#### FILM REVIEW

Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE, accompanied by jockey GARY STEVENS, was in our office to review yesterday's seventh race (6 ½ furlong turf) in which Mr. Van Dyke was disqualified from first to fifth place. Mr. VanDyke stated that it was a combination of the inside horse coming out and his horse had stumbled, causing him to angle in slightly. After reviewing the race several times, we determined that the shift was gradual and his horse did stumble slightly. Therefore, Mr. Van Dyke left without a penalty (Steward Kim Sawyer voted for a three day suspension) and he was cautioned to take a tighter hold of the reins in order to maintain better control of his horses in the future.

**SATURDAY**6/20/15<sup>1</sup>**PEDERSON HEARING**

We held a formal hearing today into a matter (case number 15SA168) involving trainer DEAN PEDERSON and a late scratch. The CHRB was represented by investigator JIM HAMILTON and Mr. Pederson was represented by attorney Steve Schwartz. The matter involved a switch of two horses by the van company that Mr. Pederson hired to take his runner to Santa Anita from Los Alamitos. Mr. Pederson's horse was deposited in the wrong trainer's barn and that horse was medicated, precluding it from running. Respondent maintained that he broke no CHRB rules and adhered to the standard of care in the industry. The CHRB maintained that the trainer is the absolute insurer of the horse, its condition and was responsible for the appearance of runners for their respective races. Decision to follow.
