19 racing days. Racing Thursdays through Sundays, except racing on Monday, Columbus Day, October 12.

**Races:** Eight races weekdays, eleven races Opening Day and minimum of nine races on weekends.

**Post time:** Daily – 1:00 p.m. except Saturday, September 26, 12:30 p.m.

**Scratch time:** Regular scratch time will be at 10:00 a.m. the previous racing day, unless otherwise noted. The deadline for scratches for stakes races, with the exception of overnight stakes races will be prior to the 3<sup>rd</sup> race or one hour before post time, whichever is longer.

**Wagering:** Minimum \$2 win, place and show wagering on every race; Daily Double on races 1-2, 4-5 and the final two races on each card. \$1 Rolling Pick Threes; \$1 Exactas on all races; \$1 Trifectas; \$1 and 10 cent Superfectas on all qualifying races; \$1 Pick Four on final four races; \$1 Pick Five on first five races; \$2 Pick Six (with carryover) on final six races, and \$1 Place Pick All (no carryover) beginning with first race.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey IGGY PUGLISI came to the office to review his ride in the eighth race on Thursday at Los Alamitos. His horse stepped out and made contact with the horse to his outside. We cautioned him to be faster in reacting and correcting his mounts. He agreed. Warning.

**DESIGNATED RACES**

We published the list of designated races for the meet (all graded races). See attached.

9/26/15<sup>3</sup>

**INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the fifth race, we posted the Inquiry sign to examine the stretch run involving the winner #4 NYQUIST (M. Gutierrez) and the second place finisher #7 SWIPE (K. Desormeaux). Video showed that Mr. Gutierrez's mount did step in and make minor contact with #7 SWIPE who was making a run on the inside. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved, we voted unanimously to make no change to the original order of finish. We believed that #7 SWIPE was not cost the opportunity at a better placing.

**INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

We posted the Inquiry sign after the running of the eleventh race to examine an incident where #1 RECALIBRATING (S. Gonzalez) made contact with the inner rail and took up sharply near the 3/8th pole. Video confirmed that there were no other horses involved; therefore, we made no change to the original order of finish.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO came to the office to review his ride in the ninth race yesterday in which the rider to his inside had to steady shortly after leaving the gate. After reviewing the video, we were satisfied with Mr. Bejarano's effort to protect his fellow rider. We did issue the following ruling because Mr. Bejarano was extremely late to the paddock yesterday:

**LATC #002**

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations), jockey RAFAEL BEJARANO is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) for being late to the paddock for the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on September 26, 2015.

We also had jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ's agent TOM KNUST in this morning to review the ride in yesterday's fifth, which was the subject of an inquiry. Mr. Gutierrez was out of town. We cautioned him to keep a straighter path in the future. Warning. We also explained to Mr. Knust that since his rider rode more than one designated race yesterday while under suspension he would be required to serve an additional day. The majority believed next Sunday was a reasonable "like" day while Steward CHANEY voted for the following Saturday:

**LATC #001**

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766(h) (Designated Races – rode in more than one designated race on September 26, 2015), jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ is suspended for ONE (1) additional day (October 4, 2015).

Term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

Jockey JUAN LEYVA called yesterday in lieu of coming to the office this morning because he was leaving town. He explained that he struck his horse more than three times in succession without giving him a chance to respond because he forgot the new rule. In fact, he struck his horse eight times in succession. This was his first violation, but given the fact that he was well over the three limit, the majority elected to increase the penalty commensurate with a second violation in the following ruling (SAWYER voted for a \$500 fine:

**LATC #003**

Jockey JUAN LEYVA is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense), during the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on September 26, 2015.

**HERNANDEZ HEARING**

Groom BENJAMIN HERNANDEZ came to the office to answer case number 15DM092 which was a complaint filed by the CHRB alleging disorderly conduct. Basically this entailed two instances of being drunk in the barn area. Ruling to follow.

**INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the ninth race, we posted the Inquiry sign to examine an incident in the stretch in which #9 CHIEF WARRIOR clipped heels and unseated his rider, apprentice TY KENNEDY. Films showed that Mr. Kennedy actually drifted out over heels and caused his own problems. Therefore, after speaking with the patrol judges, we voted unanimously to make no change to the original order of finish. Accident report attached.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA came to the office to review his ride in the fifth race on Sunday. We wanted to discuss whether he rode his mount to the wire and consequently whether he cost his horse fourth position (nose margin). Mr. Espinoza explained that he stood up right at the wire. The majority agreed. Steward CHANEY believed that he cost his mount fourth position and that a penalty was appropriate.

Jockey TYLER BAZE came to the office to review his ride in the tenth race on Saturday. It appeared upon preliminary review that Mr. Baze had violated the riding crop rule by striking his horse four times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond. Upon further review, video demonstrated that Mr. Baze, in fact, only struck his horse three times. No penalty.

Jockey JAMES GRAHAM came to the office to review his ride in the sixth race Sunday. Video showed that he struck his mount more than three times in succession without giving him the chance to respond. We issued the following ruling:

**LATC #006**

Jockey JAMES GRAHAM is suspended for ONE (1) racing day (October 11, 2015) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – fourth offense), during the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on September 27, 2015.

Jockey COREY NAKATANI came to the office to review his ride in the third race on Sunday in which he struck his mount five times in succession on the shoulder without giving his horse a chance to respond. We issued the following ruling:

**LATC #007**

Jockey COREY NAKATANI is suspended for TWO (2) racing days (October 11 and 15, 2015) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – fifth offense), during the third race at Santa Anita Park on September 27, 2015.

Jockey MARTIN PEDROZA called and acknowledged his violation of the riding crop rule from Sunday and was issued the following ruling:

**LATC #005**

Jockey MARTIN PEDROZA is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense), during the seventh race at Santa Anita Park on September 27, 2015.

Trainer EDWARD "TED" WEST, JR., who started the horse "LAROCCO", the fifth place finisher in the 1<sup>st</sup> race at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on August 6, 2015, is fined TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1844(c)(1) (Authorized Medication – Phenylbutazone in excess of permitted level), #1843.1(b) (Prohibited Drug Substances), #1843(A)(D) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse).

The complaint (case number 15LT014) filed against trainer A.C. AVILA by WEST COAST FEED alleging an unpaid feed and bedding bill was withdrawn when the bill was paid.

Trainer RICHARD BALTAS appeared in the office this morning to answer case number 15LT008 which was a complaint filed by the CHRB alleging disobedience to the paddock judge. Mr. Baltas was candid in explaining that he re-saddled his horse because his rider instructed him to do so. Unfortunately, he failed to ask the paddock judge and caused some issues with the rest of the field as well as the traffic pattern leading to the track. He acknowledged his mistake but believed he was doing the correct thing for the horse. Decision to follow.

10/03/15<sup>3</sup>**LEAL/SPORTECH HEARING**

We held an informal hearing today into case number 15LT007 which the CHRb filed against tote employee ABEL LEAL and his employer SPORTECH. This involved an incident at Del Mar in which Mr. Leal entered the wrong number for a scratched horse and then when asked to confirm the scratch, did so. He further exacerbated the problem upon realizing his mistake by taking upon himself to put the horse back in the wagering pool. We eventually scratched the horse for wagering and allowed it to run for purse money only. He acknowledged his mistake. Unfortunately, this was not his first error. Decision to follow.

Following the running of the fourth race, we posted the Inquiry sign to examine the stretch run involving the first two finishers -- #8 MESA SKY and #5 NATE'S TIZZY. Videos showed several points of contact, most of which were caused by the second place horse #5 NATE'S TIZZY lugging in. The last contact (inside horse into the outside horse) occurred as a reaction to the penultimate bump. After speaking with both riders and the patrol judges, we voted unanimously to make no change to the original order of finish.

10/03/15<sup>7</sup>**INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

We posted the Inquiry sign following the running of the sixth race to examine an incident in which third place finisher #1 JIMMY BOUNCER ducked in sharply when switching leads and caused the fourth place finisher #7 TOOWINDYTOHAULROX to steady. A nose separated the rivals at the finish. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved, we voted unanimously to disqualify #1 and place him fourth.
