We held a formal hearing into case number 15SA063 which was a complaint filed by the CHRB against jockey IRVING OROZCO alleging violation of CHRB rules #1872 and #1790. This case involved the fact that he missed three mounts a few months ago. He was recently released from county jail and requested the hearing, waiving his right to 10-day notice. Decision to follow.

FILM REVIEW

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO came to the office to review his ride in the fourth race yesterday during which he drifted in and caused his rival to check to his inside. He was candid in explaining that it was a mistake. Given that he had just been warned for the same thing two days prior, we issued a three-day suspension (Ward dissenting):

LATS #073

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO, who rode JAZZY JOSH in the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on March 21, 2015, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (March 28, 29, and April 2, 2015), for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding). Pursuant to California Horse racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races) the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

3/26/15²**CHO RULING – LATS #074**

We issued the following ruling when trainer MYUNG CHO failed to appear for a financial hearing (case number 15SA0088) filed by Citrus Feed alleging unpaid bills:

Owner MYUNG KWON CHO, having failed to respond to charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility - \$3,719.19 to LARRY BELL dba CITRUS FEED) is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear). During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of MYUNG KWON CHO are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine) Mr. CHO is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

DARRELL HAIRE of the Jockeys' Guild, was in the office to review video of some races.

3/26/15⁴**ACCIDENT**

Following the running of the first race, third place finisher #6 BELIEVE TOO, collapsed of heat exhaustion a furlong past the wire. Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO was unseated and transported to first aid where he was taken off of his mounts for the remainder of the card, complaining of neck pain. The horse was revived and vanned off. A claim was voided because the horse was placed on the veterinarian's list as unsound. Accident report attached.

Jockey FELIPE VALDEZ came to the office this morning to review his ride in the fourth race yesterday. We felt he could have relieved the pressure from his position on the outside of a four horse spread. He agreed and left with a warning.

3/27/15²**RUBALCAVA RULING - LATS #076**

Pursuant to an outrider citation, exercise rider TONY RUBALCAVA was fined in the following ruling:

Exercise rider TONY RUBALCAVA is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – backtracking in contradiction of track safety rules).

3/27/15³**VALDEZ HEARING and RULING - LATS #075**

Jockey FELIPE VALDEZ came to the office for an informal hearing to discuss case number 15SA083 which alleged a whip violation:

Jockey FELIPE VALDEZ is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(B)(3)(Use of Whips – causing a break in the skin) during the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on February 26, 2015.

3/27/15⁴**TOTE ISSUE**

Mutuel Manager RANDY HARTZELL was in this morning to discuss a tote issue which took place yesterday. At the heart of the issue is the fact that our placing judges do not have direct control of the tote board. We are trying to work with Mr. Hartzell to streamline the process and eliminate the possibility of human error as much as we can. Complicating matters is the fact the contract with the current tote company expires in five months and the changes we are interested in would take longer than that. He will work with the replacement company, Am Tote, to establish the system we want.

3/27/15⁵**INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

After the running of the eighth race, we posted the Inquiry sign to examine the start of #5 SCREAMING TAP who stumbled and lost his rider SANTIAGO GONZALEZ. After reviewing video and speaking with the starter, we unanimously declared the horse a starter because he caused his own problems without outside influence. Jockey Santiago Gonzalez appeared uninjured but will be examined by the track physician before riding. Accident report attached.

SATURDAY3/28/15¹**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey SANTIAGO GONZALEZ came to the office to review his ride in the third race yesterday in which we felt that he tried to push his way out from behind horses down the backstretch of a two-turn race. He explained that he thought he was clear of the horses to his outside. We issued a warning.

Jockey BRICE BLANC came to the office to review his ride in the sixth race yesterday during which we felt he angled in too sharply and put too much pressure on the horses to his inside. Mr. Blanc felt that his rivals should have taken back. The majority issued a warning (Steward Sawyer voted for three suspension days).

3/28/15²**LANDA RULING – LATS #077**

Exercise rider PABLO LANDA was suspended when he failed to appear for case number 15SA085 which alleged disorderly conduct and drug use, among other things:

Exercise rider PABLO LANDA, having failed to respond to charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1928(c) (Fire Regulations), #1437 (Conditions of a Race Meeting), and #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of PABLO LANDA are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. LANDA is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

3/28/15³**COMPLAINT WITHDRAWAL**

LOS LAURELES TRAINING and EQUINE THERAPY withdrew its complaint (case number 15SA093) against owner MERSAD METANOVIC when the alleged debt was paid.

3/28/15⁴**JONES RULING – LATS #078**

Groom SEDRIC JONES was suspended when he failed to appear for his hearing (case number 15SA090) alleging drug, DUI, and driving convictions:

Groom SEDRIC JONES, having failed to respond to charges alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1489(H) (Possession of a controlled substance), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of SEDRIC JONES are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. JONES is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

3/28/15⁵**MUDARRIS HEARING**

We held an informal hearing into case number 15SA092 which was a financial complaint by LOS LAURELES TRAINING FARM against owner SALAH AL MUDARRIS alleging unpaid board and training fees amounting to \$6,511.00. After listening to the evidence, we decided that the money was indeed owed. Mr. AL MUDARRIS, through his attorney, expressed his desire to appeal, so we will publish a ruling tomorrow.
