10/26/14<sup>1</sup>

#### FILM REVIEW

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO came to the office with his agent and Jockeys' Guild rep DARRELL HAIRE to review his ride in the fourth race yesterday after which his mount was disqualified and placed second. He explained that he thought he was clear when he shifted his mount out. He also believed that the horse in front of him at the time left him no choice. We felt that neither explanation was sufficient and therefore issued a three-day suspension for the interference: LATC #025

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO, who rode TEMEEKU in the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on October 25, 2014, is suspended for THREE RACING DAYS (November 8, 9, and 13, 2014) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch, causing interference which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from first to second position. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules). Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

Jockey FERNANDO PEREZ came to the office to review his ride in the fourth race yesterday during which we felt he may have been hitting his horse on the flank. While films were not dispositive and there were no post race welts, we explained the riding rule and cautioned him against such behavior.

Jockey ALONSO QUINONEZ came to the office this morning to explain why he was extremely late to the paddock for the fourth race yesterday. Unable to provide a legitimate excuse, a ruling will be issued in the near future.

Apprentice jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE came to the office to review his ride in the fifth race yesterday. He won the race but we wanted to caution him against using a left-handed whip while his horse was drifting out. He recognized the error and was somewhat embarrassed that it had happened.

Jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ came to the office to review his ride in the fifth race from last Thursday. Upon further review, we felt that he could have made a better effort to control his mount going into the first turn and down the backstretch. He felt his mount was running off and wanted to avoid clipping heels. We explained that unless the danger was imminent, he should take his horse straight back rather than push his way out.

10/26/14<sup>2</sup>**BREEDERS' CUP MEETING**

We held the first of what will be several meetings in preparation for the Breeders' Cup. General issues and logistics were discussed.

10/26/14<sup>3</sup>**NEGOTIATIONS**

We attempted some mediation between trainer MIKE CURTIS and owner JOE BLANFORD this morning. The connections have some disagreements over training bills and own two horses together. Thus far, the mediation has been unsuccessful.

10/26/14<sup>4</sup>**MORALES SUSPENSION - LATC #024**

We issued the following ruling when groom ENRIQUE MORALES failed to appear for his hearing (case number 14SA224) into a complaint alleging marijuana use:

Groom ENRIQUE MORALES, having failed to appear to answer a complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1902(b) (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing), #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation), #1874 (Disorderly Conduct), and #1890 (Possession of Contraband), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of ENRIQUE MORALES are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. MORALES is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

Groom ENRIQUE MORALES came to the office after receiving his suspension ruling. Fortunately, supervising investigator RICK AMIEVA was able to come to our office and we conducted an informal hearing into the underlying complaint. Security discovered Mr. Morales smoking marijuana in the stable area. We supplemented Santa Anita's penalty (small fine and Winners' Foundation) with our own ruling:

Groom ENRIQUE MORALES, having appeared as ordered, is restored to good standing. Ruling LATC #024, issued at Santa Anita Park on October 26, 2014, is set aside provided that Mr. MORALES sign a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board and continue his contract with Winners' Foundation.

11/01/14<sup>1</sup> **JOCKEY MEETING**

After an uneventful day yesterday, we held a second meeting with the jockey colony this morning to reinforce our expectations.

11/01/14<sup>2</sup> **INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the 12<sup>th</sup> race today (Breeders' Cup Classic), we posted the Inquiry sign to examine an incident at the start (Dirt, 1¼ miles). Involved in the incident were the winner #7 BAYERN (M. Garcia) and several horses to his inside -- #6 SHARED BELIEF (M. Smith) and #4 MORENO (J. Castellano). Film review revealed that #7 BAYERN broke in sharply, bumped #6 SHARED BELIEF, causing a chain reaction with several other horses to his inside, including #4 MORENO, who also broke out slightly. #6 SHARED BELIEF finished fourth, 3½ lengths behind the third place finisher while #4 MORENO finished far behind the leaders. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved, it was our unanimous decision that pursuant to CHRB Rule 1699, that the incident occurred in a part of the race where the horses interfered with were not cost the opportunity to place where they were reasonably expected to finish.

Jockey IGGY PUGLISI came to the office this morning to review his ride in the first race on Friday. His mount had a tendency to get out throughout the stretch. Films showed that he made a decent effort to keep his horse straight but we felt he could make a slightly better effort. He agreed.

Jockey MARTIN GARCIA came to the office to review his ride in the 12<sup>th</sup> race yesterday. His mount made a sharp move inward at the start. Films revealed that Mr. Garcia corrected his horse on the second stride, therefore we believed that no penalty was appropriate.

11/02/14<sup>2</sup>**ASMUSSEN RULING – LATC #034**

We issued the following ruling in response to a security report that trainer STEVE ASMUSSEN had accessed the paddock exit to the track with a horse before it was opened:

Trainer STEVE ASMUSSEN is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations – disobeying outrider).

11/02/14<sup>3</sup>**INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the seventh race, we posted the Inquiry sign to examine the circumstances under which the last place finisher #4 MIA'S STORM (T. Baze) clipped heels at the 3/16ths pole. Films revealed that several factors contributed and was partly the fault of the next to last place finisher #2 HUGH KNEW (M. Smith) drifting in. After speaking to the patrol judges and riders involved, we voted unanimously to make no change to the original order of finish.

11/02/14<sup>4</sup>**INQUIRY/DOUBLE DISQUALIFICATION**

Following the running of ninth race today we posted the Inquiry sign to review an incident that involved several horses. Films revealed that the outside horse (#5 EMOTIONAL KITTEN, F. Dettori) drifted in and the inside horse (#6 I'M ALREADY SEXY, F. Geroux) drifted out causing a squeeze play and interference with the three horses in the middle. We felt that two of the horses (#4 and #2 were cost the opportunity at a better placing) and therefore voted unanimously for a double disqualification.
