the horse was racing on the lead and broke down with no warning. The rider did a good job of getting the horse pulled up without incident.

The horse suffered fractures of both sesamoids in the right foreleg and was later euthanized by trainer PETER MILLER's attending veterinarian.

10/17/14<sup>5</sup>**JOCKEY OBJECTION – NO CHANGE**

The Objection sign was posted after the seventh race as jockey ALONSO QUINONEZ (7<sup>th</sup>, #3 TANQUERRAY) lodged a claim of foul against jockeys COREY NAKATANI (3<sup>rd</sup>, #1 MARKET QUOTE) and JOE TALAMO (4<sup>th</sup>, #5 MINDFULLY) for interference during the stretch run. After speaking with the riders involved, taking into account reports from the Patrol Judges and reviewing video of the stretch run, the Stewards voted unanimously to dismiss the claim of foul. Although Quinonez did steady for one stride, the incident did not cost the rider and his mount a position.

**HEARING**

Groom NORMAN LINDSAY was in the office this morning in response to a complaint filed by the Board alleging abuse of his dog. The complaint stated that Lindsay's dog was observed tethered to an arm of a hot walking machine and also tied up in a stall. Lindsay admitted to both allegations, stating that he put the dog on the walking machine in order to get it some exercise. He said that he has trouble walking and felt the dog would benefit more on the machine than if he was hand walking it. He tied the dog in the stall as it had run away on several occasions. We will take the matter under submission and render a decision shortly.

**REFUND**

A refund was ordered in the fourth race as #6 HAPPY DEISY was off in the right foreleg during the warm up period and was declared on the advice of Racing Veterinarian STEAD. The refund came to a total of \$18,493.46.

**STEWARDS' INQUIRY – NO CHANGE**

The Inquiry sign was posted after the sixth race as the Stewards reviewed an incident in the stretch which involved the first and third place finishers, #1 BACKSTREET LISA (E. Maldonado) and #3 VOW ME OVER (R. Bejarano). After speaking with the riders involved, taking into account reports from the Patrol Judges and reviewing video of the stretch run, the Stewards voted unanimously to make no change to the original order of finish. Review showed that Bejarano steadied momentarily and in our opinion was not cost a placing because of the interference.

Apprentice Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE rode "HEYYOUCAN" in the first race at Santa Anita race track. When he was approaching the finish line, his horse suddenly veered out sharply causing him to be unseated. Mr. Van Dyke was attended to by the race track paramedics and was then transported to the First Aid to be examined by the track physician. The track physician cleared him to ride his remaining mounts.

**Jockey/Driver condition** – No injuries. Jockey cleared by track physician

**Horse condition** – Horse was caught by the outrider; no injuries.
